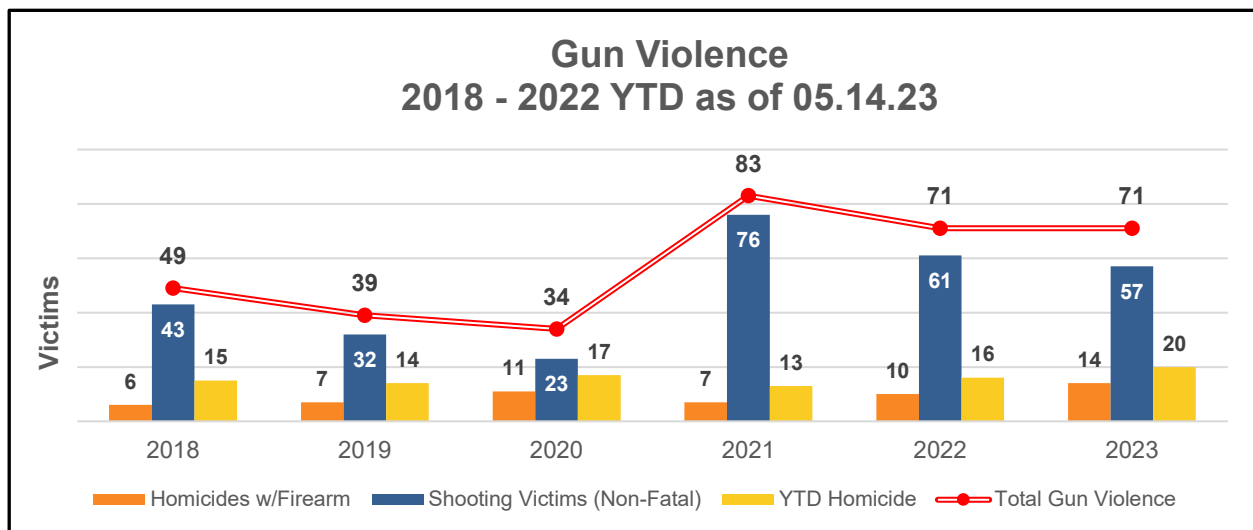

**GUN VIOLENCE – Is EVEN to 2022**

- **There were 3 shooting incidents causing injuries to 3 victims this week.**
  - For the year, there are a total of 64 incidents resulting in 71 victims
- **There was 1 homicide incident for the week ending 05.14.23**
  - There are 20 homicides YTD with 14 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - **Overall Clearance Rate: 90%**



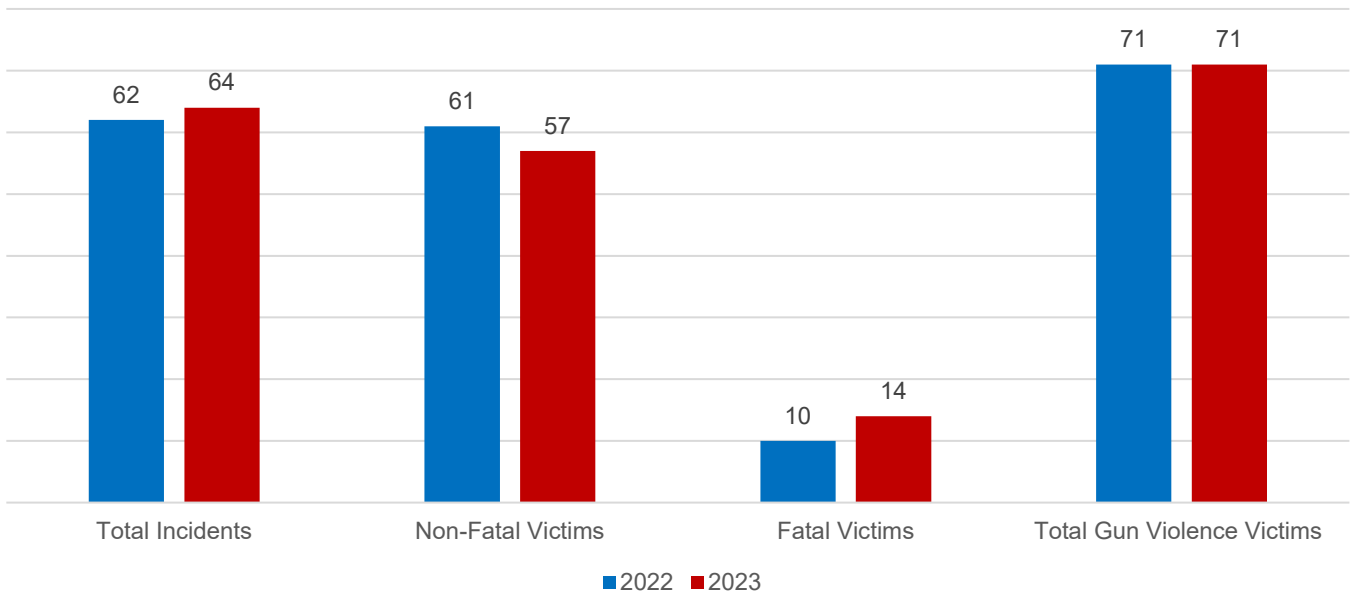

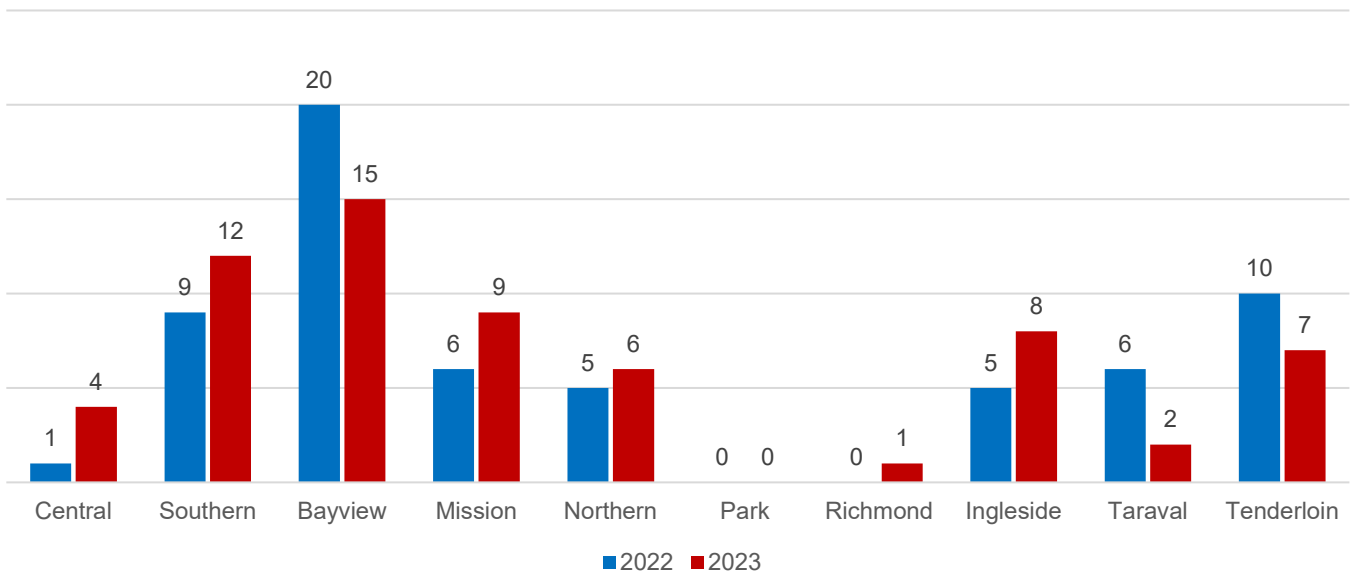

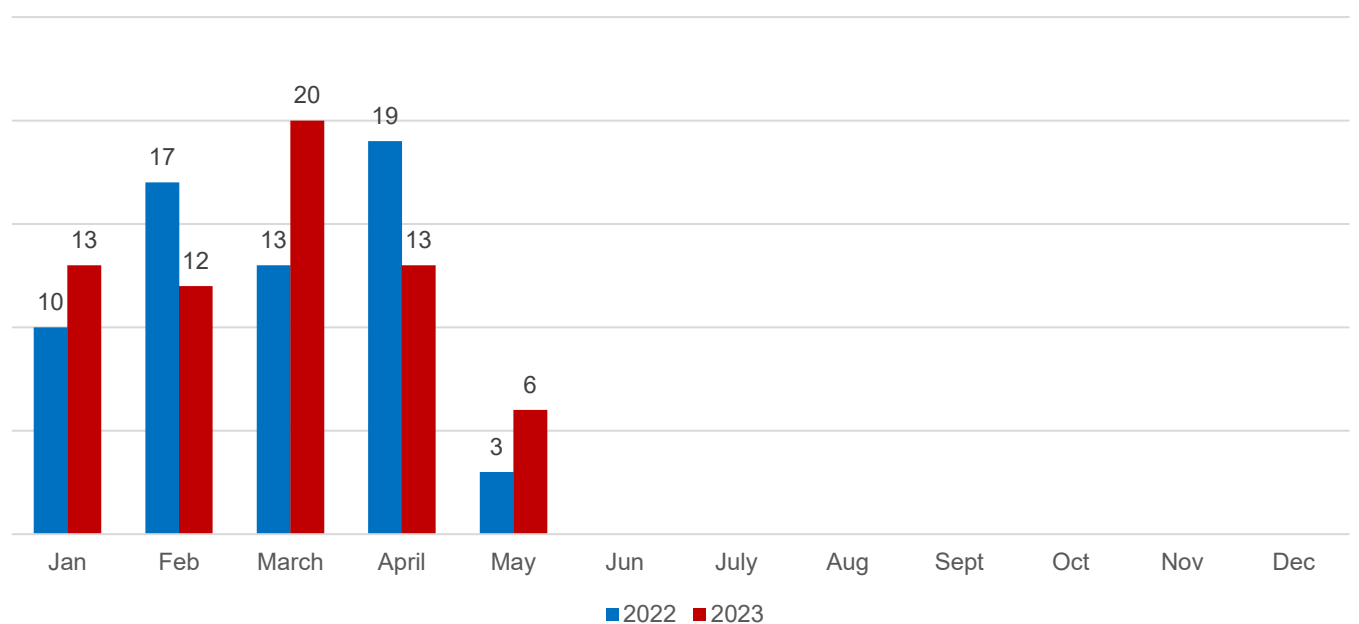
### Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2022 vs. 2023



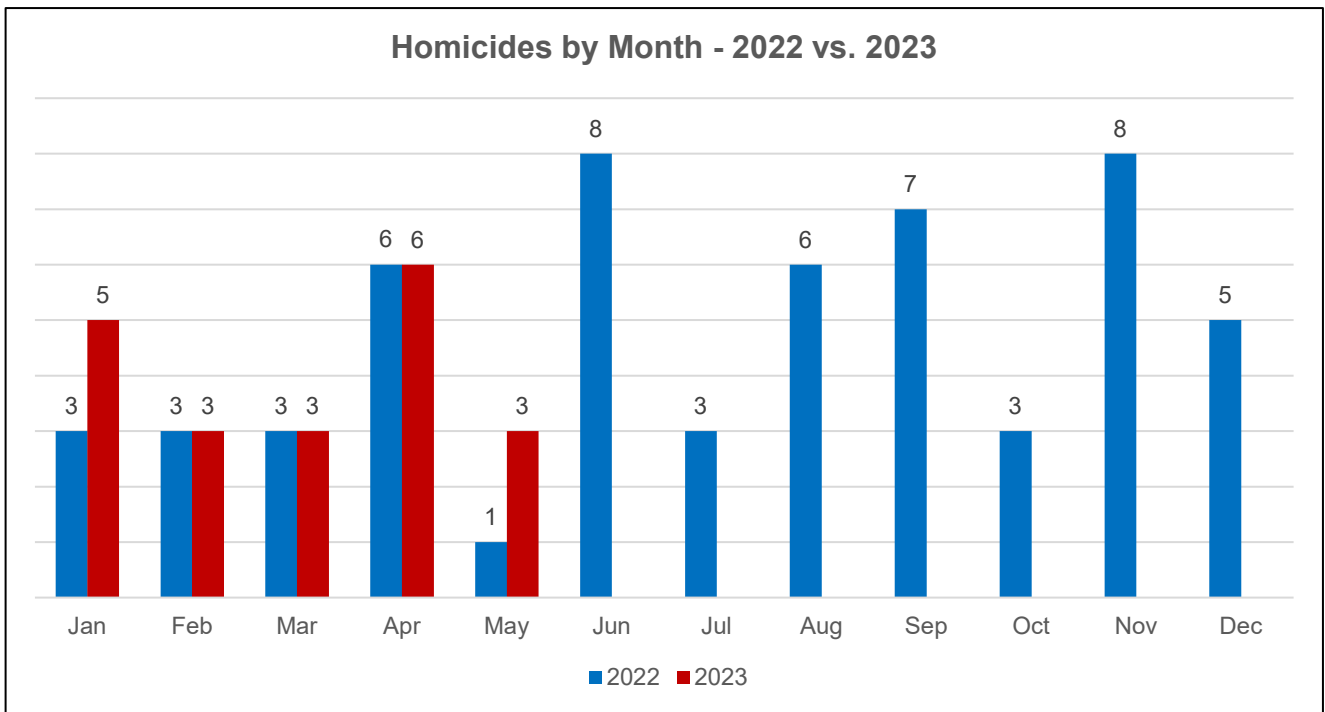
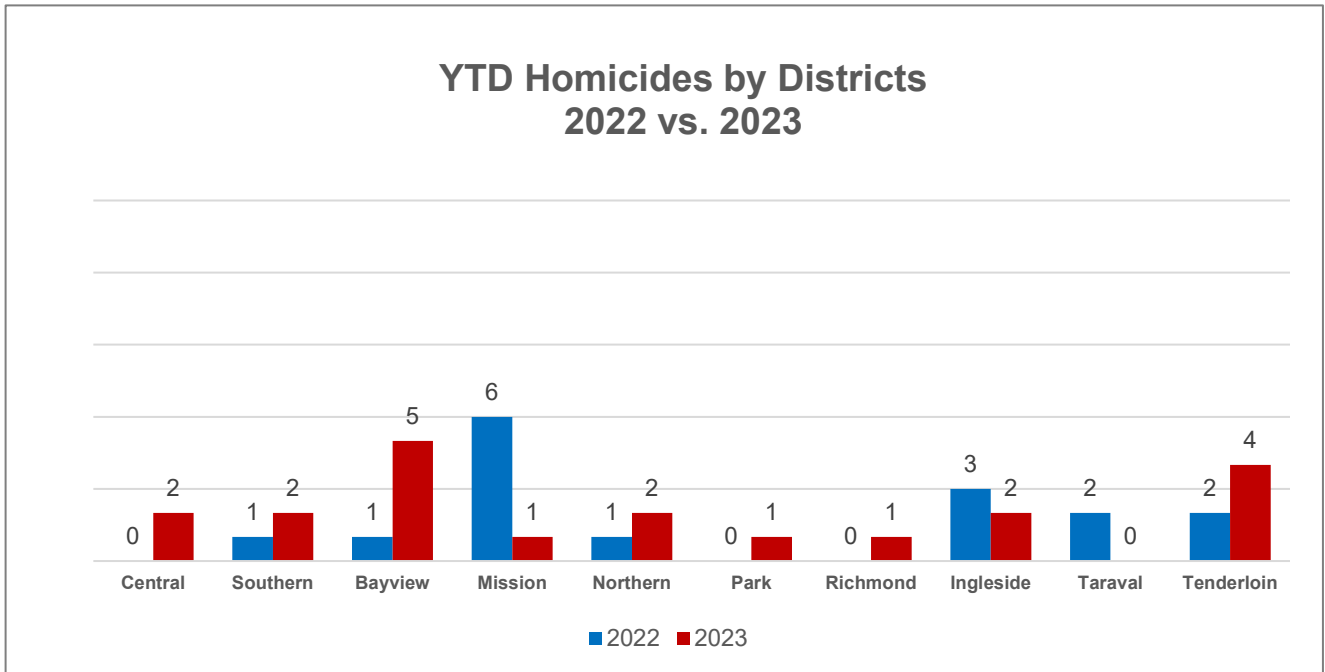
### Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
