 of how to correctly complete citations involving LIDAR/RADAR to avoid the invalidation of traffic
 citations.
- 22-009 <u>Find Assigned Investigator</u>; The purpose of this notice is to inform members of a new feature in Crime Data Warehouse ("CDW").
