SF ACC placed 376 animals in foster homes during this quarter
Fostered: 347 cats, 18 dogs, 11 others ( 9 guinea pigs, 2 rabbits). Many of these fostered animals went on to be adopted from us, while many other animals were transferred to our adoption partners

ACOs responded to 3,024 emergency calls for service this quarter
4 Cats were transported to the Feral Fix/Community Cat Program
