1. Call to Order and Roll Call

The Redistricting Task Force met in special session, in-person with remote access and public comment via telephone and videoconference, on Thursday, April 21, 2022. Chair Reverend Arnold Townsend called the meeting to order at 12:21 p.m.

On the call of the roll, Chair Townsend, Member Jeremy Lee, Member Hernández Gil, Member Pierce, Member Castillon, Member Ho, Member Cooper, Member Chasel Lee, and Member Reiner were noted present.

A quorum was present.

2. Mapping; Final Draft Map

Jaime Clark, Redistricting Consultant (Q2 Data and Research); conducted the live line drawing and answered questions raised throughout the discussion. Andrew Shen, Deputy City Attorney (Office of the City Attorney); answered questions raised throughout the discussion.

Member Pierce, seconded by Member Hernández Gil, moved that the Task Force begin live line drawing with Map 7. The motion failed by the following vote:

- Add the Dogpatch neighborhood to District 10;
- Add the area around the San Francisco Zoo to District 7, with a northern boundary at Sloat Boulevard;
- Add the area bounded by Gough Street, Eddy Street, Laguna Street, and Golden Gate Avenue to District 5;
- Add the area bounded by Dr. Tom Waddell Place, Polk Street, Van Ness Avenue, and Grove Street to District 5;
- Add one block west of Edgewood Avenue in Parnassus Heights to District 8;
- Add one block east of Arguello Boulevard south of Frederick Street to District 8;
- Add the area south of the CPMC Mission Bernal Campus between Guerrero Street and Tiffany Avenue to District 9; and
- Add the area south of Silver Avenue to Cambridge Street to McLaren Park to District 11.

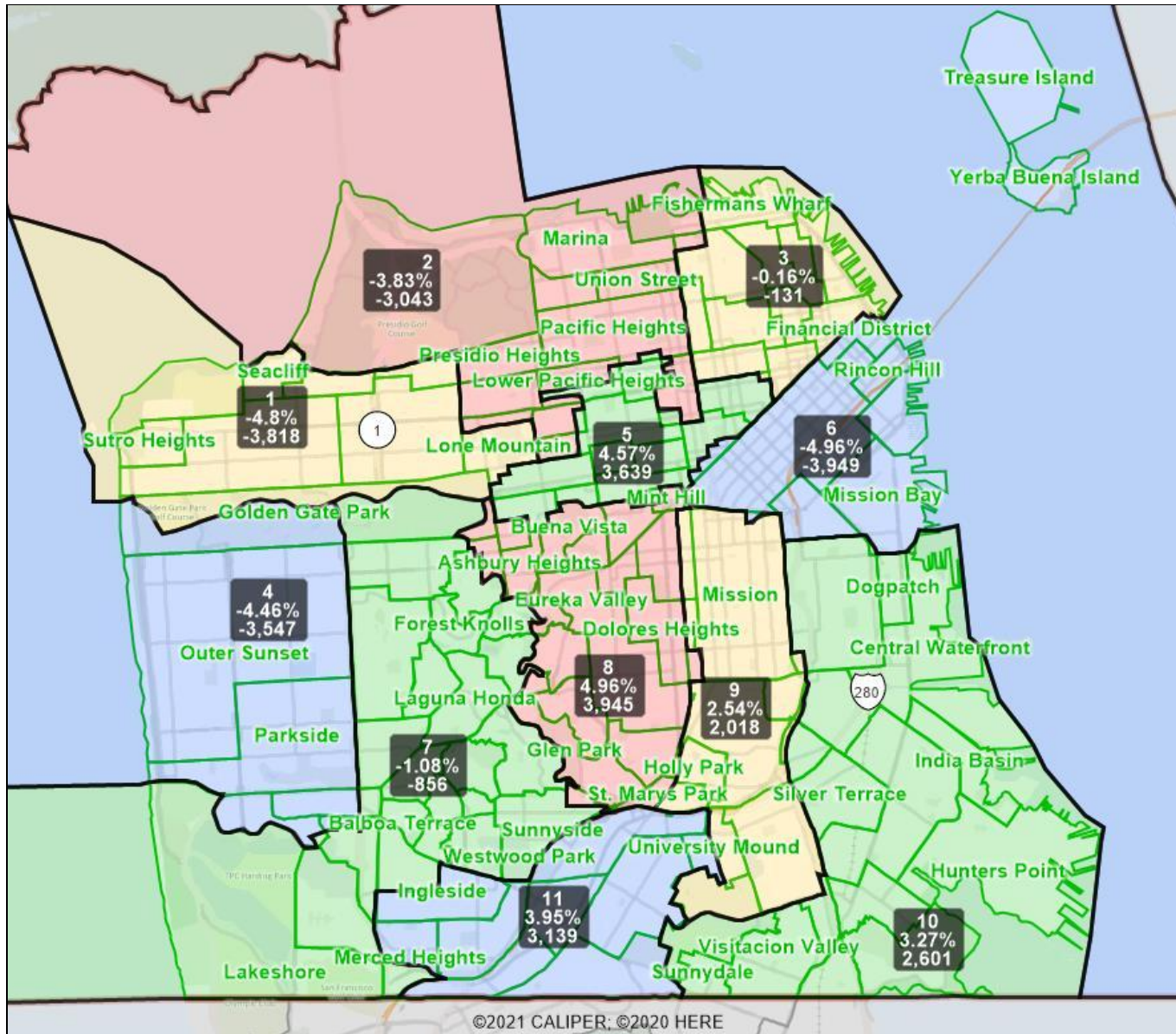
