Re: Proposed Pretext Stops Legislation (Department General Order 9.01)

Regarding your December 15, 2022 agenda item pertaining to Department General Order 9.01, I am writing to let you know that the Mayor's Office on Disability has not had opportunity to be consulted on this item.

While we support the principles of non-biased stops and the potentially improper use of pretext in police matters, our office has questions and concerns related to the potential impact that the Order may have on safety of pedestrians with disabilities and older adults when there is a violation of the California Vehicle Code or the SF Transportation Code, especially for infractions on sidewalks, crosswalks, or areas within the Public Right of Way.
