On Tuesday March 14th at approximately 2:45 PM Yerba Buena Island experienced a power outage. SFPUC dispatched crews, issued an I-Info Alert and notified TIDA and DEM, who issued an AlertSF notification. Service was restored to the outage area at approximately 4:50 PM. Cause was identified as windblown tree limbs during a storm event contacting overhead high voltage lines.

On Tuesday March 21st at approximately 2:15 PM Treasure Island and portions of Yerba Buena Island experienced a power outage. SFPUC dispatched crews, issued an I-Info Alert and notified TIDA and DEM, who issued an AlertSF notification. Service was restored to all of Treasure Island and Yerba Buena Island by 9:00 PM with the exception of Mersea Restaurant on Treasure Island which was restored on the morning of Wednesday March 22nd, and with the exception of AT&T telecommunications facility on Yerba Buena Island. Final restoration of service to the YBI facility is expected by no later than the week of April 10th, and is contingent on completion of currently active on-Island tree removal operations. Cause was identified as windblown tree limbs during storm event contacting overhead high voltage lines.

The San Francisco Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD) exhausted its original list of interested applicants and is seeking additional applicants for the five remaining BMR condominiums at The Bristol on a first come first served basis. MOHCD informed the TIDA team that Treasure Island Resident (TIR) Certificates will not provide Legacy and Vested Residents with a priority in this second offering of BMR units at The Bristol. However, purchasing a BMR condominium at The Bristol continues to be an option for those who apply.



TI Advisors sent emails to 821 Legacy and Vested Residents to inform residents of this opportunity and encourage them to apply to purchase one of the remaining BMR condominiums at The Bristol. TI Advisors provided guidance on the First Time Homebuyer education process and steps to proceed with an application.

TI Advisors and the TIDA team are planning community meetings, electronic and paper notifications and FAQs, tours, and individual meetings. Star View Court outreach efforts will include information to Vested Residents who may choose to rent an Affordable Unit at Star View Court using their Treasure Island Resident Preference Number

TI Advisors continue to provide Legacy and Vested Treasure Island Residents with information, education, and payments provided for under TIDA's Transition Housing Rules and Regulations (THRR). The team is working with TIDA to enhance the portion of TIDA's website that focuses on future housing options for Legacy Households and Vested Residents at The Villages.

Star View Court Housing Options

TI Advisors spoke with residents about the opportunity to move into Transition Housing or Affordable Housing at Star View Court in 2024. TI Advisors helped residents understand income qualifications for Affordable Housing and options for Legacy Resident Transition Units. The TIDA team is scheduling community outreach and events to share this exciting housing opportunity with Island Residents in May!



In Lieu Cash Payments. TI Advisors continue to work with Legacy Residents who choose to move from Treasure Island. These Legacy Residents are eligible to receive In-Lieu Cash Payments rather than wait for future housing opportunities on Treasure Island.

Food Pantry

We continue to operate the weekly Food Pantry on Tuesdays with an average of 130 households accessing the pantry.

One Treasure Island Programming:

The 14th cohort of the Construction Training Program graduated on March 3rd, 2023. Recruitment for the 15th cohort of the CTP has begun. The training session will begin on May 1, 2023.

The One TI tax site continues to prepare tax returns for island residents and workers. Over 200 tax returns have been prepared to date.

Outreach & Social Media

Community engagement continues through social media posts, posts on Next Door Treasure Island, fliers on the community boards, in weekly pantry bags, mass emailing and through partnerships with the TI housing providers.

Community Engagement & Events

One TI hosted a successful 6-week Health and Wellness Series. An average of 10 individuals attended with a total of 20 folks attending the Self Defense workshop. Island BINGO was also a success with over 20 people attending. We are excited to begin to see an increase in resident participation in island wide events.

Planning for the Spring Fling and other small events is in the works! We are excited to for the grand opening of the Maceo May housing development is on May 18^{th} at 10:30 AM. One TI gifted all new residents with a microwave and is excited to facilitate an orientation to the new residents of Maceo May soon.


