Purpose of Contract:

In May of 2022, Health Services Advisory Group (HSAG) was selected and engaged by the Department to be the lead external agency to assist the Department in its quest to achieve full recertification of Laguna Honda Hospital. Further, in the fall of 2022 HSAG was also designated under the settlement agreement between the US Department of Health and Human Services and the City as the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved Quality Improvement Expert (QIE) for Laguna Honda Hospital and will perform those services under contract (By Board of Supervisors Ordinance - file number 221102).

Building on the work which has already been completed, HSAG will provide a dedicated performance improvement team which will provide: Provide technical assistance (TA) and targeted support to LHH in order to obtain CMS recertification; Participate as a subject matter specialist in pertinent committees; Provide Nursing Home Administrator, Director of Nursing, Closure Plan, Infection Prevention, QAPI, and Behavioral Health consultants; Develop resources and curriculum and conduct instructional sessions for as needed topics as identified by LHH leadership; Participation in the selection and interviewing process for candidates being considered for key leadership positions; Develop a transition plan with LHH staff that describes the hand-off tasks from HSAG to LHH staff and assures sustainability post re-certification.

Finally for the upcoming 2023 engagement HSAG has committed to engage certified Local Business Entitles (LBE)at a participation rate of at least 5%, which under the current budget is a dollar value of \$380,000. Health Services

Advisory Group is actively recruiting LBE firms in the categories of: Transportation Services – GS005, Travel Agencies GS085, Computer Hardware -EQ108 and will expand the categories if they need to find additional firms to meet the stated goal.
