Myong Leigh served on the 2011 San Francisco Redistricting Task Force as an appointee of the Mayor. He also served as a staff member of the San Francisco Unified School District for twenty-two years, including fifteen years as its Deputy Superintendent of Policy and Operations.

At SFUSD, Mr. Leigh oversaw the district's business services, facilities, information technology, student nutrition, school enrollment, transportation, policy and planning and government relations teams.
