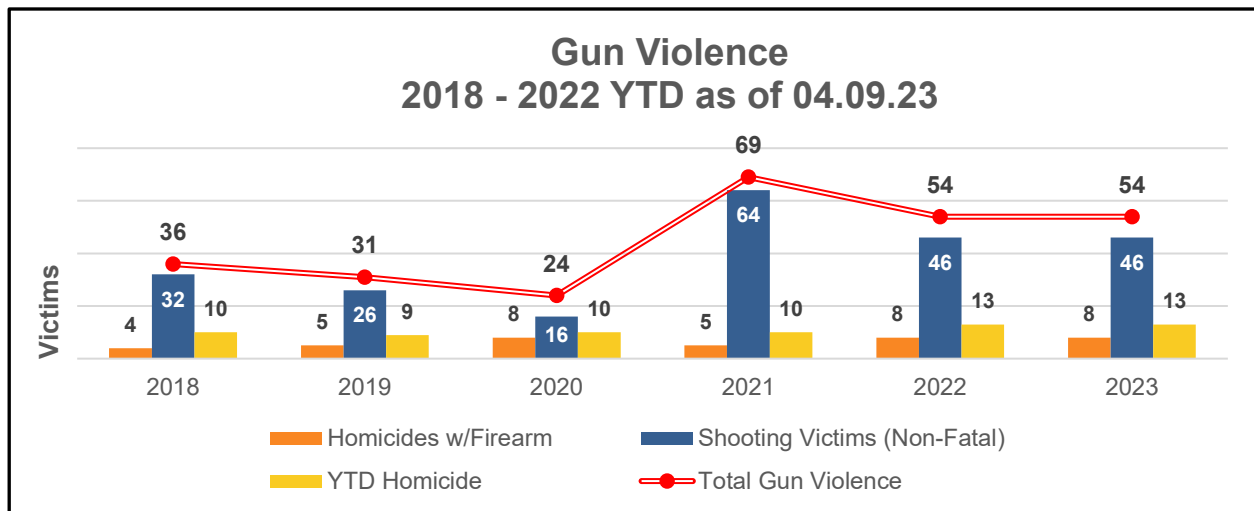

**GUN VIOLENCE – Is Even compared to 2022**

- **There were 3 shooting incidents causing injuries to 3 individuals this week.**
  - For the year, there are a total of 51 incidents resulting in 54 victims
- **There was 1 homicide incident**
  - There are 13 homicides YTD with 8 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - **Overall Clearance Rate: 85%**

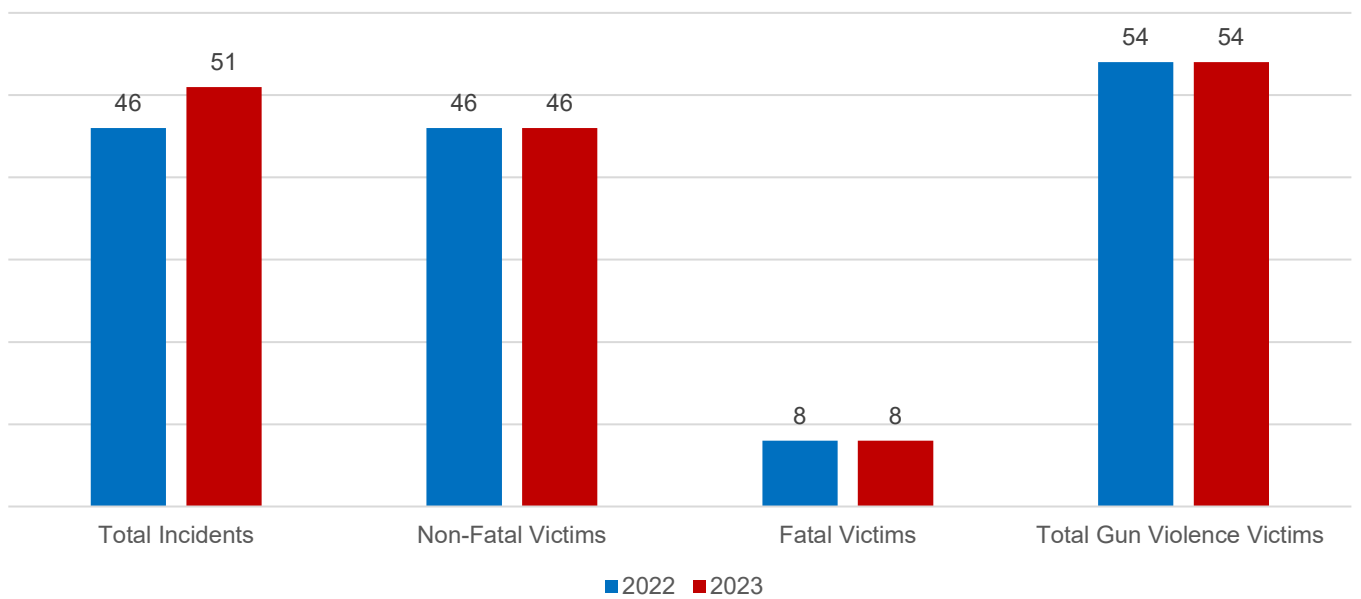

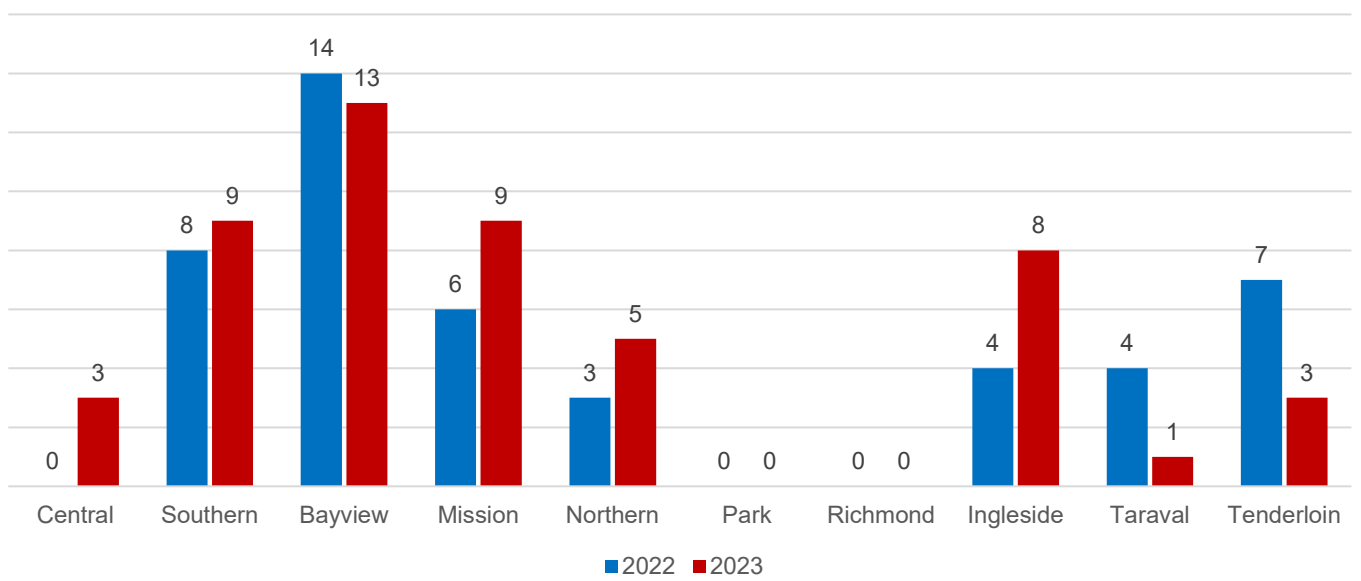

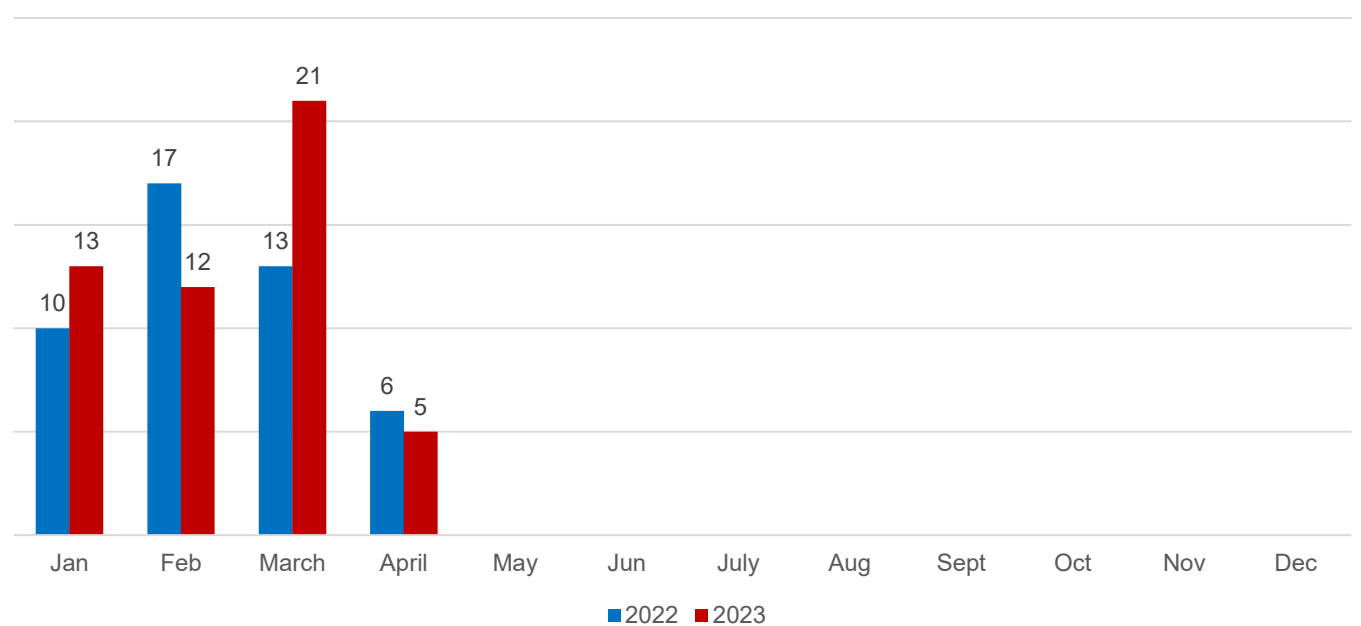
### Gun Violence YTD Comparision 2022 vs. 2023



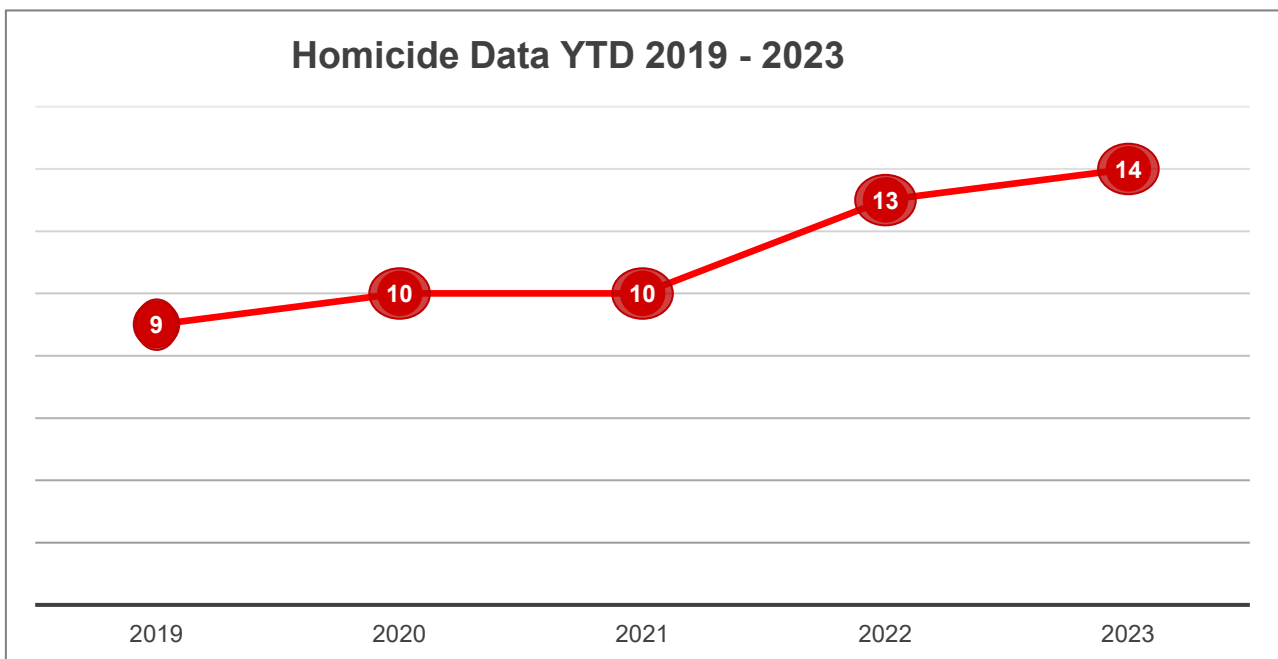
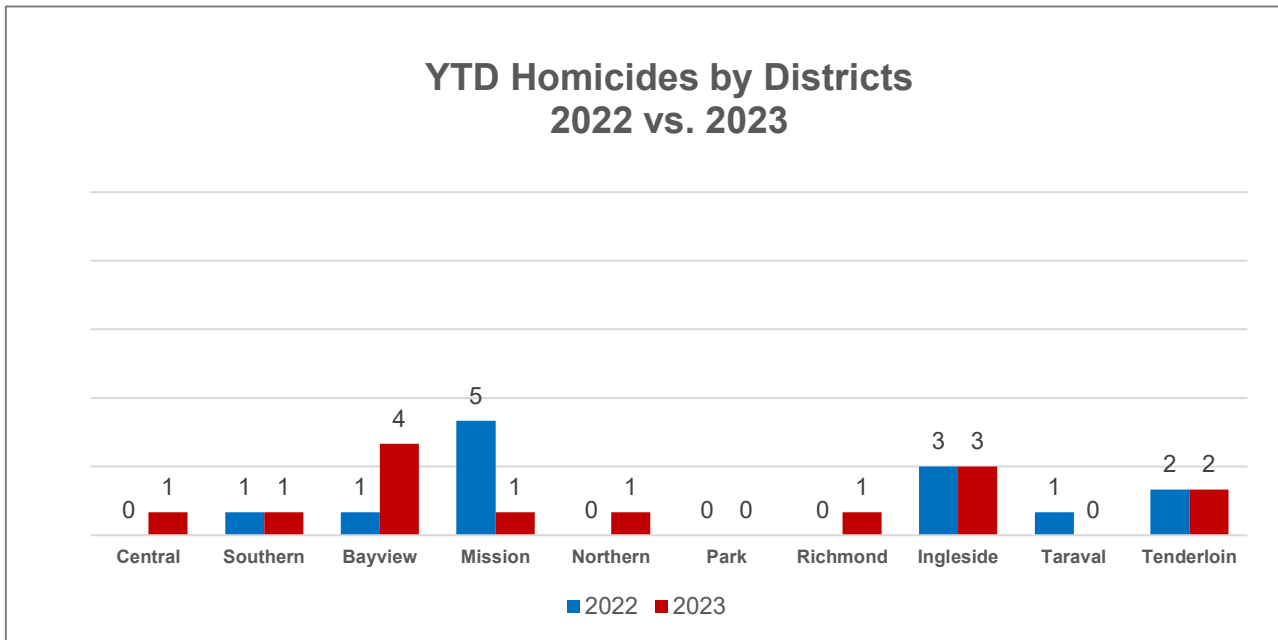
### Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
