


Summary of Complaints Received in June 2022

The Department of Police Accountability received 44 cases in June 2022, compared with 58 cases in the same period last year. The June 2022 case total is 34% lower than the five-year average and 24% lower than the previous year.


From January through June, the DPA received a total of **336** new cases, compared with the **397** cases filed during the same period in 2021. The June year to date case total represents a **15%** decrease in new complaints over last year.

Most complaints were received over the phone and online.
