SEC. 67.29-6. Sources of Outside Funding

No official or employee or agent of the city shall accept, allow to be collected, or direct or influence the spending of, any money, or any goods or services worth more than one hundred dollars in aggregate, for the purpose of carrying out or assisting any City function unless the amount and source of all such funds is disclosed as public record and made available on the website for the department to which the funds are directed. When such funds are provided or managed by an entity, and not an individual, that entity must agree in writing to abide by this ordinance. The disclosure shall include the names of all individuals or organizations contributing such money and a statement as to any financial interest the contributor has involving the City

GRATUITY POLICY

(Supersedes Department Bulletin 07-250)

Members are reminded that they shall adhere to the Department gratuity policy pursuant to D.G.O. 2.01, General Rules of Conduct, section 27 reads as follows:

27. GIFTS, PRESENTS, COMPENSATION, REWARDS. Members shall not solicit or accept any gift, compensation or reward for the performance of their duties, except with the permission of the Police Commission. When offered money or gifts for police services (other than monies received pursuant to section 10 B.1 of the City Administrative Code), members who wish to accept the money or gift being offered shall submit a written report to their commanding officer. The report shall include a request for permission to accept the money or gifts and include the date the offer was made, the name and address of the donor and a brief description of the services rendered. Commanding officers shall forward these reports through channels to the Police Commission. The Commission may grant or deny the member permission to accept all or part of the money or gifts.
