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

WHAT IS AN EARLY INTERVENTION SYSTEM?

- Identifies Members who were involved in activity types proven to increase stress
- Provides Members with resources and tools
- Mechanism for ensuring police accountability PRIOR to adverse events

The Early Intervention System is **NOT** about warning supervisors about problem officers, but rather a way to help officers **BEFORE** they experience an adverse event.

CURRENT ALERT THRESHOLDS



- 1+ Officer-Involved Shooting/Officer-Involved Discharge
- 3+ Use of Force Incidents in a 3-month period
- 3+ DPA complaints in a 6-month period
- Any 5+ indicators in a 6-month period
- 4+ DPA complaints in a 12-month period
- Any 6+ indicators in a 12-month period

EARLY INTERVENTION SYSTEM (EIS) ALERT



An EIS Alert is generated when a Member reaches numerical thresholds of predefined activity types in certain time periods. The Administrative Investigations Management (AIM) application generates alerts each month. Generated alerts are validated by analysts, then forwarded to the EIS Sergeant every other month for review.




COMPLETING A QUARTERLY REPORT

- Finalizing all Use of Force incident documentation can take up to two weeks past the close of the last reporting month.
- Supporting data and documentation obtained from all areas included in the Quarterly Report (UOF, DPA, IAD, HRMS/Staff Services, EVOC, DABOR, etc.).





*Alerts are generated every month and sent out to stations during the following months: February, April, June, August, October, December. Only the most recent alert is sent to the officer's unit. Please note that the EIS Unit records both alerts for data-tracking purposes.
