


#### **GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 4% compared to 2021**

- There were 5 shooting incidents causing injuries to 5 individuals for the week ending 10/02/22
  - o There are a total of 142 incidents resulting in 164 victims
- There was 1 homicide incident the week ending on 10/02/22
  - o There are **40 homicides** YTD with **27** incidents resulting from a firearm.
    - Overall Clearance Rate: 55%




