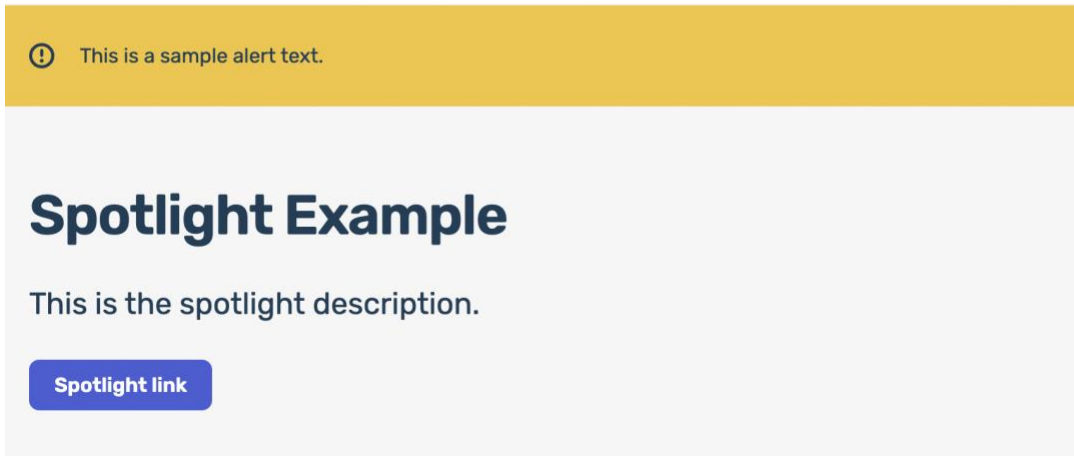


Figure 1. This shows what the optional "alert" banner and optional "Spotlight" link look like. The Spotlight link can also have a picture instead of the gray box.

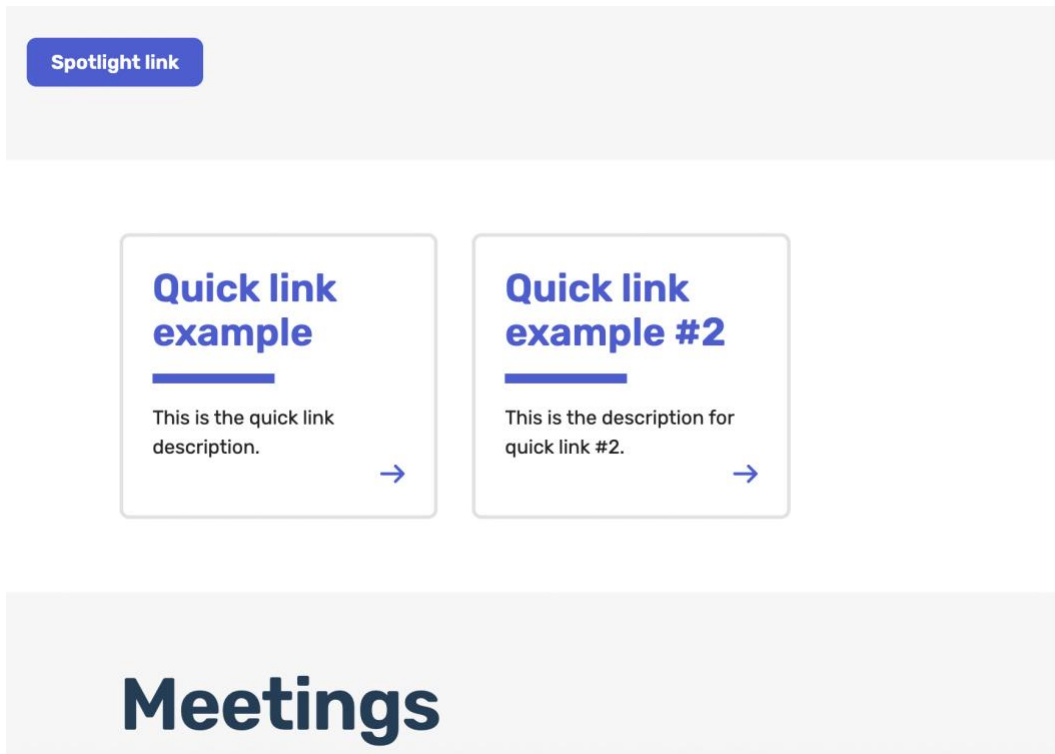


Figure 2. This shows what optional "Quick links" look like. I believe there can at most three quick links.

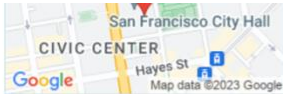

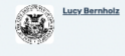
