Kevin Griffith, TIDG, provided an update on the vertical development.

Nine architects have been selected for the ten development parcels in Stage 1.

Danielle Butler, TIDG, presented details of development parcels C3.4 and C3.5.

Tom Shaff, Lennar, presented details of parcel C2.2, 178 for-rent apartments and approximately 1,700 sf of retail space.

Michael Garfield, Poly Global, presented parcel C2.3, 76 for-sale units.

Linsey Perlov, Wilson Meany, presented parcel C2.4, 250 rental apartments and 1,192 sf retail space.

Michael Garfield, Poly Global, presented parcel B.1.

Director Richardson asked confirmation of unit count and inclusionary units.

Answer: 542 for-rent units (39 below market inclusionary) and 228 condominiums (11 inclusionary).

Director Tsen asked about financing for projects and about affiliation with Poly Global.

Director Tsen discussed the public experience of the streetscapes and developments and asked about shared landscaping elements.

Director Prochnik asked about sustainability elements of landscaping and option of green roofs and play areas.

Director Prochnik suggested sharing street/building names previously discussed by the TIDA board.

## 5. Discussion of Future Agenda Items by Directors

Bob Beck commented that SFCTA has received notice that a grant they had applied for to help close the funding gap on Westside Bridges will be awarded in the amount of \$18 million.
