Pursuant to the request of the Police Commission, the Department provides this monthly update on the status of Public Record Act Requests received relating to Senate Bill 1421, Peace Officers: release of records. This report is a cumulative record of all requests and the production of documents since SB 1421 became effective on January 1, 2019, and is calculated for a month-over-month comparison.

**Release defined as a production of records and/or a determination letter. Determination letters generally are a response indicating the department has identified records or has no responsive records for one or more categories of disclosure for a specific officer.

A single PRA may contain requests for multiple categories or multiple officers; therefore, this number is higher than the total number of PRAs. *Case refers to the number of distinct incidents reviewed within the Department's tracking systems for use of force tracking and administrative investigation tracking.
