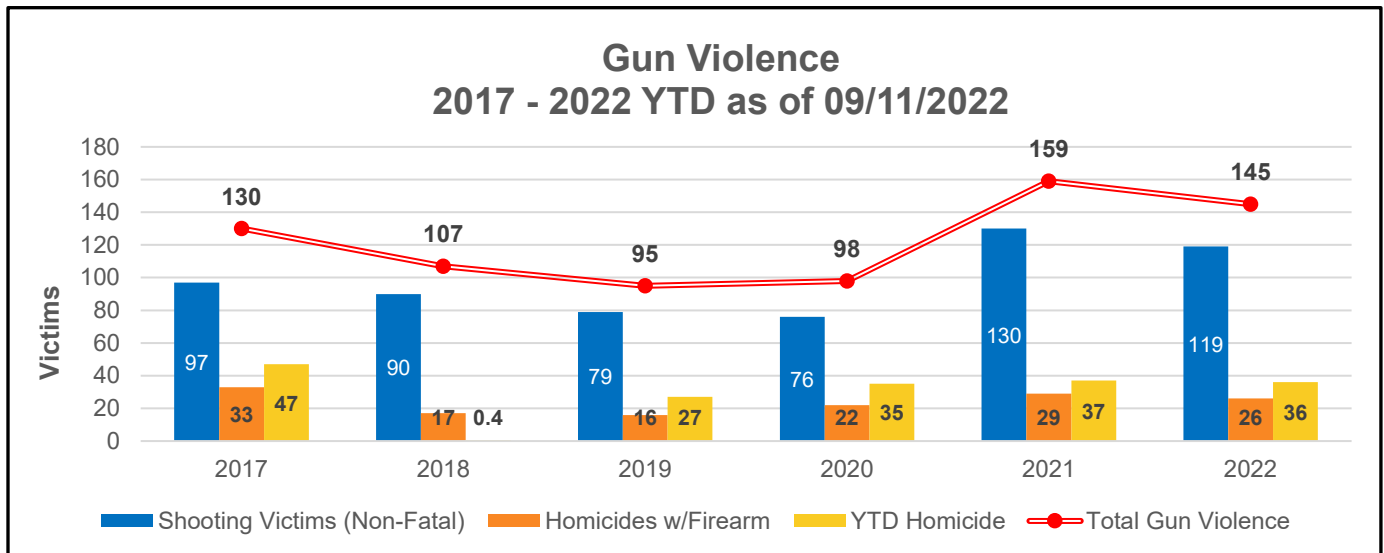

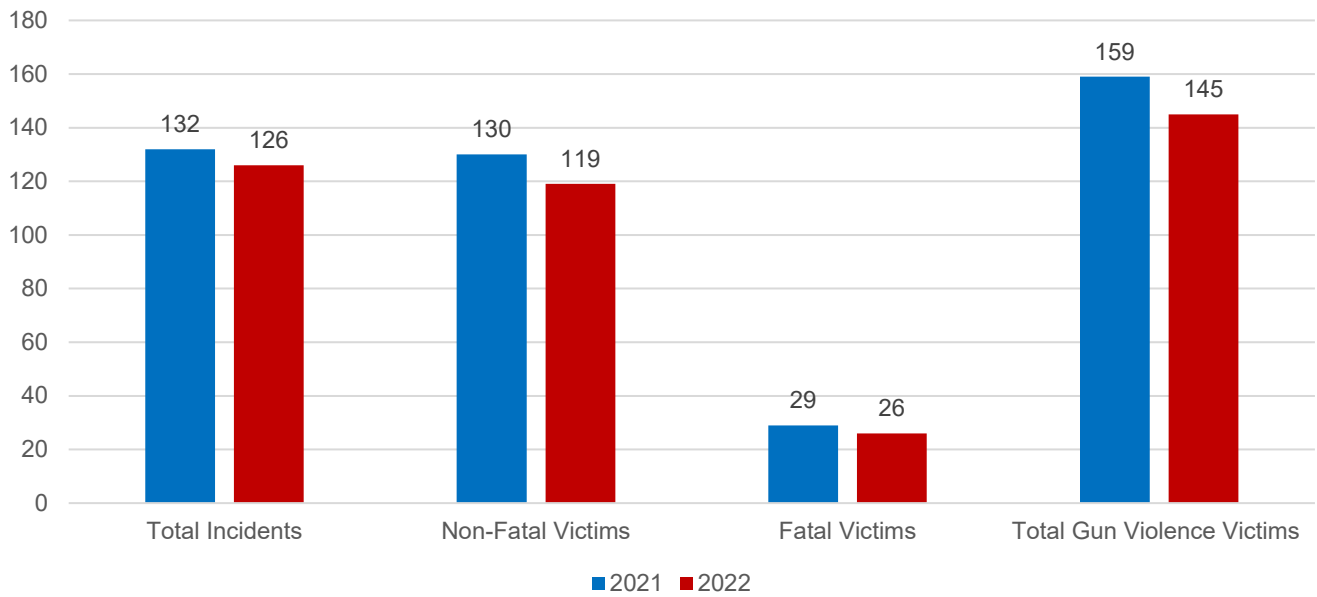

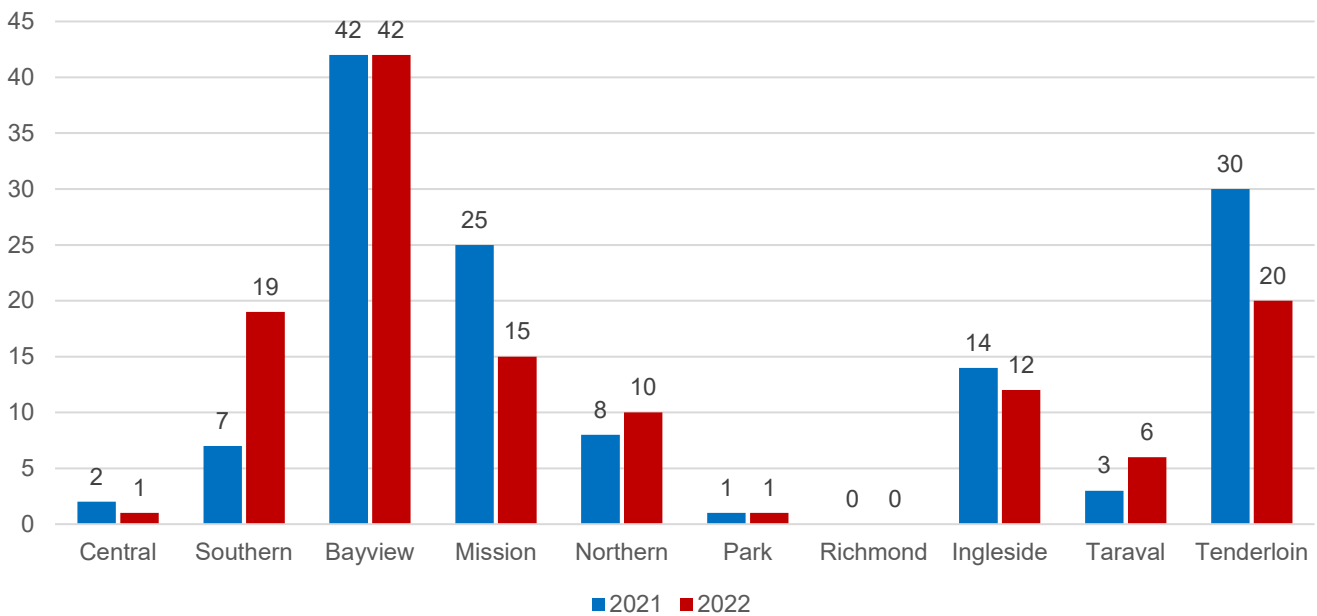
GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 9% compared to 2021

- There were **3 shooting incidents** causing injuries to **3 individuals** for the week ending **09/11/22**
 - There are a total of **126 incidents** resulting in **145 victims** YTD
- There were **2 homicide incidents** the week ending on **09/11/2022**
 - There are **36 homicides** YTD with **26 incidents** resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 62%**

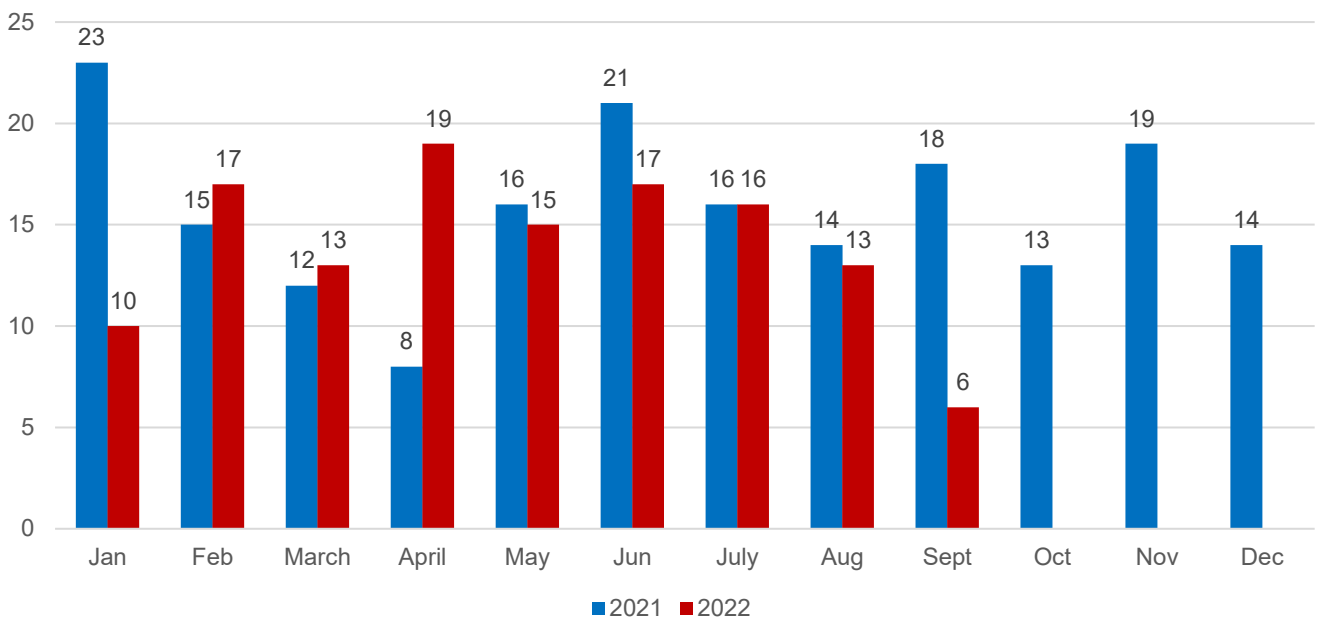
Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2021 vs. 2022



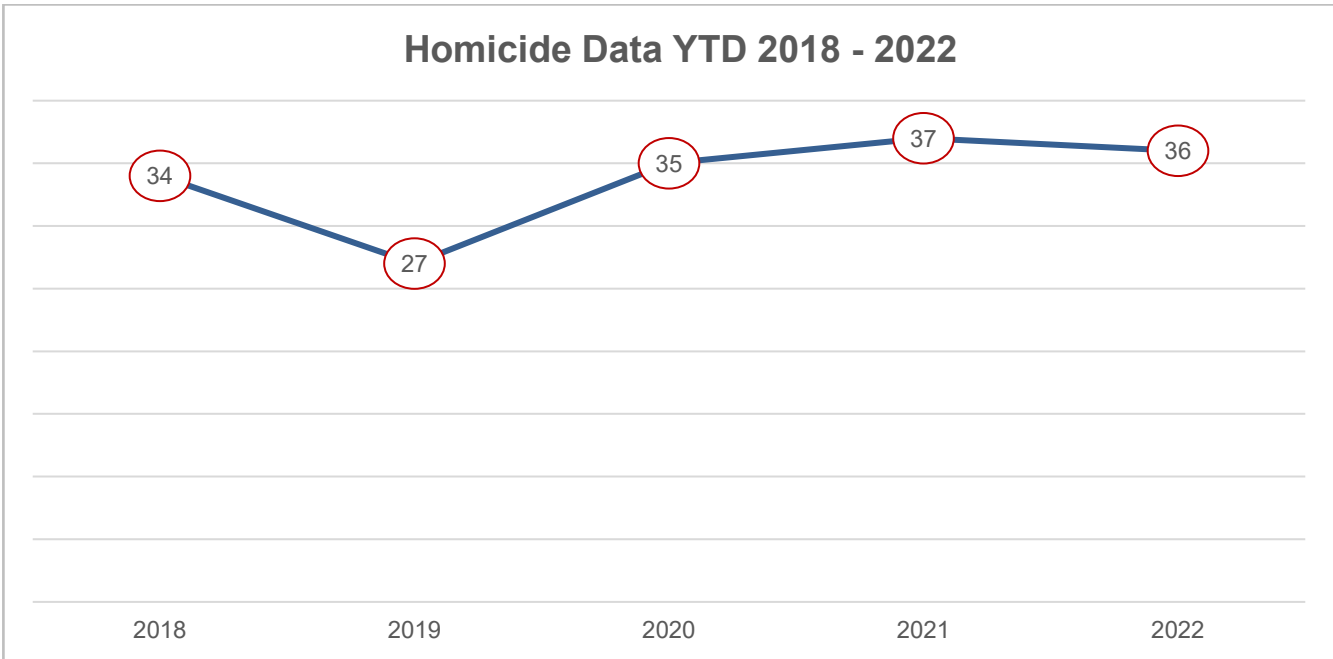
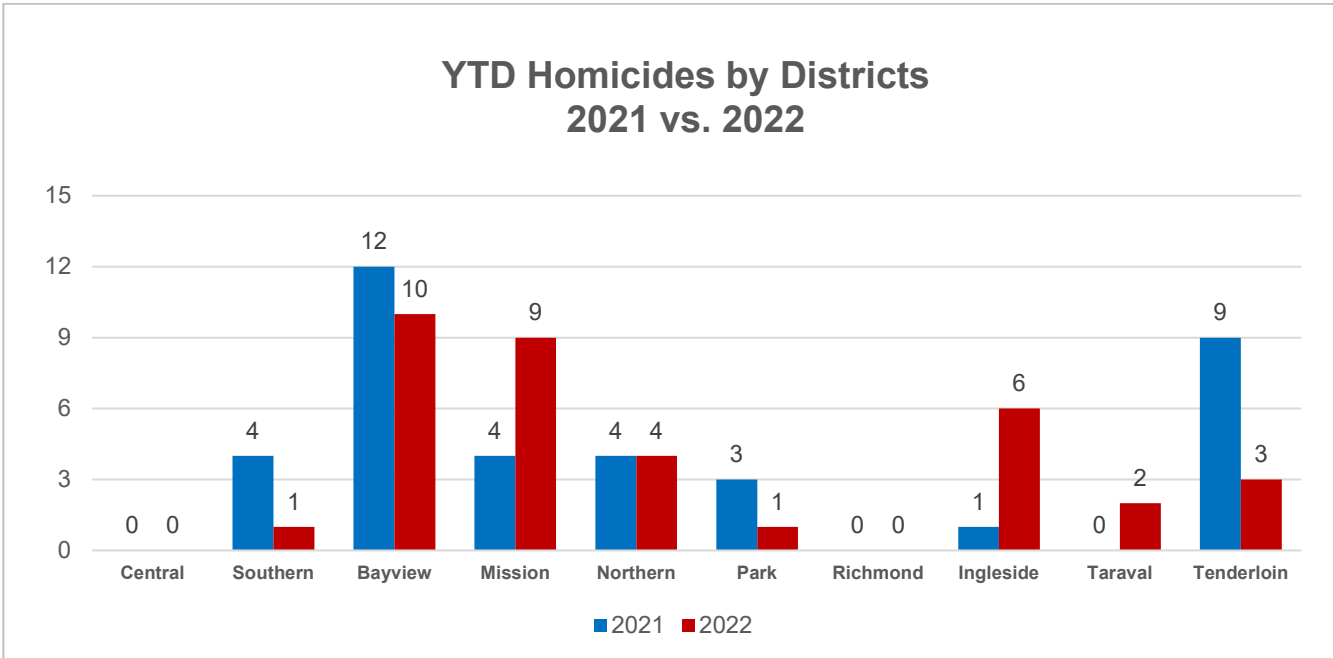
Shootings YTD by District Station - 2021 vs. 2022
