## MEETING MINUTES - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12, 2023

# HYBRID MEETING (IN-PERSON AND REMOTE ACCESS VIA ZOOM)

### (1) PUBLIC COMMENT

At this time, members of the public may address the Board on items of interest to the public that are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board except agenda items. With respect to agenda items, your opportunity to address the Board will be afforded when the item is reached in the meeting with one exception. When the agenda item has already been reviewed in a public hearing at which members of the public were allowed to testify and the Board has closed the public hearing, your opportunity to address the Board must be exercised during the Public Comment portion of the calendar. Each member of the public may address the Board for up to three minutes. At the discretion of the Board President, public comment may be limited to two minutes. If it is demonstrated that comments by the public will exceed 15 minutes, the President may continue Public Comment to another time during the meeting.

## (2) **COMMISSIONER COMMENTS & QUESTIONS**

SPEAKERS: Commissioner Trasviña spoke about the letter submitted by Mr. Emblidge during public comment at the last hearing, regarding cases that were previously heard by the Board. He stated that the Board had received a response letter from the department, and he wanted to know the next steps. He further stated that the public would want to know where the matter stands. Commissioner Trasviña also asked President Swig about the current status of any taxi appeals from the SFMTA.

President Swig stated that he and Ms. Rosenberg attended a meeting with the SFMTA to discuss the letter sent to them by Vice President Lopez regarding taxi issues. He further stated that the letter was constructively received and that the SFMTA would be following up with a formal response. In response to Commissioner Trasviña's inquiry about the status of taxi appeals, President Swig stated that, currently, any appeals would go to the Board of Appeals.

#### (3) ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Discussion and possible adoption of the March 15, 2023 minutes.

ACTION: Upon motion by Commissioner Eppler, the Board voted 4-0-1 (Vice President Lopez absent) to adopt the March 15, 2023 hearing minutes, as amended by Commissioners Lemberg and Trasviña.

Commissioner Lemberg made two corrections to Item 1, General Public Comment: He added a "d" to Scott Emblidge's last name in the first sentence and added an "r" to "23d" in the second sentence.

Commissioner Trasviña made two amendments to Item 5 (Appeal No. 23-007 @ 1468 Van Dyke): (1) he clarified the second condition in the Board's motion by amending the language to state: "the deck shall be lowered to grade or made no higher than 30 inches, as measured from the grade," and (2) he removed the title "Professor" from the appellant's name under the "Speakers" section.
