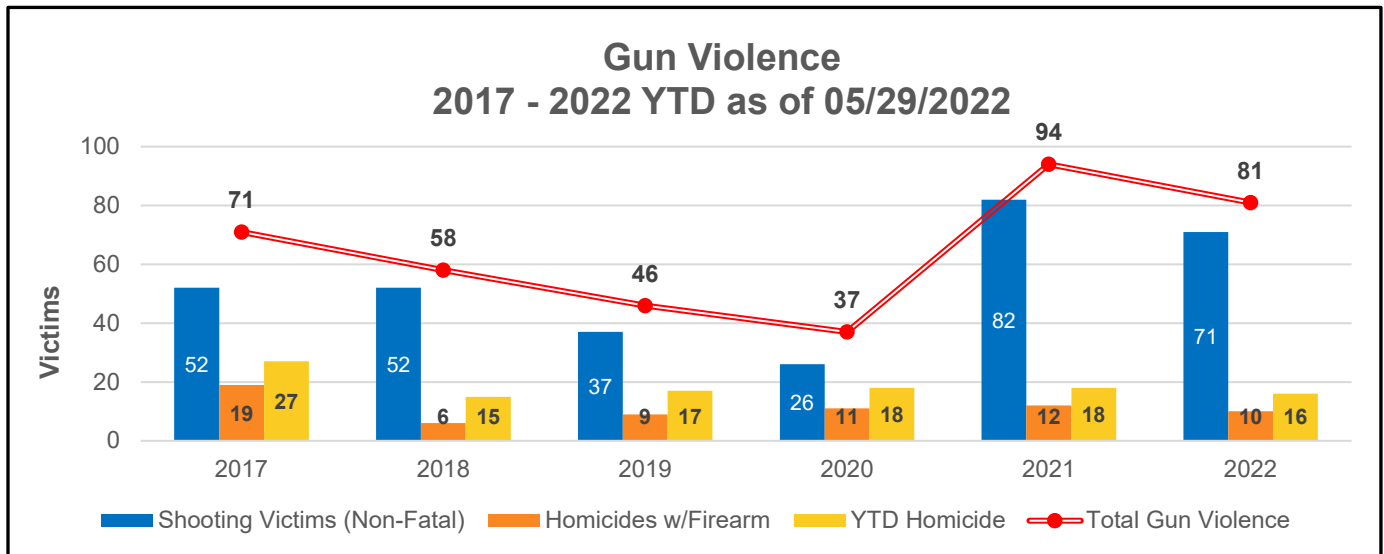

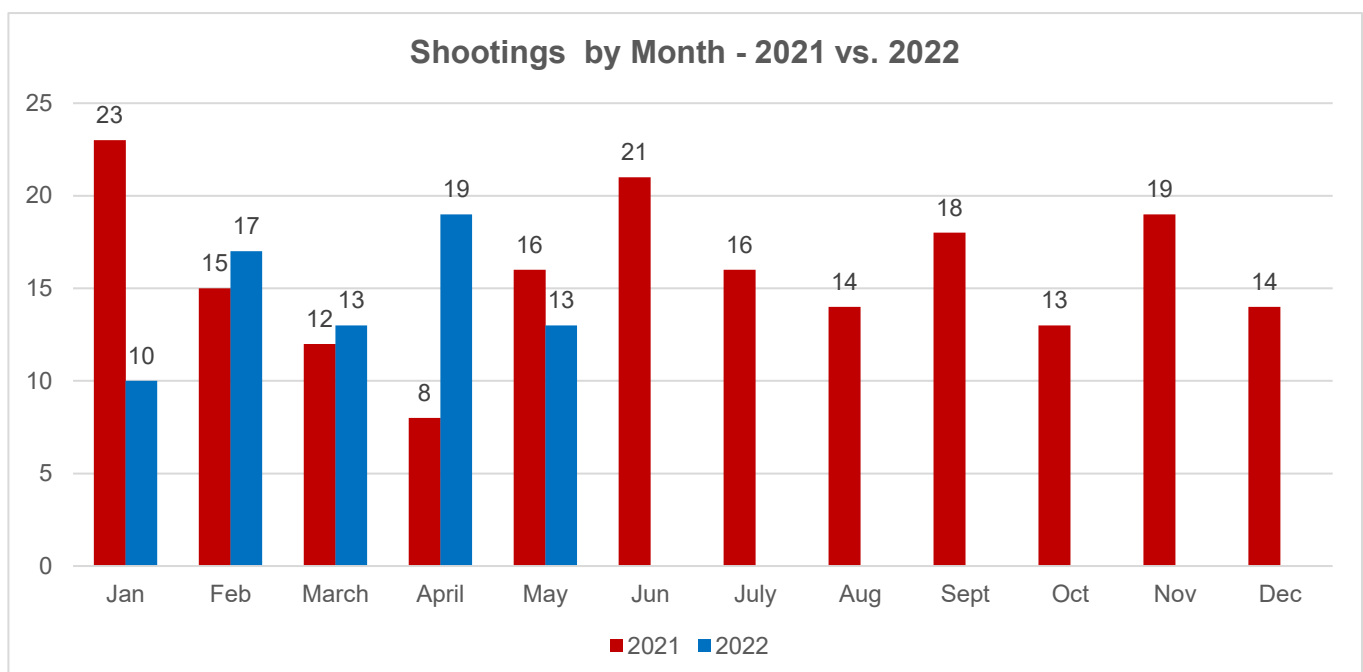

**GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 14% compared to 2021**

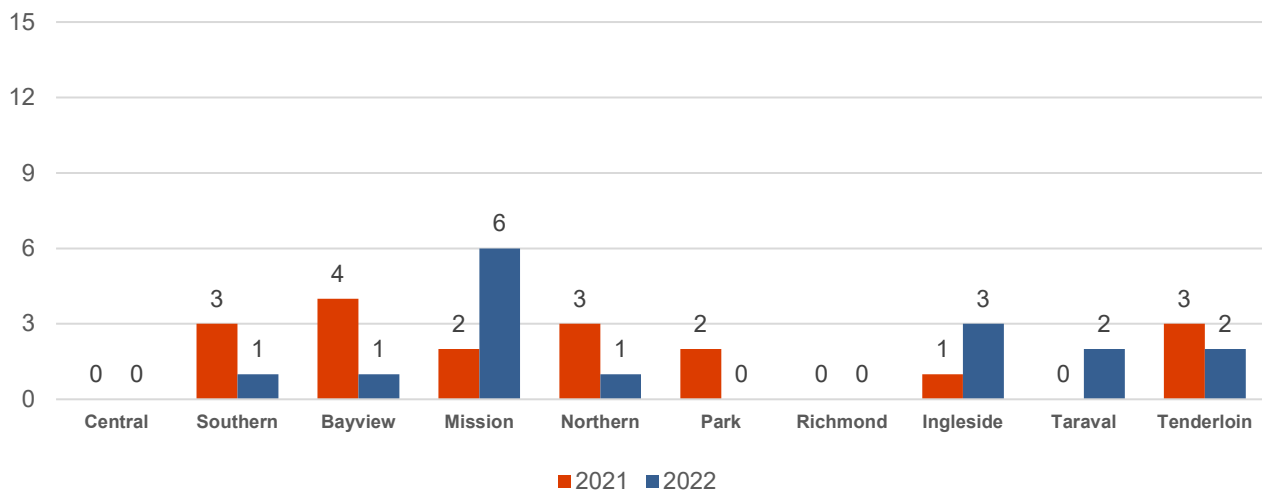
- There were 6 shooting incidents for the week ending on 05/29/22
  - There are a total of 72 incidents resulting in 81 victims YTD
- There were NO homicides the week ending on 05/29/2022
  - There are 16 homicides YTD with 10 homicides resulting from a firearm.
    - Overall Clearance Rate: 50%

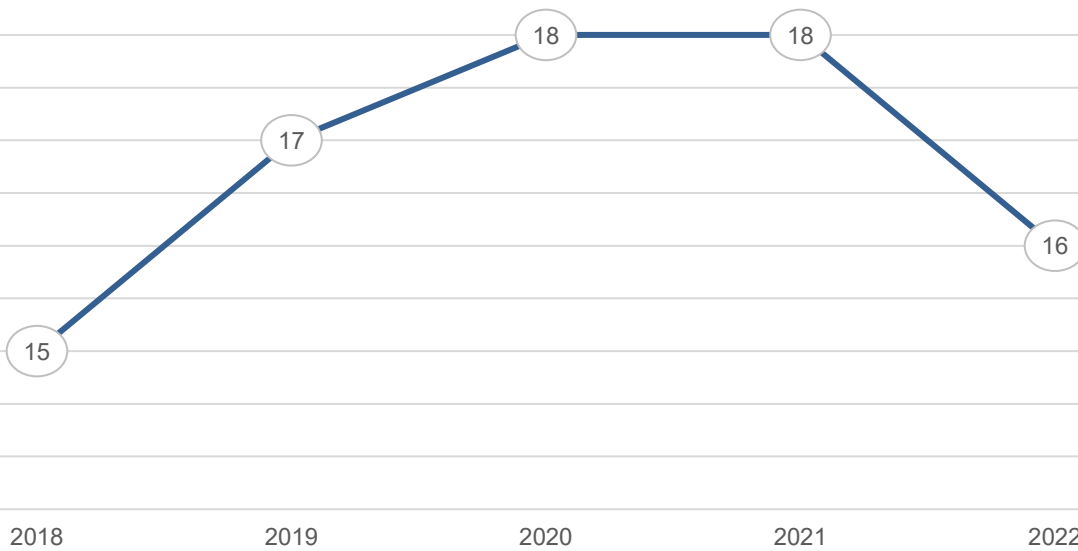
