**Release defined as a production of records and/or a determination letter. Determination letters generally are a response indicating the department has identified records or has no responsive records for one or more categories of disclosure for a specific officer.

A single PRA may contain requests for multiple categories or multiple officers; therefore, this number is higher than the total number of PRAs. *Case refers to the number of distinct incidents reviewed within the Department's tracking systems for use of force tracking and administrative investigation tracking.
