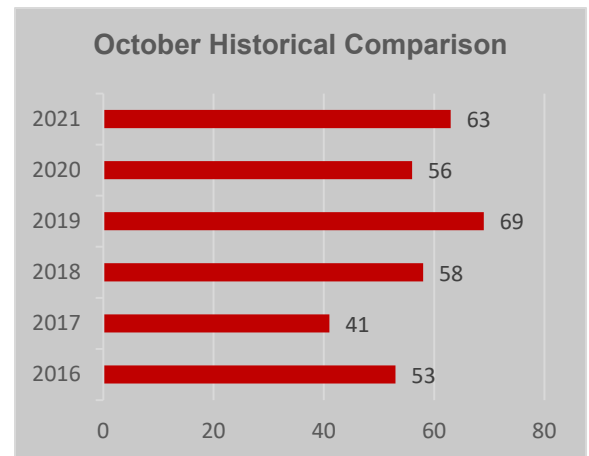

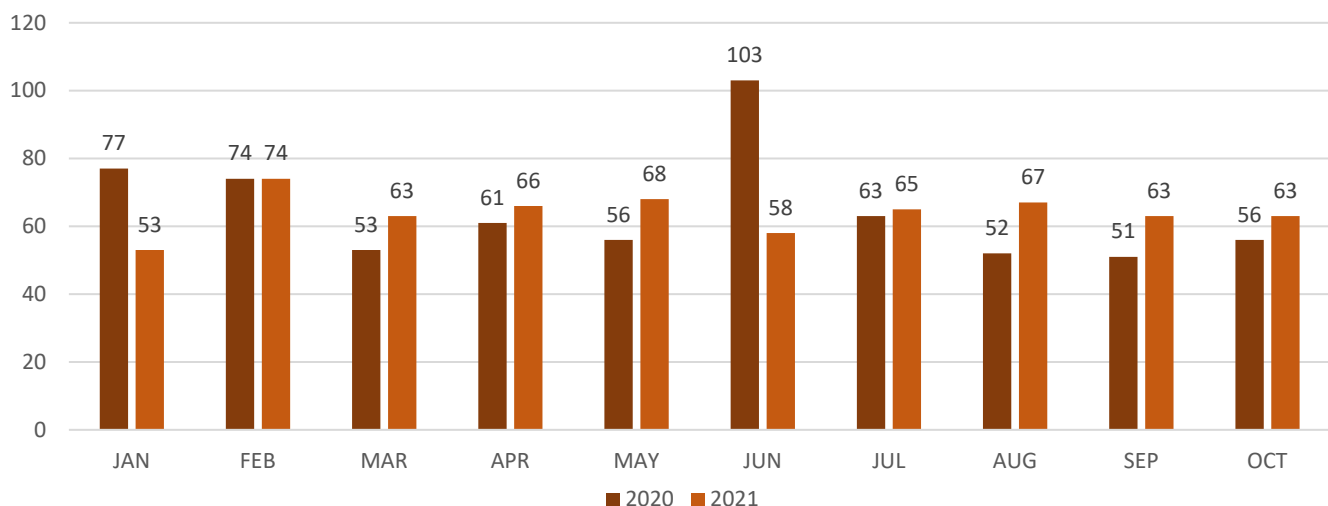
Summary of Complaints Received in October 2021

The Department of Police Accountability received **63** cases in **October 2021**, compared with **56** cases in the same period last year. The **October 2021** case total is **15% higher** than the five-year average and **13% higher** than the previous year.

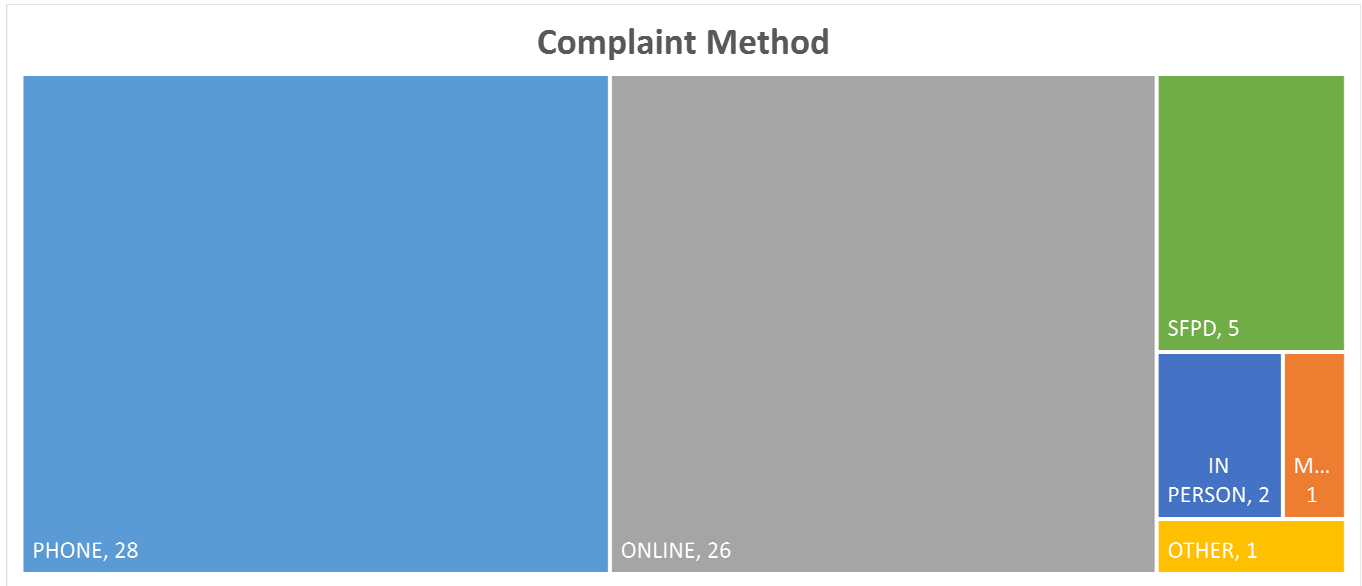
From January through October, the DPA received a total of **658** new cases, compared with the **683** cases filed during the same period in 2020. The October year to date case total represents a **4% decrease** in new complaints over last year.

Most complaints were received over the phone and online.

00048312-21	10/7/2021	Officers prepared an inaccurate incident report and took a statement from a juvenile driver's non-witness parent.
00048315-21	10/7/2021	The Chief of Police is not enforcing laws regarding drug dealing, drug use, and other illegal activities occurring in the Bayview District.
00048319-21	10/8/2021	Officers evicted illegally evicted the complainant.
00048320-21	10/8/2021	The complainant stated there were girls by her home.
00048325-21	10/8/2021	Officers lied to gain entry to the complainant's residence, falsely arrested, failed to Miranderize, refused medical attention, refused to provide a phone call and attorney when in police custody.
00048328-21	10/7/2021	An officer arrested the complainant without cause.
00048340-21	10/11/2021	Officers pulled over the complainant's wife and her cousins for a report of concealing guns. Officers took out their weapons, engaged in unequal treatment, failed to properly deal with the person who made a false criminal complaint.
00048341-21	10/11/2021	Officers detained a juvenile female, used unnecessary force, took unauthorized photos, and a male officer inappropriately and unlawfully pat searched a juvenile female.
00048349-21	10/12/2021	The complainant stated that the officer cursed at him and slammed his door that hurt his leg during a traffic stop.
00048350-21	10/12/2021	The complainant stated that he was denied entrance by apartment staff because of his service dog, and the responding officer was rude, condescending, and wrong about the law.
00048383-21	10/12/2021	The officer mistreated the complainant by only issuing a citation on their car and entering an incorrect date on the citation.
00048385-21	10/13/2021	The complainant stated that he was falsely accused of being a sex offender.

00048388-21	10/13/2021	An officer behaved inappropriately when the complainant asked to park near his residence on a street that was temporarily closed to traffic.

00048391-21	10/14/2021	Officers failed to respond to a call for service promptly. An officer did not accept a citizen's arrest and failed to investigate properly.

00048395-21	10/14/2021	An officer behaved inappropriately and used profanity.
00048400-21	10/15/2021	The officer falsely accused the complainant of stealing a wallet that the complainant found. Then the officer gave the complainant's cash away.
00048401-21	10/15/2021	Officers detained and arrested the complainant without cause, conducted an illegal search, issued a citation without cause, and refused to provide their names and badge numbers.

00048417-21	10/17/2021	Officers neglected to respond to a call for service promptly.
00048418-21	10/16/2021	An officer harassed and accused the complainant of shoplifting at a retail store.
00048420-21	10/18/2021	The officer refused to write an Incident Report because he determined no crime was committed.
00048422-21	10/18/2021	Officers detained the complainant and provided medical treatment without consent.
00048423-21	10/18/2021	Officers failed to act, behaved inappropriately, and entered the home without consent.
00048424-21	10/18/2021	An officer continues to knowingly accept false and erroneous reports.
00048425-21	10/18/2021	The complainant stated his girlfriend called the police for help, but officers did not respond to the scene.
00048430-21	10/19/2021	Officers delayed the complainant's medical treatment by holding him at the incident location.
00048463-21	10/19/2021	The complainant reported witnessing a person damage his car window.
00048472-21	10/21/2021	The complainant stated three security guards assaulted him by forcibly taking him to the ground and handcuffing him. The complainant said he asked a sergeant on the scene for help, but the officer did nothing.
00048479-21	10/22/2021	The complainant stated that he is a San Francisco police officer, and every time he calls the station to speak to his unit's sergeant, the officers that answer the phone act like they don't know the complainant's sergeant.

00048496-21	10/26/2021	Officers during a call of service refused to view video surveillance footage.
00048503-21	10/26/2021	An officer violated the complainant's civil rights when the officer detained the complainant, told the complainant he was under arrest, handcuffed the complainant, and cited the complainant for trespassing.
00048538-21	10/27/2021	Officers took an hour to respond to a call for service involving a threatening individual. When the named officer arrived, he was rude to the staff.
00048539-21	10/27/2021	Officers used excessive force during an incident.
00048540-21	10/27/2021	Officers cited the complainant without cause and violated traffic laws during the traffic stop.
00048541-21	10/27/2021	Merged: The complainant stated that several officers came into his home and handcuffed him. The primary officer made several inappropriate comments, and the complainant was afraid for his safety. The complainant also stated The officer failed to take the complainant's statement regarding an assault, thereby not thoroughly investigating the incident.
00048543-21	10/28/2021	The officer arrested the complainant without cause, failed to explain the reason for the arrest, failed to read a Miranda warning to her promptly, and did not offer her a phone call.
00048544-21	10/28/2021	Officer chased and yelled at an individual.
00048550-21	10/28/2021	The complainant stated that officers entered and searched her residence for weapons regarding her granddaughter's father.
00048554-21	10/28/2021	Officers conducted a pretextual stop, searched the complainant because of racial profiling.
00048555-21	10/29/2021	The officers harassed the complainant and did not treat him fairly because of his race, religion, sexual preference, and disability.
00048557-21	10/29/2021	An officer yelled at parents and teachers during school drop-off and threatened to issue tickets for street cleaning.
