eVideon Inc. will provide continued access to the Vibe Health patient experience platform currently in use at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital. Fully integrated with the Epic electronic health record system, Vibe Health is an on premises application that provides patient education, movies, entertainment, relaxation and sleep content, as well as a portal for viewing television content sourced from a separate provider. Vibe Health also provides ZSFG customized banner digital signage across the ZSFG campus in common areas such as waiting rooms and lobbies. Vibe Health was originally procured through a competitive solicitation via a subcontract with a third party provider. This contract was competitively solicited and brings DPH into a direct contractual relationship with the provider for the first time.

eVideon was founded in Michigan in 1993 as "Optimal Solutions Inc." and converted to a Delaware C corporation in 2019 as eVideon Inc. The privately held company has served hospitals since 2007 with in-room interactive technology solutions integrated with the electronic health record. eVideon serves over 100 hospitals across the US.

eVideon Inc. was selected under RFP SFGOV0000006742. The RFP allows for a contract of up to 9 years which includes contract options which may or may not be exercised.

Performance Monitoring:

The contract will be monitored in accordance with Hospital and network monitoring procedures by the Program Manager assigned to these services.
