### **Additional Data**

SF ACC placed **131** animals in foster homes during this quarter

Fostered: 117 cats, 10 dogs, 4 others (3 guinea pigs, 1 rabbit). Many of these fostered animals went on to be adopted from us, while many other animals were transferred to our adoption partners

ACOs responded to 2,950 emergency calls for service this quarter

9 Cats were transported to the Feral Fix/Community Cat Program

(NOTE: Members of the public are instructed to bring feral cats directly to SPCA for their Community Cats program. SF ACC only tracks animals which are impounded at SF ACC and then transported to Community Cats.)

#### **Partner Transfers: 156 cats, 141 dogs, 207 others**

141 others to unpaid partners: 43 pigeons, 28 hamsters, 11 turtles, 9 guinea pigs, 8 chickens, 6 frogs, 4 opossums, 3 chinchillas, 1 goat, and 28 other birds and mammals and reptiles

66 birds and wildlife animals sent to paid partner PHS

#### **Euthanized: 52 cats, 68 dogs, 180 others = 300 animals**

223 Euthanized for Medical Conditions

39 cats, 17 dogs, 167 others

Others = 60 pigeons, 35 raccoons, 15 rats, 12 gulls, 8 skunks, 37 other birds, reptiles, and mammals

28 Euthanized for Behavior Concerns
