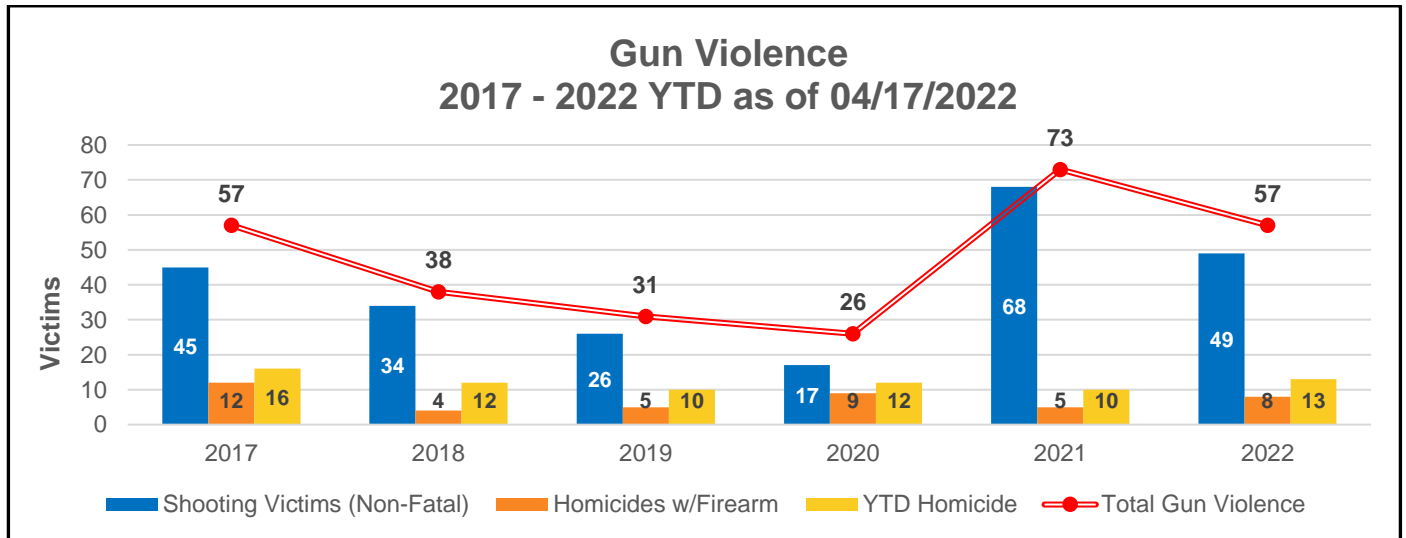

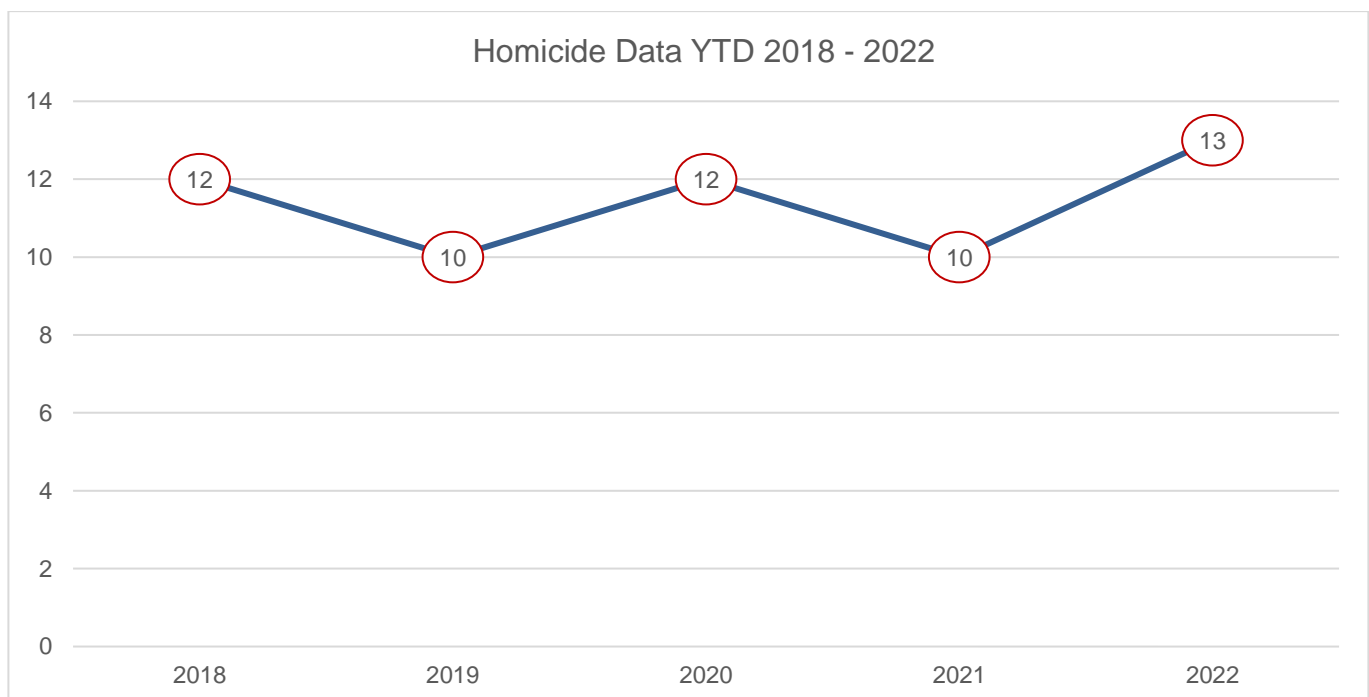
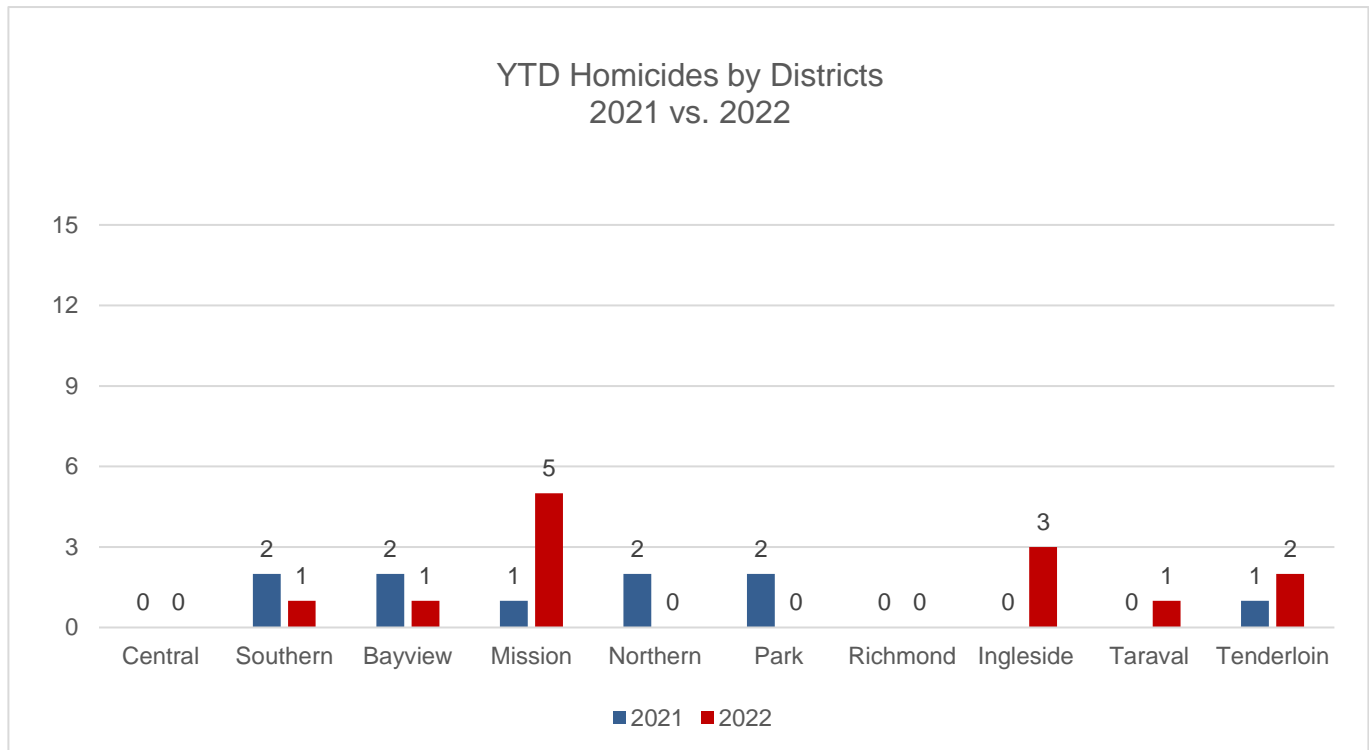
GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 22% compared to 2021

- **There were 3 shooting incidents for the week ending on 04/17/22**
 - There are a total of **49 incidents** resulting in **57 victims** YTD
- **There were NO homicides the week ending on 04/17/2022**
 - There are **13 homicides** YTD with 8 homicides resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 46%**
