- 8% **The officer failed to properly investigate.**
- 8% **The officer failed to make an arrest.**
- 6% **The officer prepared an incomplete or inaccurate incident report.**

Total Allegations: 52

Call for service types involved robbery, sexual assault, assault, and burglary.
