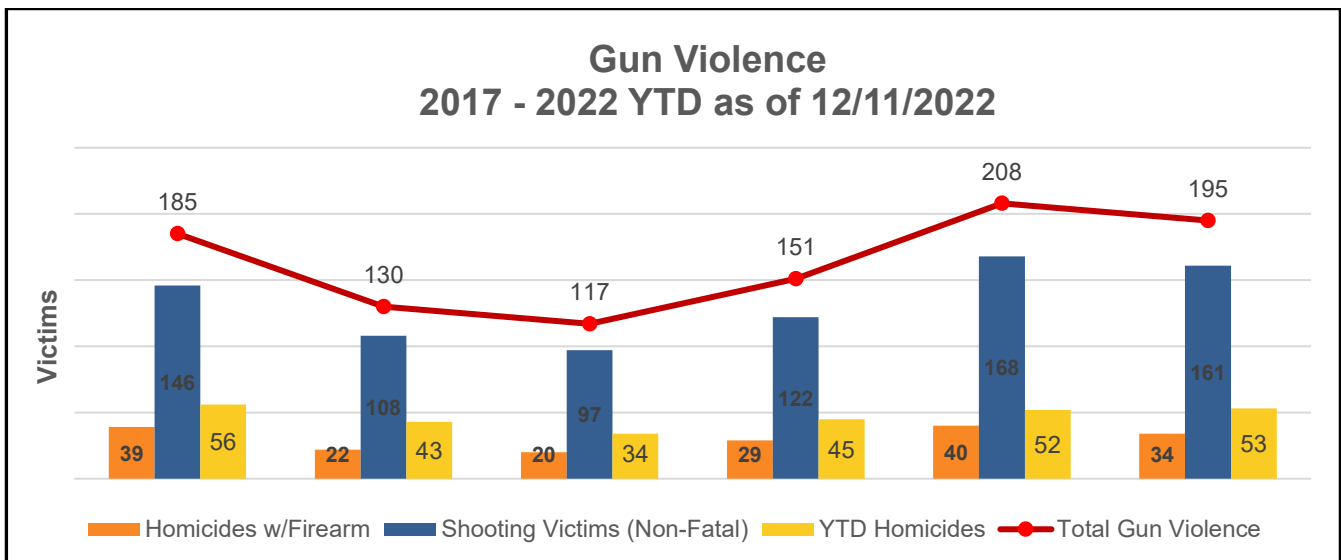

*Total Gun Violence = Non-fatal Shooting Victims + Fatal Shooting Victims

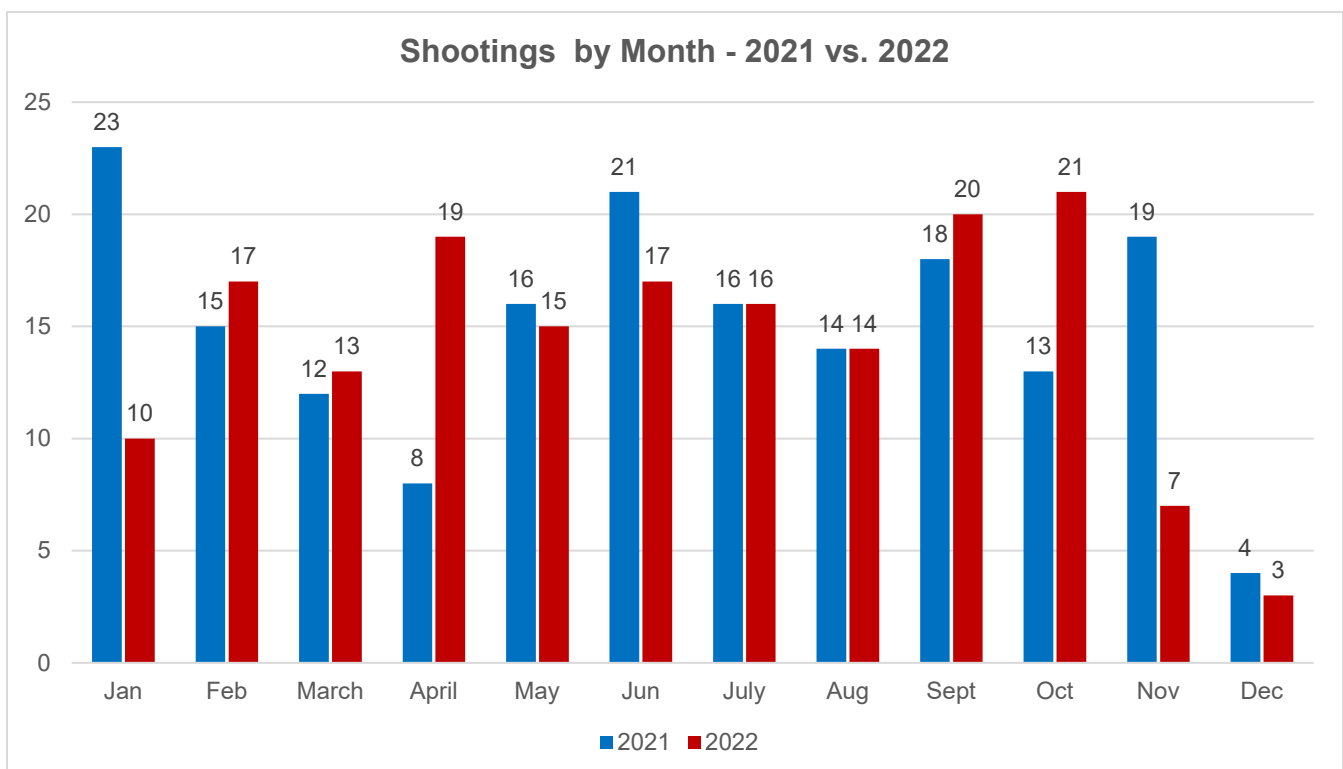
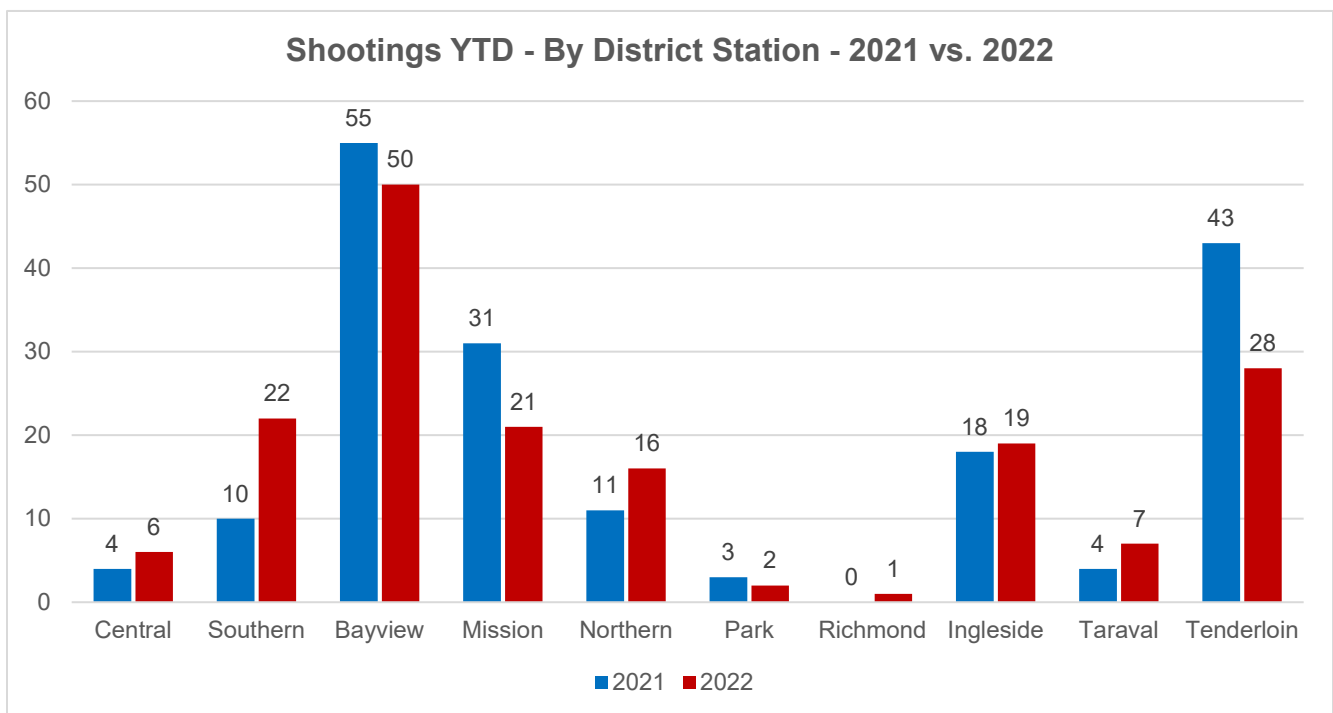
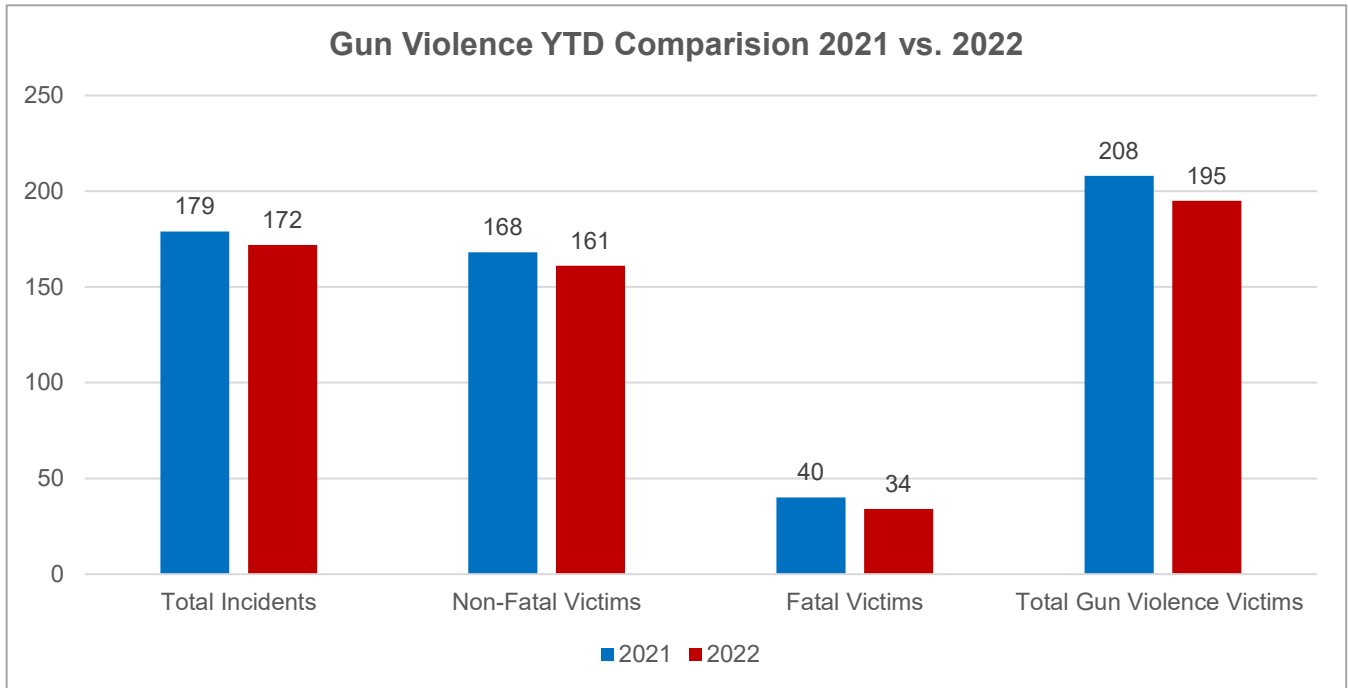

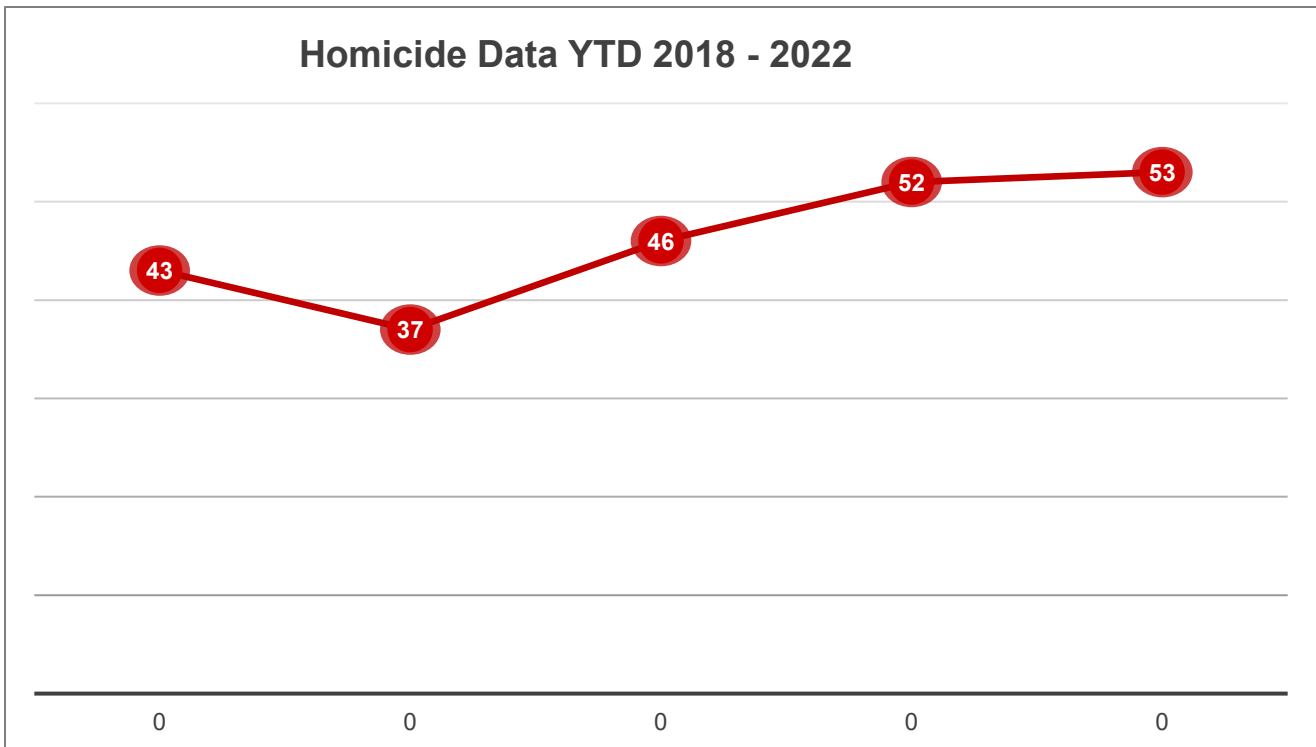
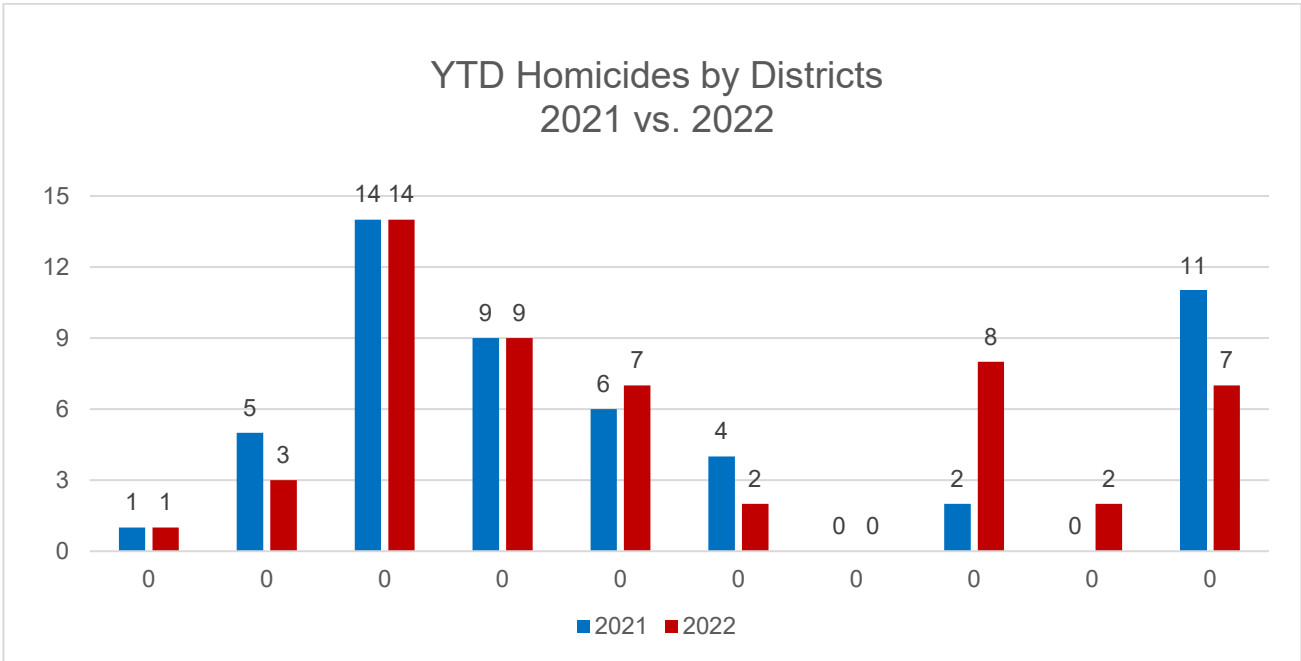
GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 6% compared to 2021

- **There were two shooting incidents causing injuries to two individuals for the week ending 12/11/22**
 - There are a total of 172 incidents resulting in 195 victims
- **There were 2 homicide incidents reported the week ending on 12/11/22**
 - There are 53 homicides YTD with 34 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 6%**
