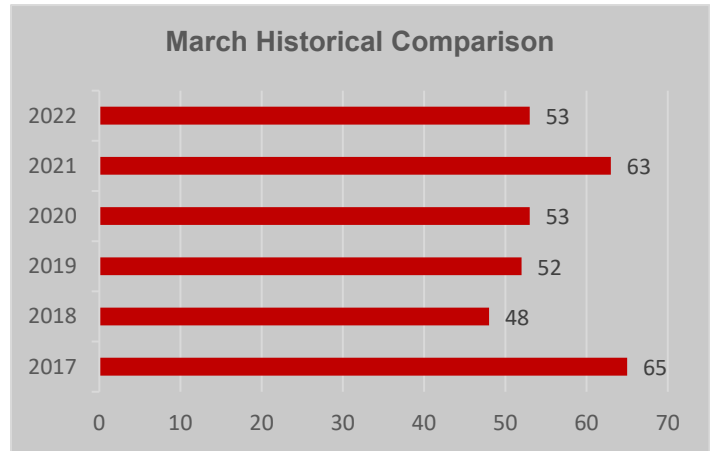

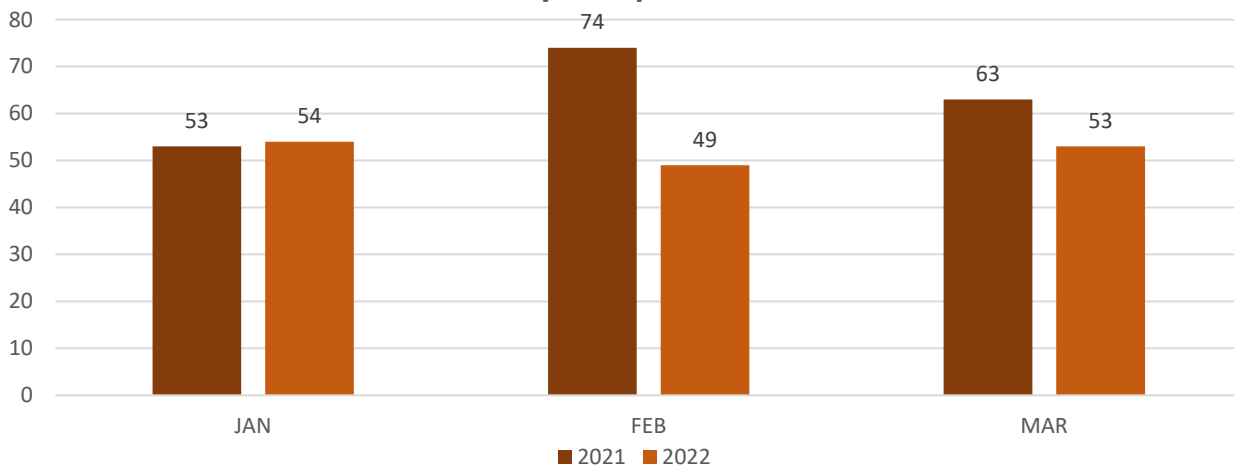
Summary of Complaints Received in March 2022

The Department of Police Accountability received **53** cases in **March 2022**, compared with **63** cases in the same period last year. The **March 2022** case total is **5%** lower than the five-year average and **16%** lower than the previous year.

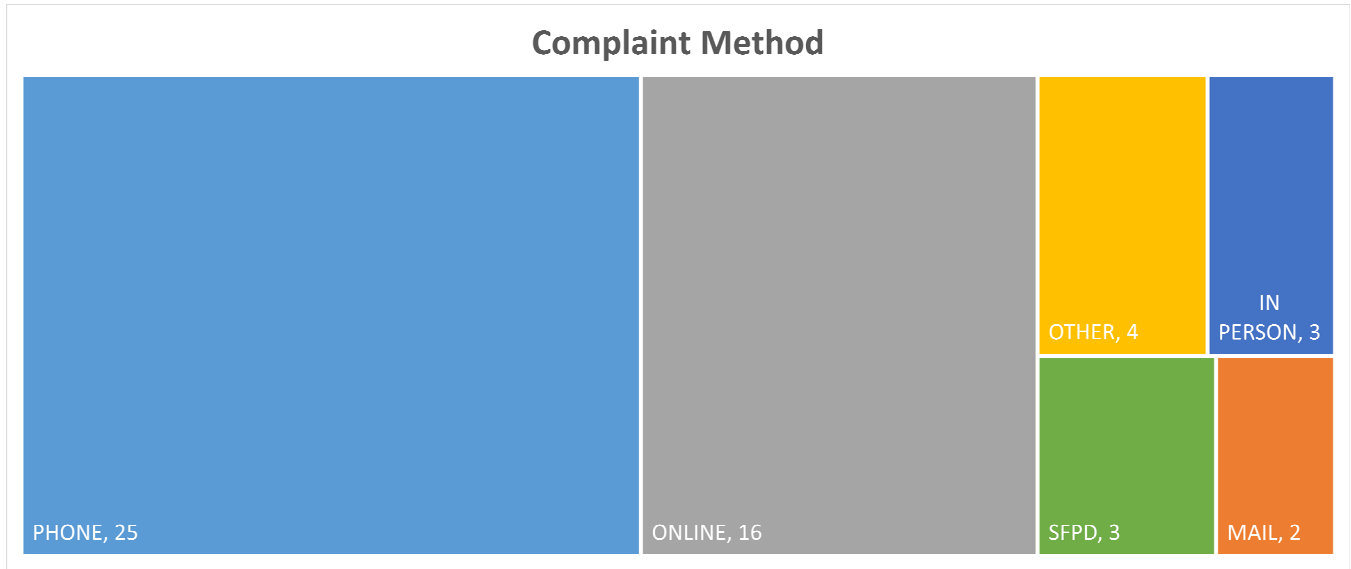
From January through March, the DPA received a total of **159** new cases, compared with the **200** cases filed during the same period in 2021. The March year to date case total represents a **21%** decrease in new complaints over last year.

Most complaints were received over the phone and online.

CASE	RECEIVED	SUMMARY
00049989-22	3/1/2022	Complainant reported that an officer failed to take an incident report and made an inappropriate statement regarding a hit-and-run incident which resulted in property damage to a vehicle.
00050025-22	3/2/2022	An officer threatened to handcuff the complainant and remove their belongings from a restaurant if they did not leave.
00050036-22	3/2/2022	Officers used unnecessary force during a drug-bust operation and wrote an inaccurate report.
00050037-22	3/3/2022	The complainant contacted the San Francisco Police Department to get assistance because the complainant's husband cancelled her credit cards. The officer said they had better things to do than deal with the complainant's complaint.
00050038-22	3/3/2022	The officer did not like the complainant's reaction to him and gave her a ticket in retaliation. The officer would not provide the name and badge number of another officer.
00050048-22	3/3/2022	The officer did not use the turn signal when the officer made a right turn.
00050051-22	3/3/2022	Officers illegally park their personal vehicles on the red curb in front of the Central Station.
00050054-22	3/3/2022	The officer did not arrest the security guards who injured the complainant's hand and wrist.
00050119-22	3/3/2022	The officer did not properly curb the wheels of the police vehicle.
00050039-22	3/4/2022	The officer gave unclear instructions while directing traffic. The officer pulled the complainant over, spoke to her rudely and displayed insensitivity while she was crying.
00050040-22	3/4/2022	The complainant stated that he called 911 and reported that people were camping on the sidewalk and blocking both the sidewalk and a driveway but the officers never responded.
00050041-22	3/5/2022	The officer told the complainant that he could not sit on the bench outside or loiter around the station because he looked suspicious.
00050053-22	3/7/2022	The officers failed to take action against the complainant's neighbor for double parking and blocking her driveway.
00050100-22	3/10/2022	An officer banged on the complainant's vehicle and left a note that he was in violation of parking laws
00050188-22	3/10/2022	Complainant states a person in his apartment building has been arrested numerous times for violent offenses but has not been charged.
00050104-22	3/11/2022	Officers spoke to the complainant in a condescending, disrespectful, and offensive manner.
00050127-22	3/12/2022	The complainant and his friend heard the officer relaying his private information as they were driving by.
00050109-22	3/14/2022	The complainant alleged a San Francisco Customs officer made discourteous statements and acted in a discourteous manner toward an ethnic ground.
00050112-22	3/14/2022	The complainant alleged the San Francisco Police Department officers conducted an inappropriate and warrantless search on her home. The involved officers allegedly made rude comments to the complainant and her mother. Also, the complainant alleged an the San Francisco Police Department officer placed an inappropriate tracking device on her vehicle.
00050120-22	3/14/2022	The complainant was assaulted. Complainant alleges when the San Francisco Police Department arrived at the scene, they conducted an improper investigation and drafted an inaccurate incident report. Also, the complainant alleged the assigned investigating officer failed to properly investigate the incident.
00050121-22	3/15/2022	Merge: The officer prepared an inaccurate citation and input inaccurate information into an incident report.
00050122-22	3/15/2022	An off -duty officer passed by the complaints residence and made a jealous comment.
00050123-22	3/15/2022	Officers asked the complainant to exit his apartment while undressed and handcuffed him in earshot of his neighbors.
00050158-22	3/15/2022	Misconduct related to a rape case.
00050166-22	3/17/2022	The complainant stated that after waiting 10 days, he was still unable to get a copy of an Incident Report from a district station. The complainant also stated that he was illegally searched. The charges were dropped and he was released but his property was not released.
00050167-22	3/17/2022	The complainant stated that officers assaulted her son at a local market. The officers then went to her home and served her with a search warrant and conducted an illegal search.
00050170-22	3/18/2022	An officer acted rudely toward the complainant who was parked and sitting in their vehicle.
00050173-22	3/18/2022	Complainant feels targeted by officers who have removed the complainant from various hotels without consent.
00050174-22	3/18/2022	Officers painted a false narrative with respect to a previous homicide case.
00050184-22	3/21/2022	The complainant stated that two officers used unnecessary force by grabbing her arms, slamming her face into the ground and kneeling on her body in order to remove her from a CVS store.

00050187-22	3/22/2022	Complainant stated he and a friend were involved in a hit and run vehicle incident and officers initially refused to respond to the scene. When the officers arrived at the scene, the Complainant alleges the officers engaged in biased policing based on race, the officers failed to investigate the incident, made inappropriate comments and threatened to arrest the complainant for interfering with the investigation.
00050190-22	3/22/2022	Officers failed to respond to a call for service the San Francisco Police Department did not inform complainant about storage fees for towed recovered stolen vehicle.
00050191-22	3/22/2022	vehicle.
00050194-22	3/22/2022	The complainant stated there was no police follow up on previous reported cases. The complainant stated officers violated the smoking ordinance. When he brought it to their attention, the complainant was told to leave in an intimidating manner.

00050226-22	3/23/2022	An officer used bias policing to detain a juvenile without justification. Officers failed to detain complainant's ex-partner on a mental health detention and behaved in a discourteous manner.

00050233-22	3/23/2022	The complainant alleged she was unlawfully arrested and her property was taken. Complainant alleged an the San Francisco Police Department officer spoke with her inappropriately after she filed a complaint against him. Also, the complainant alleged the San Francisco Police Department officers inappropriately followed her.
00050232-22	3/24/2022	The officer failed to investigate a vehicle theft.
00050234-22	3/24/2022	The officer behaved in a discourteous manner.
00050235-22	3/24/2022	The officer failed to properly investigate and within a timely manner.
00050237-22	3/25/2022	The officer made an inappropriate comment.
00050238-22	3/25/2022	Officers failed to take complainant's statement while investigating a domestic violence incident. On two other occasions, complainant called 911 and officers failed to respond to her apartment to investigate.
00050239-22	3/25/2022	The officer harassed the complainant.
00050242-22	3/27/2022	The complainant stated an officer refused to take his complaint or provide him with forms to fill out.
00050241-22	3/28/2022	Complainant states an officer parked blocking a fire hydrant
00050249-22	3/28/2022	Complainant stated he is being harassed
00050251-22	3/28/2022	The officer parked a vehicle and failed to properly curb the vehicle's wheels. The complainant pointed out this issue to the officer and was ignored.
00050252-22	3/28/2022	The officer parked a vehicle and did not properly curb the wheels. The officer ignored the complainant when the complainant pointed out the issue.
00050294-22	3/29/2022	The complainant stated she observed someone slumped over in a vehicle. She tried to flag down officers in a patrol vehicle and they ignored her.
00050293-22	3/30/2022	The officer acted improperly when he threatened the complainant and refused to provide service.
00050297-22	3/30/2022	The officer did not curb his unmarked police vehicle even though the vehicle was facing uphill.
00050292-22	3/31/2022	The complainant alleged she was struck in the face. She alleged an officer assigned to investigate the incident stated there was not enough evidence to pursue charges but the officer's reasoning not to pursue charges were incorrect.
