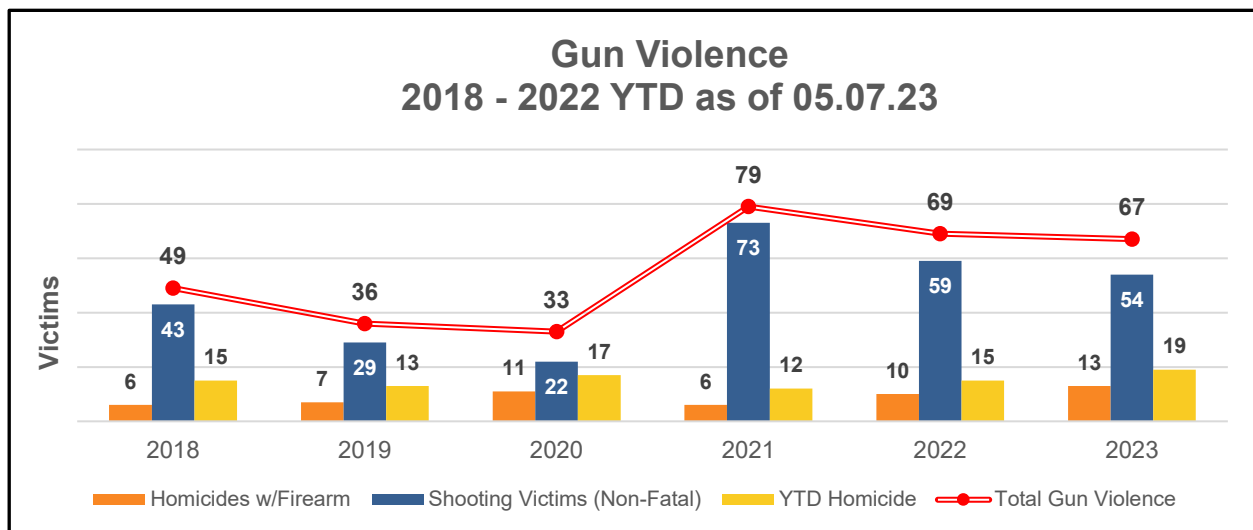

GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 3% compared to 2022

- **There was 1 shooting incident causing injuries to 1 individual this week.**
 - For the year, there are a total of 60 incidents resulting in 67 victims
- **There were 2 homicide incident for the week ending 05.10.23**
 - There are 19 homicides YTD with 13 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 194%**



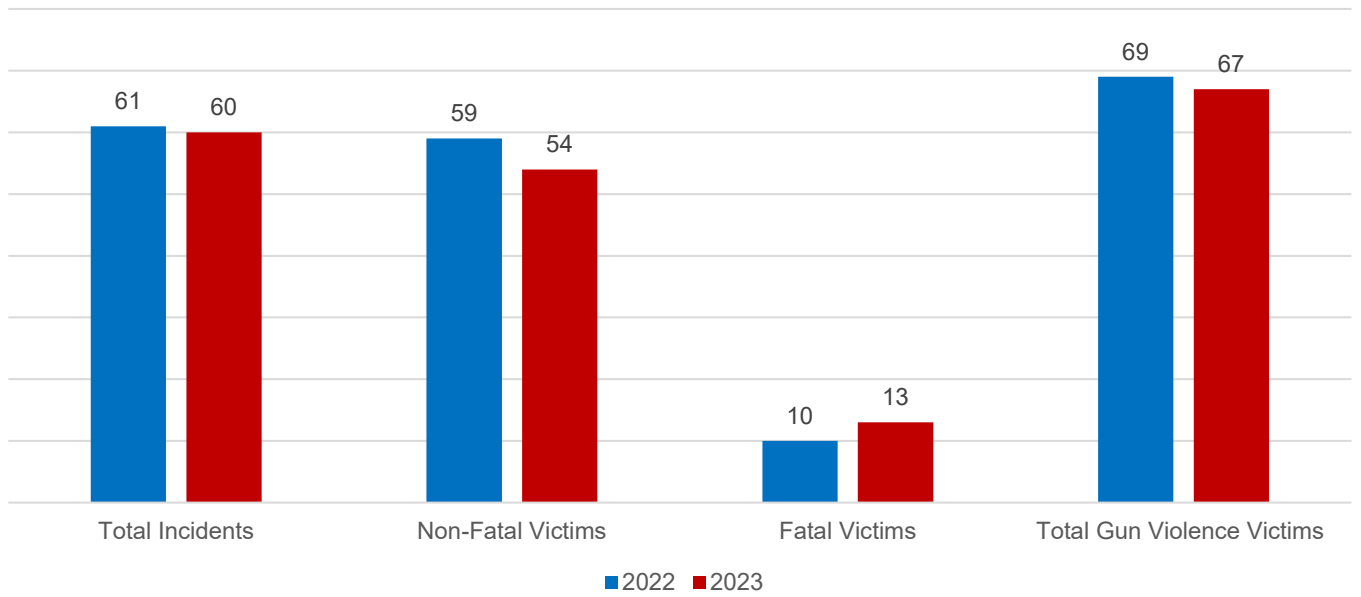

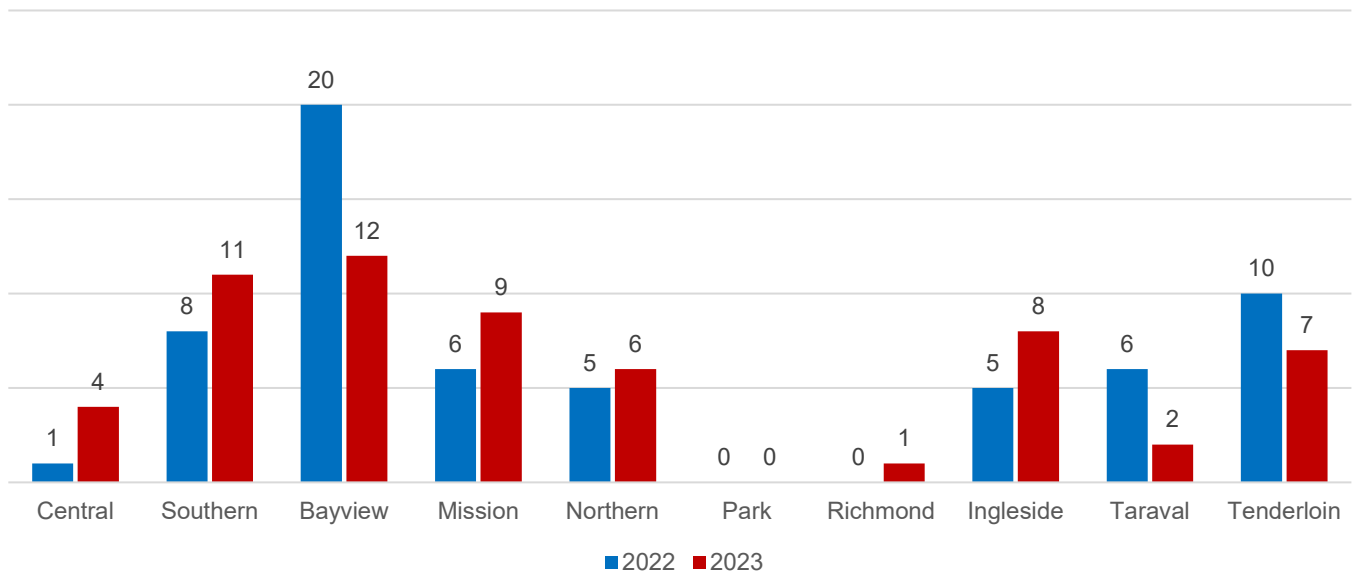

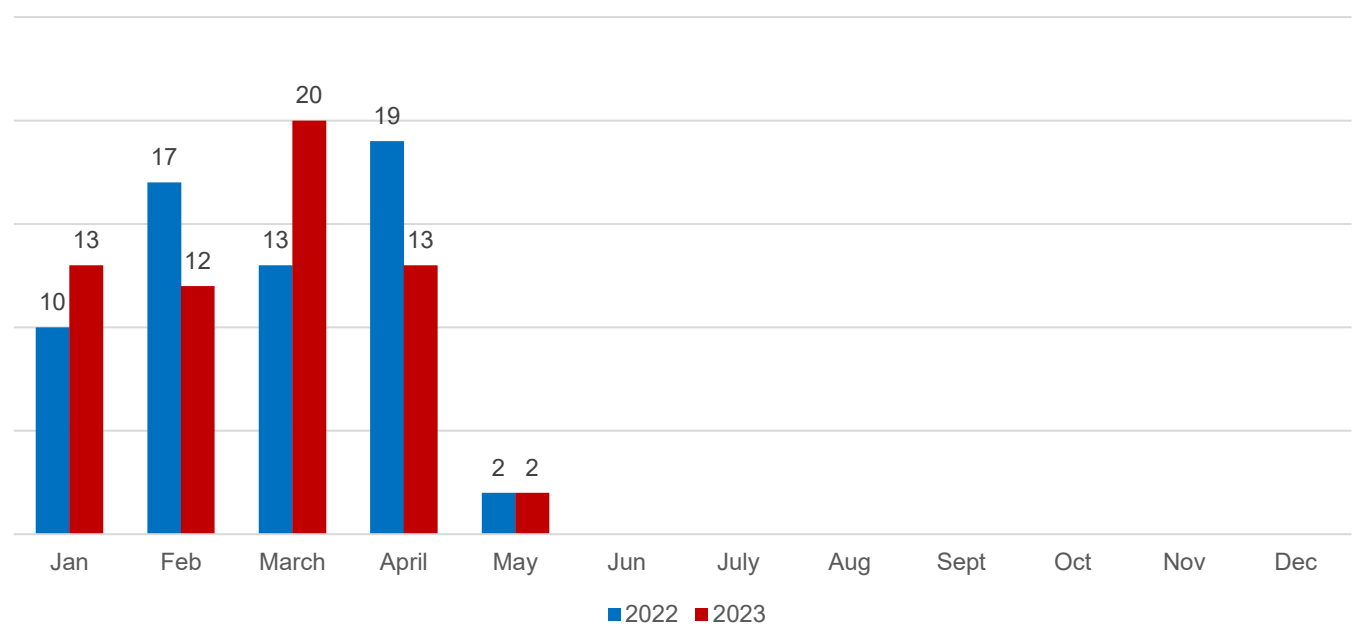
Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2022 vs. 2023



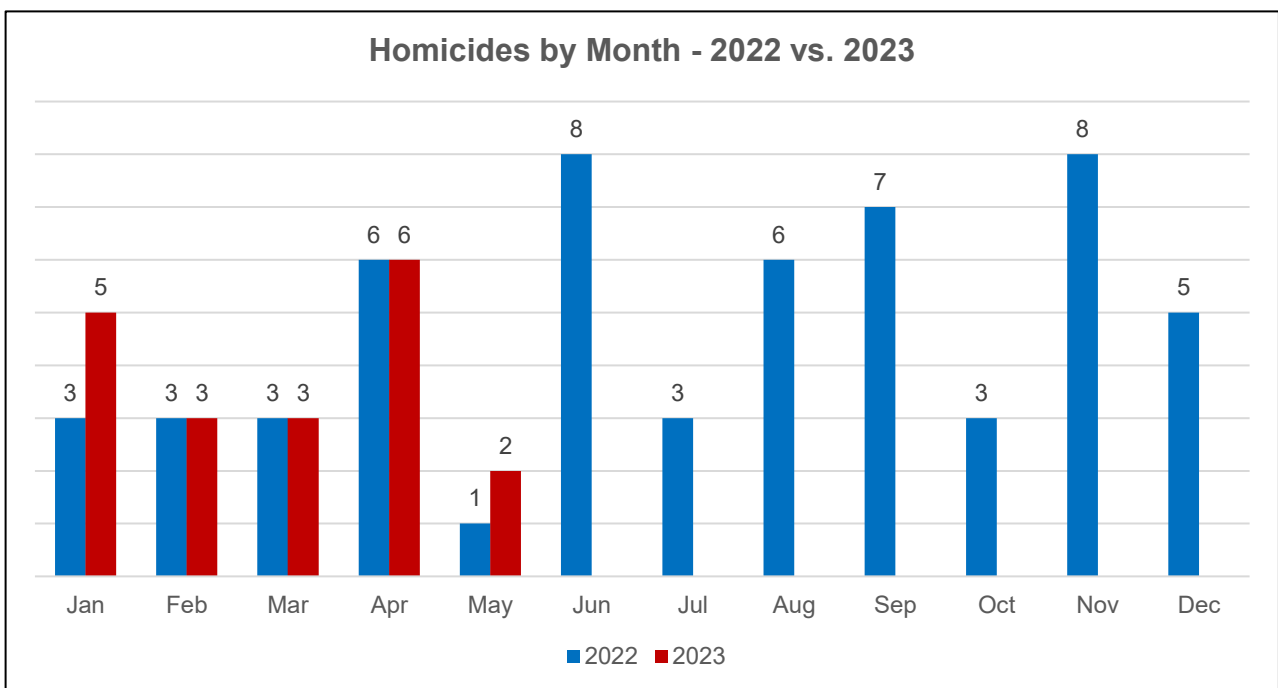
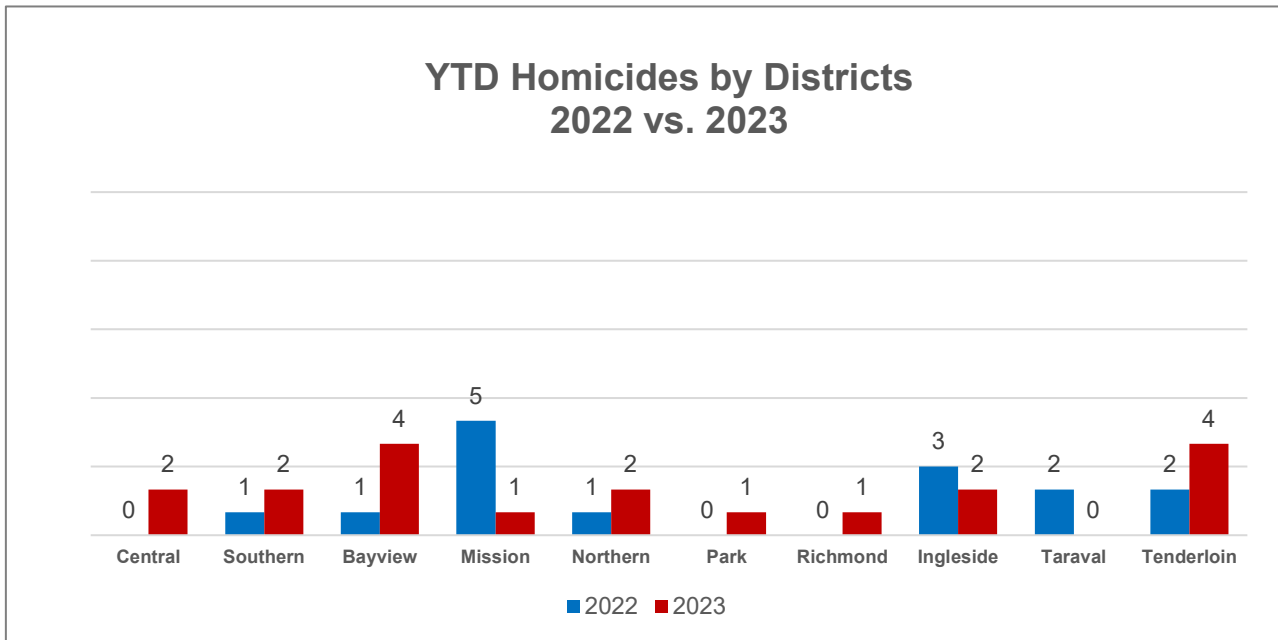
Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
