5. CIO Update

City Chief Information Officer Linda Gerull presented an overview of the support services of the Department of Technology available as departments return to the office.

6. Resolution Making Findings to Allow Teleconferenced Meetings Under California Government Code Section 54953 (e) (Action Item)

Deputy City Administrator Bukowski introduced a resolution to continue COIT meetings virtually. The resolution was adopted.

7. Digital Accessibility and Inclusion Standard (Action Item)

COIT Policy Analyst Emma Fernandez presented updates to the policy standard for accessibility of the City's digital content based on discussion at last month's COIT meeting.

The committee unanimously approved the standard with the amendment to remove the phrase "or fluent" from the description of bilingual employees on page 4.

8. Surveillance Technology Policy: Juvenile Probation GPS Ankle Monitor Bracelet (Action Item)

Juvenile Probation Director of Research and Planning Maria McKee presented an overview of SCRAM ankle monitor bracelets, which are used in cases of a court order to monitor location.

Natalie Gee noted Supervisor Walton's concerns about use of GPS ankle monitoring, but recognized Juvenile Probation's use of the technology in accordance with court order.

The Juvenile Probation Technology Policy for GPS Ankle Monitor Bracelet was approved to be shared with the Board of Supervisors for review.

9. Surveillance Technology Policy: Elections Nest Camera (Action Item)

COIT Policy Analyst Emma Fernandez presented an overview of Nest cameras, which are used by the Department of Elections to provide a livestream of elections operations to the public and to monitor the voter line at City Hall Voting Center.

The Department of Elections' Surveillance Technology Policy for Nest Camera was approved to be shared with the Board of Supervisors for review.

10. Public Comment

Charles Belle made public comment to suggest that COIT discuss the contract on internet voting for voters with disabilities at a future COIT meeting.
