

Local Context

Historically EDD provided OEWD with Unemployment Insurance (UI)
quarterly wage data for clients served only by WIOA-funded
programs.

 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds account for less than 10% of OEWD's workforce portfolio.





Prior to AB 593

Lack of access to Unemployment Insurance (UI) wage data limited OEWD's and other workforce areas' ability to verify job retention and to evaluate long-term impact.


- Quarterly wage data is considered confidential information.
- The data is useful to assess program outcomes and confirm employment of workforce clients.

What is AB 593?



- In 2019, OEWD partnered with the California Workforce Association to advance legislation to modify the allowable uses of UI Code 1095.
- Assembly Bill 593 enabled the **EDD** to share Unemployment Insurance wage and employment data with local departments that administer public workforce funds.

Assembly Bill No. 593

CHAPTER 611

An act to amend Section 1095 of the Unemployment Insurance Code, relating to workforce development.

[Approved by Governor October 8, 2019. Filed with Secretary of State October 8, 2019.]


LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 593, Carrillo. Unemployment insurance: use of information: public

Under existing law, the information obtained in the administration of the workforce development programs. Unemployment Insurance Code is for the exclusive use and information of the Director of Employment Development in the discharge of the director's duties and is not open to the public. However, existing law permits the use of the information for specified purposes, including to enable the California Workforce Development Board and other entities to access any relevant quarterly wage data necessary for the evaluation and reporting of specified workforce program performance outcomes as required and permitted by various state and federal laws, as specified. Existing law makes it a crime for any person to knowingly access, use, or disclose this confidential information without authorization.

RELEASE OF INFORMATION

The Office of Economic and Workforce Development (DEWD) Obtains and reviews information about participants' program performance while they are in the program and after they leave the program in order to evaluate the effectiveness of the services we fund. We are requesting your permission to obtain employment and educational information from employers, service providers, and other institutions and share this information with third parties who are partnering with us on these programs to evaluate program effectiveness or to see if you might be eligible for additional resource.

I, ______, give the Office of Economic and Workforce
Development (OEWD) permission to:

- Obtain employment verification including employer name and contact information, dates of
 employment, job title, wage, quarterly earnings, full-time/part-time status including hours
 worked per week and benefits received.
- Obtain education or training program information including institution name and contact information, dates of enrollment, type of degrees or certificates obtained, grades, and other educational performance assessments.
- Obtain quarterly wage data from the Employment Development Department (EDD) as reported by my employers for the purposes of measuring and reporting on the effectiveness of Workforce Development Programs.
- Release program participation and educational and employment outcome data (excluding quarterly wage data from EDD) to workforce partners and state and local agencies for the purposes described above.
- · Share only anonymized quarterly wage data from the Employment Development Department.

This release will remain valid for three (3) years after completion of services. Lunderstand that I can discontinue this authorization at any time by sending a written notice to OEWD by mail at the address listed below or by email to <u>workforce.development@sfgw.org</u>.
