At the meeting of the Police Commission on Wednesday, October 19, 2022, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION 22-142

APPROVAL TO DENY THE DRAFT MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE SAN FRANCISCO POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE SAN FRANCISCO DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, REGARDING THE INVESTIGATION OF SERIOUS USES OF FORCE AND IN-CUSTODY DEATHS, FOR MEETING AND CONFERRING WITH THE SAN FRANCISCO POLICE OFFICER'S ASSOCIATION, AS REQUIRED BY LAW

RESOLVED, that the Police Commission does not approve the draft Memorandum of Understanding as written as this time and directs the Chief of Police to go back to the District Attorney and the Mediator to consider the changes suggested by the Commission including forthcoming changes suggested by the Department of Police Accountability and present them to the District Attorney and the Mediator and once that is done, return to the Commission for discussion and action; and
