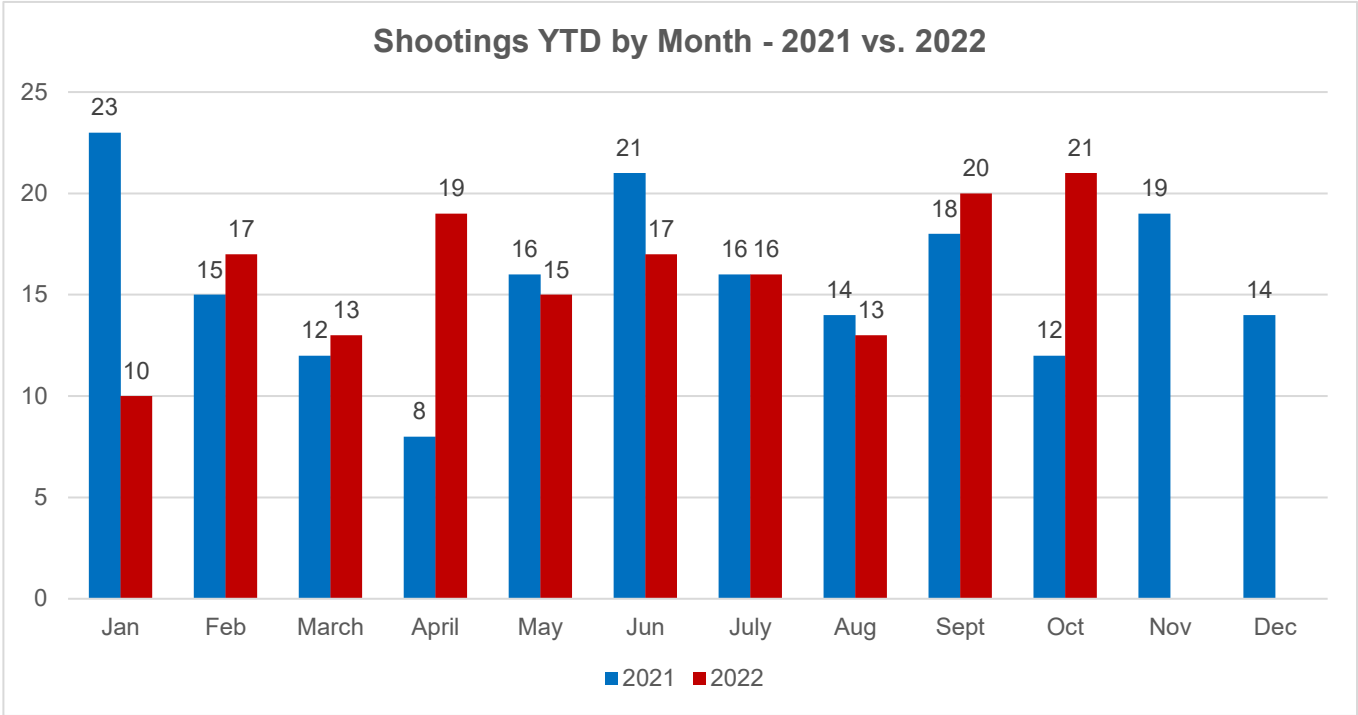

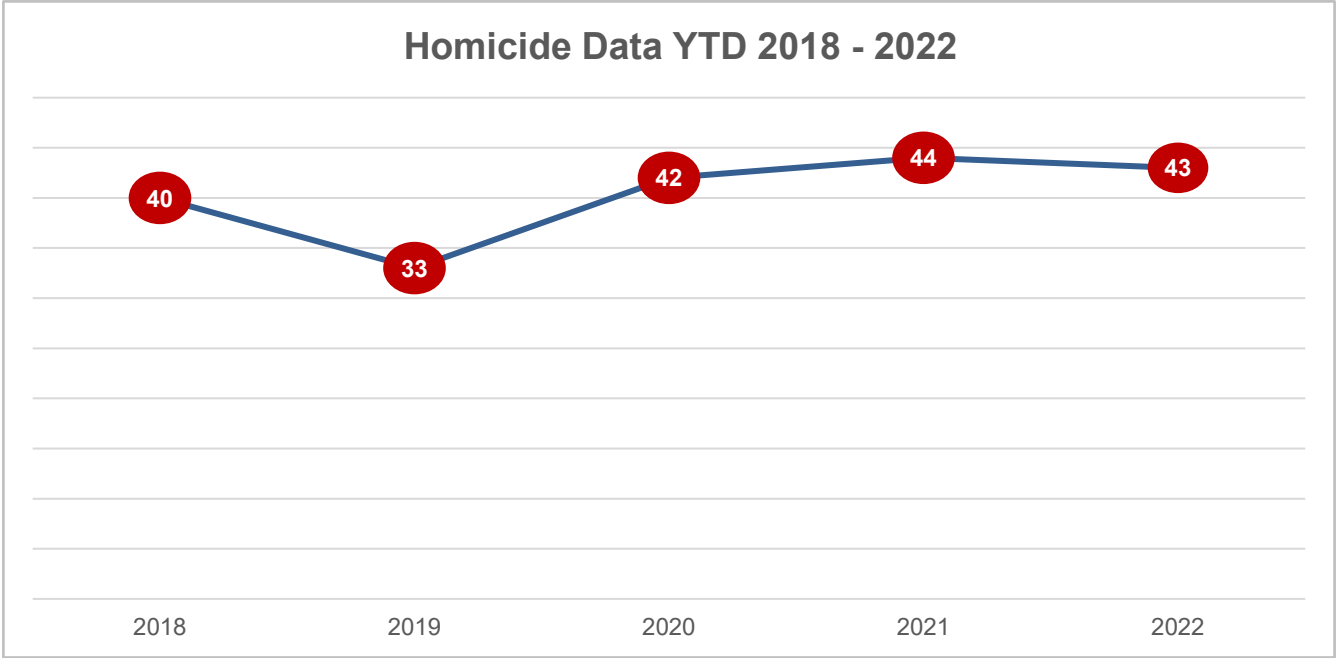
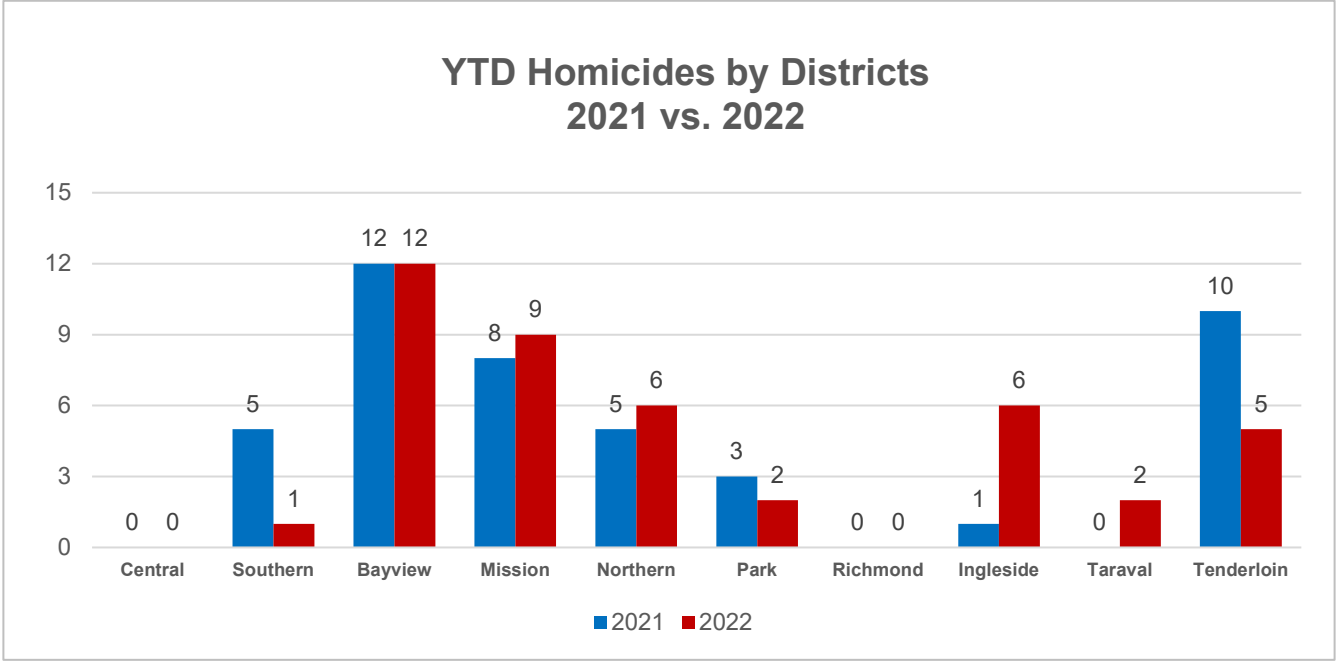

GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 1% compared to 2021

- There were 4 shooting incidents causing injuries to 4 individuals for the week ending 10/30/22
 - There are a total of 162 incidents resulting in 185 victims
- There were no homicide incidents reported the week ending on 10/30/22
 - There are 43 homicides YTD with 30 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 61%
