


GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 1% compared to 2021

- There were 7 shooting incidents causing injuries to 8 individuals for the week ending 10/16/22
 - o There are a total of 152 incidents resulting in 175 victims
- There were 2 homicide incidents reported the week ending on 10/16/22
 - o There are **42 homicides** YTD with **28** incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 61%




