

  - o For the year, there are a total of 17 incidents resulting in 20 victims
- There were no homicides.
  - o However, there was one homicide occuring outside the reporing period on 12.13.23
  - $_{\circ}$   $\,$  There are 5 homicides YTD with 5 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 100%





