Other Significant Issues:

A&A Health LLC was selected under the authority of the Administrative Code 21.5 (e) as a pilot not to exceed two years. This program is the result of the recommendation of the New Beds and Facilities workgroup of Mental Health SF, and is funded by Prop C dollars. The new model, Rehabilitative Board & Care Residential Services, is an enhanced service model not currently available in the BHS system of care. While BHS operates/funds many types of residential services, this program is unique, as it combines aspects from the different models. Unlike Board and Care homes, and Supportive Housing sites, the 20 proposed slots are not permanent housing. This is a nine to 12 month program with the intentional goal of providing intensive, daily, life skill and work skill training to enable the residents to move from this program to an independent living situation. This program, unlike current Board and Care sites, has on-site staff who are there all day, every day working with the resident clients to achieve their goals.

A&A Health LLC, a Residential Care Facility, will provide rehabilitative board & care residential services to San Francisco residents with behavioral health issues and medical problems, and/or with physical impairments requiring special assistance that might include the use of wheelchairs, walker or cane. A&A Health Services facility(s) will primarily admit San Francisco residents directly from acute psychiatric, medical inpatient units, jail, and clients in community settings when appropriate. A&A Health provides 24 hour care to18 to 64 years old with dual and triple diagnoses requiring a structured, rehabilitating environment program that will maximize each client's potential to re-join and re-engage in the community. The program goal is to provide innovative, recovery-based programs and maximize each individual's functional capacity fostering self-care and return to the highest level of independent living possible in the community.

A&A Health LLC is a for-profit entity formed as a Delaware limited liability company on November 13, 2019 and registered in California on January 20, 2020. The company is headquartered in Alamo, California. The primary business of the Company is to operate facilities providing transitional housing and social rehabilitation for adults experiencing mental health crises. The Company's principals and key executive staff have 20+ years of experience in related fields.
