


### **GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 2% compared to 2021**

- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 individuals for the week ending 10/09/22
  - o There are a total of 145 incidents resulting in 167 victims
- There were no homicide incidents the week ending on 10/09/22
  - o There are **40 homicides** YTD with **27** incidents resulting from a firearm.
    - Overall Clearance Rate: 61%




