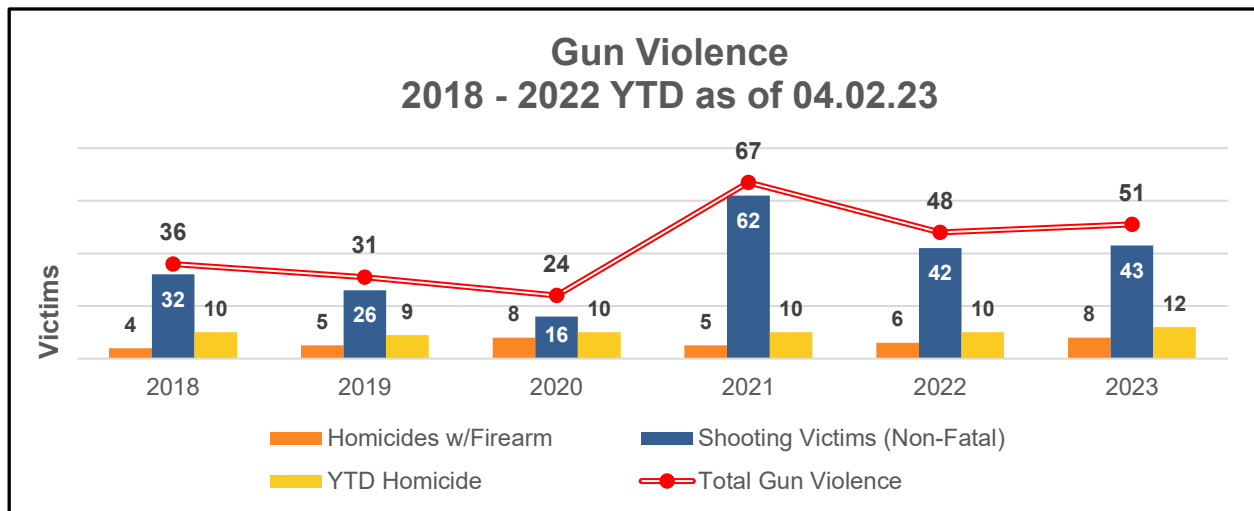

GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 6% compared to 2022

- **There were 3 shooting incidents causing injuries to 3 individuals this week.**
 - For the year, there are a total of 48 incidents resulting in 51 victims
- **There were no homicides.**
 - There are 12 homicides YTD with 8 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 90%**



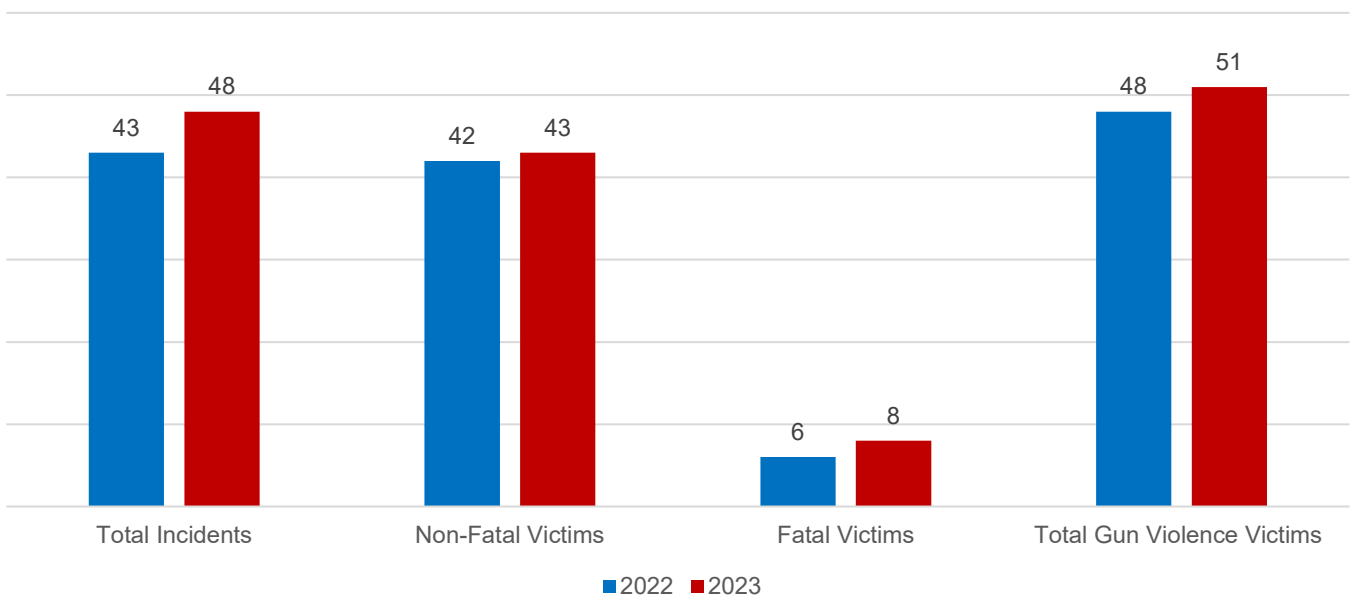

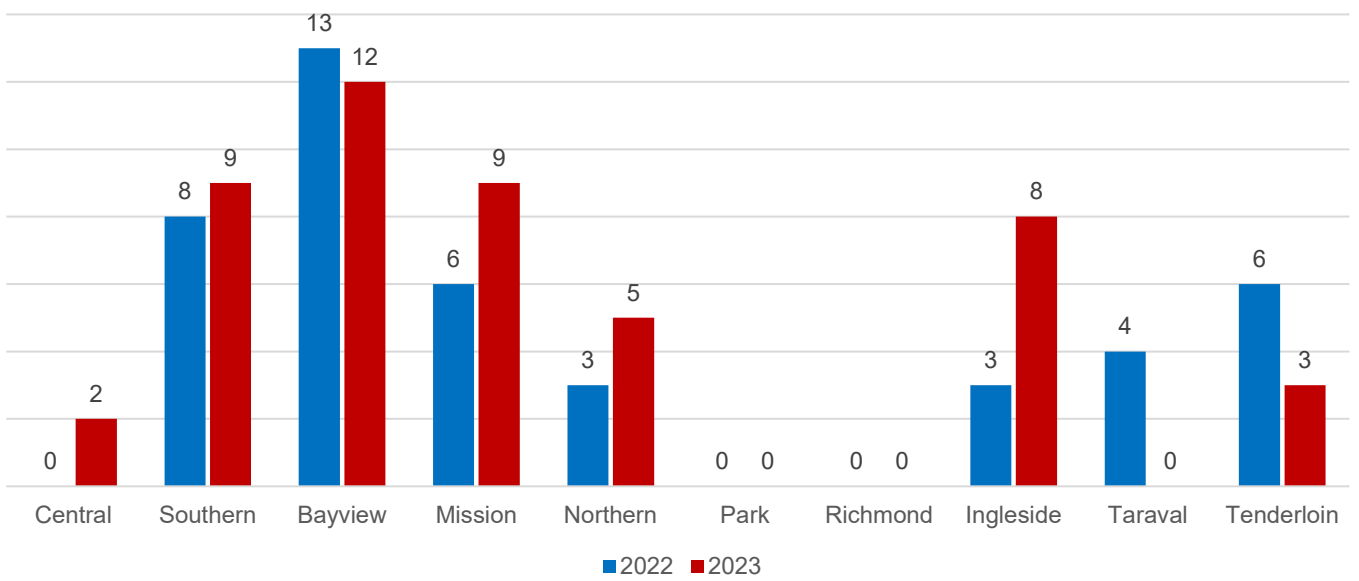

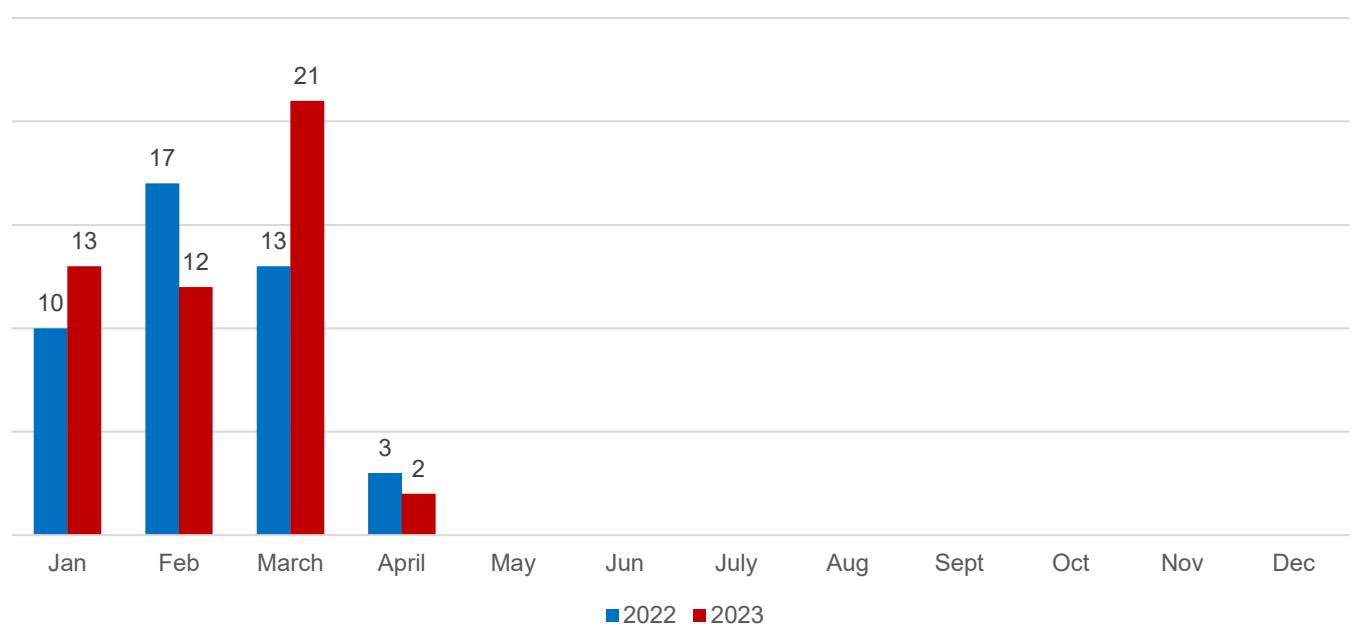
Gun Violence YTD Comparision 2022 vs. 2023



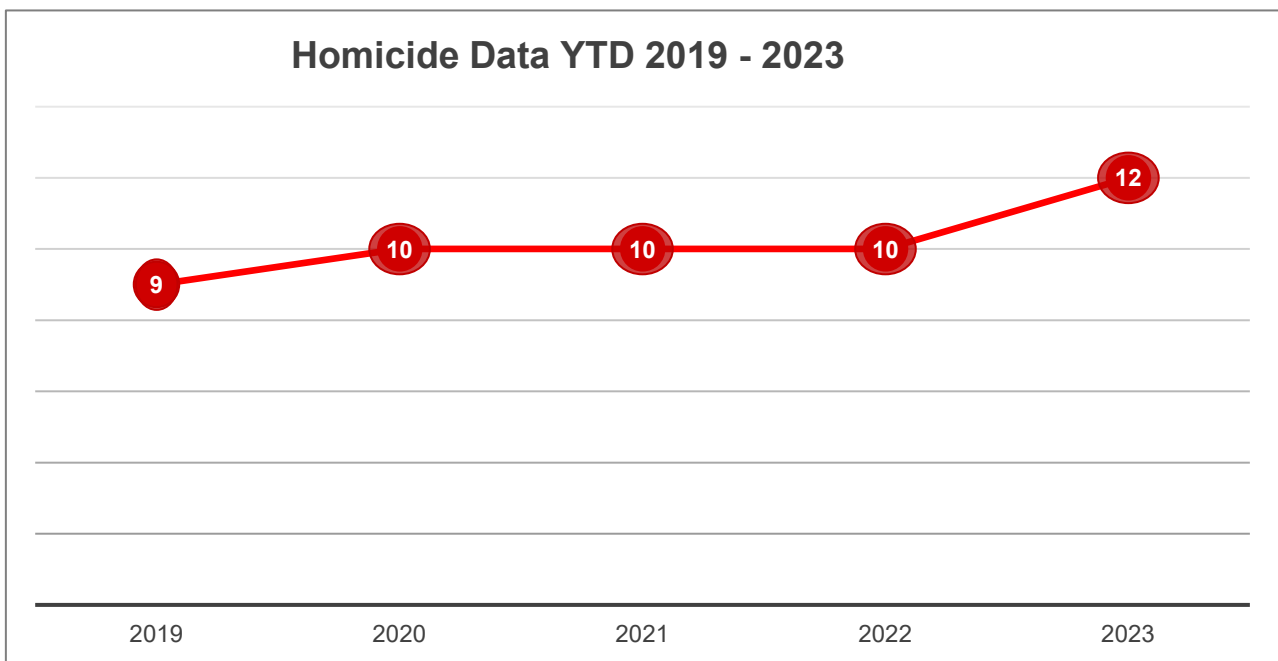
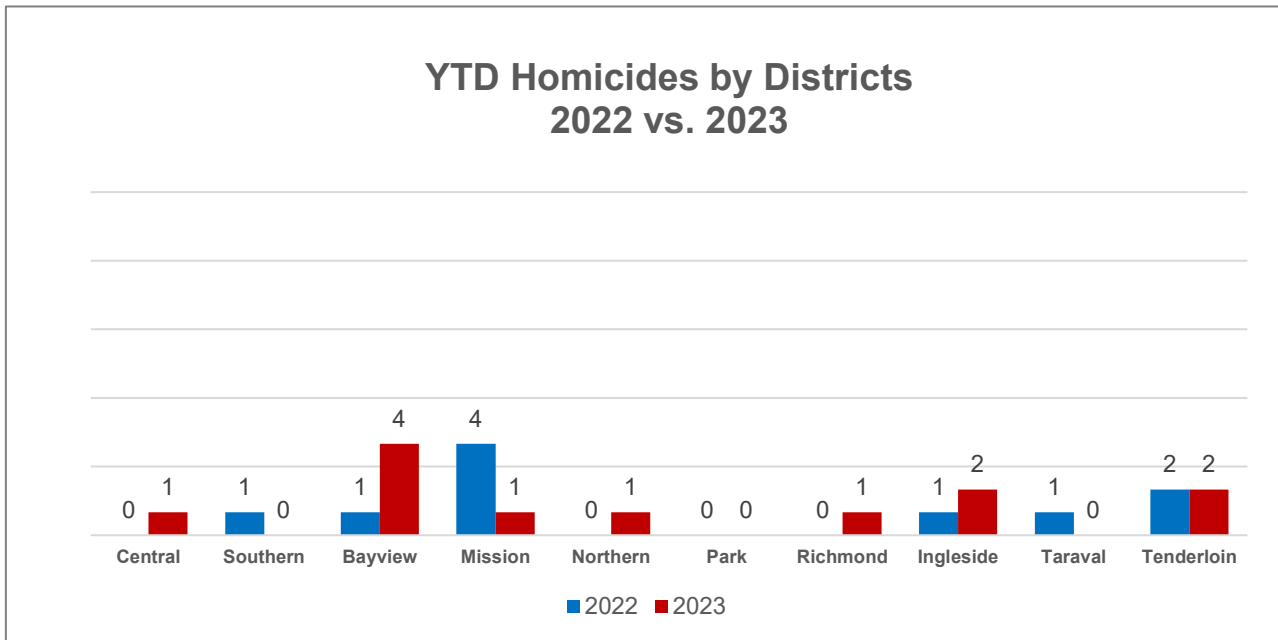
Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
