The Subcommittee revisited the resolution. It seeks to improve the data available about the unhoused, encourage participation from a broader set of stakeholders, and to improve equity, e.g., for people of color. Some stakeholders worry that available data is not being fully utilized; however, it was agreed that the phrase "but does not disclose" should be stricken.

Member comment: Member Rachowicz wanted to clarify what is being asked of the City. Certainly, nothing is intentionally hidden. Also, significant steps are underway to improve equity, e.g., HSH hired an equity director and is improving their dashboard.

III NEW BUSINESS

DISCUSSION/ACTION

A. NAVIGATION CENTERS Subcommittee Chair Avalos 15 min

The Subcommittee discussed Navigation Centers. SMC Membership is down. There are eight Nav Centers if the TAY is included; more may be coming online eventually. It is not prudent to move too fast. To assess what the Committee is realistically able to do in the short term, the Subcommittee decided to recommend that the SMC Members undertake to participate in: (1) the monthly virtual (Teams) meeting that HSH has with all shelters; (2) Navigation Center tours hosted by HSH; and (3) one pilot inspection at each Navigation Center.

B. ENCOURAGING PROFESSIONALISM IN SHELTER STAFF Subcommittee 15 min

The Subcommittee discussed ways to impact the performance of shelter staff. Contracts call for a minimum training regimen. The SMC cannot take direct action, e.g., increase wages, but more inspections and training (e.g., on conflict resolution) would be realistic options.

Public comment: Kaleese Street stated that, based on personal experience, site visits are "motivational." More training would be good. Many shelter employees work out of conviction more than for the pay. Some are worried about safety; the possibility that safety could be improved might be even more motivational than increased pay.
