#### Sole Source:

The contract is authorized under section 21.42 of the Administrative Code. The contract with Regents of the University of California/SF recruit, train, and support a cadre of Emergency Department based clinical champions who will advocate for enhanced and expanded substance use assessment and navigation across 7 San Francisco hospitals, while providing ongoing training and orientation to ED staff.

# **Other Significant Issues:**

Funds will be used for fellowship stipends to fund clinician champion time. Each champion selected for the fellowship will attend meetings at least monthly with the fellowship group, develop any necessary hospital workflows, and engage key hospital stakeholders. Their work will include both expansion of medication-assisted treatment access at the hospital and implementation of overdose prevention programs at their hospital.

Contractor will also support site visits to individual hospitals, site visits to outpatient clinics and residential programs, onsite trainings at each hospital, and expenses for in-person meetings of the fellowship.
