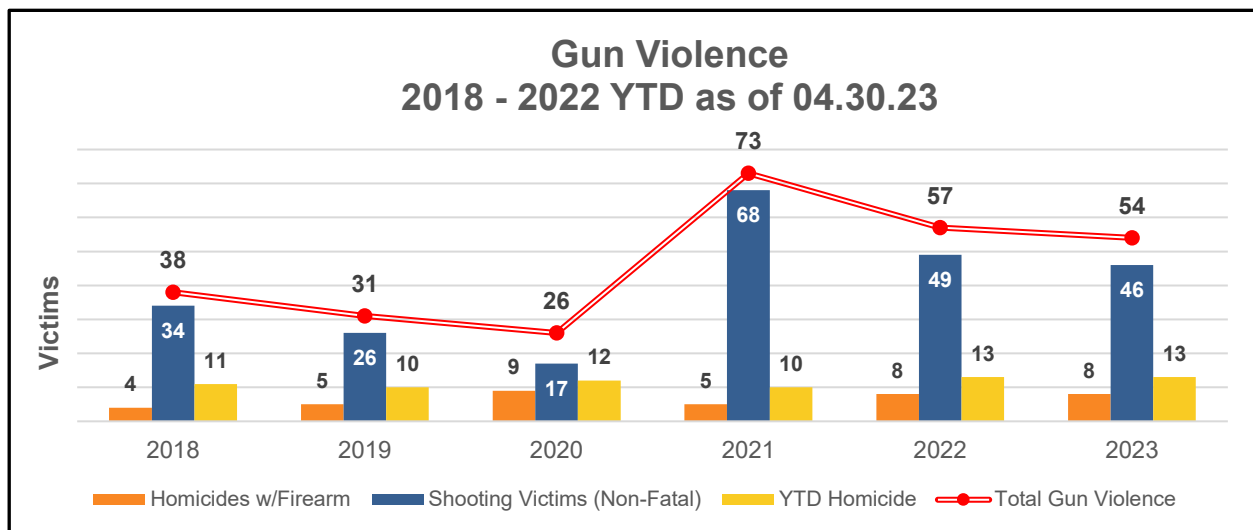

GUN VIOLENCE – Is DOWN 3% compared to 2022

- **There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 individuals this week.**
 - For the year, there are a total of 58 incidents resulting in 65 victims
- **There were 2 homicide incident for the week ending 04.30.23**
 - There are 17 homicides YTD with 12 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 100%**



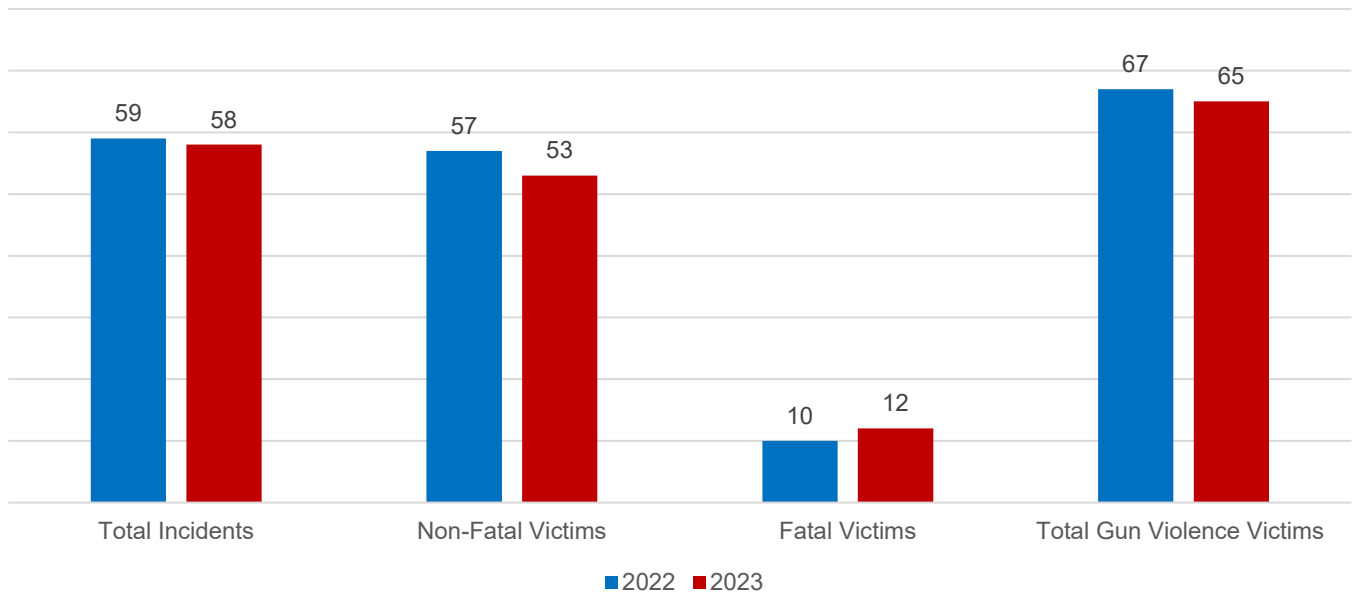

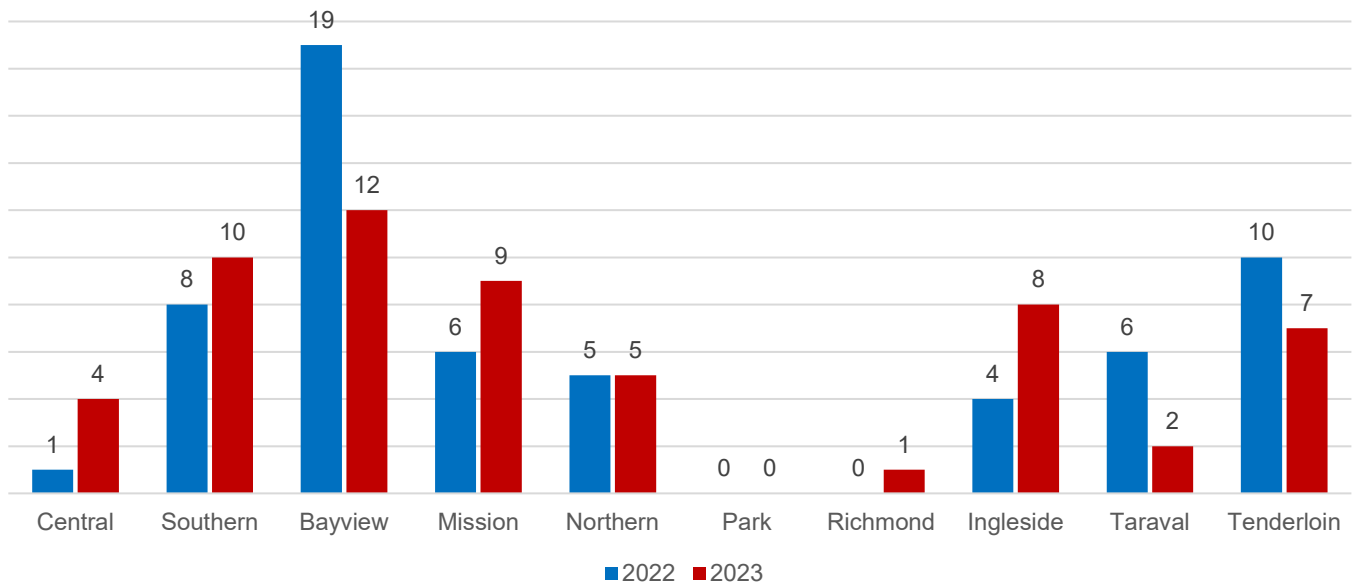

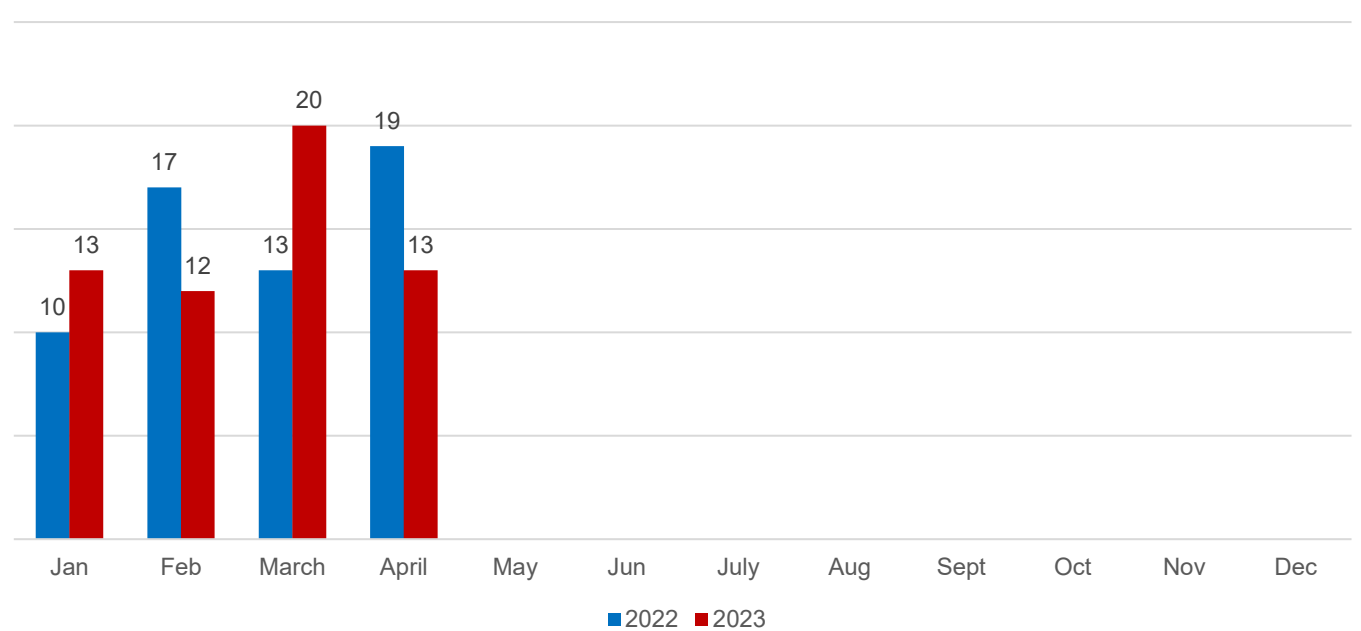
Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2022 vs. 2023



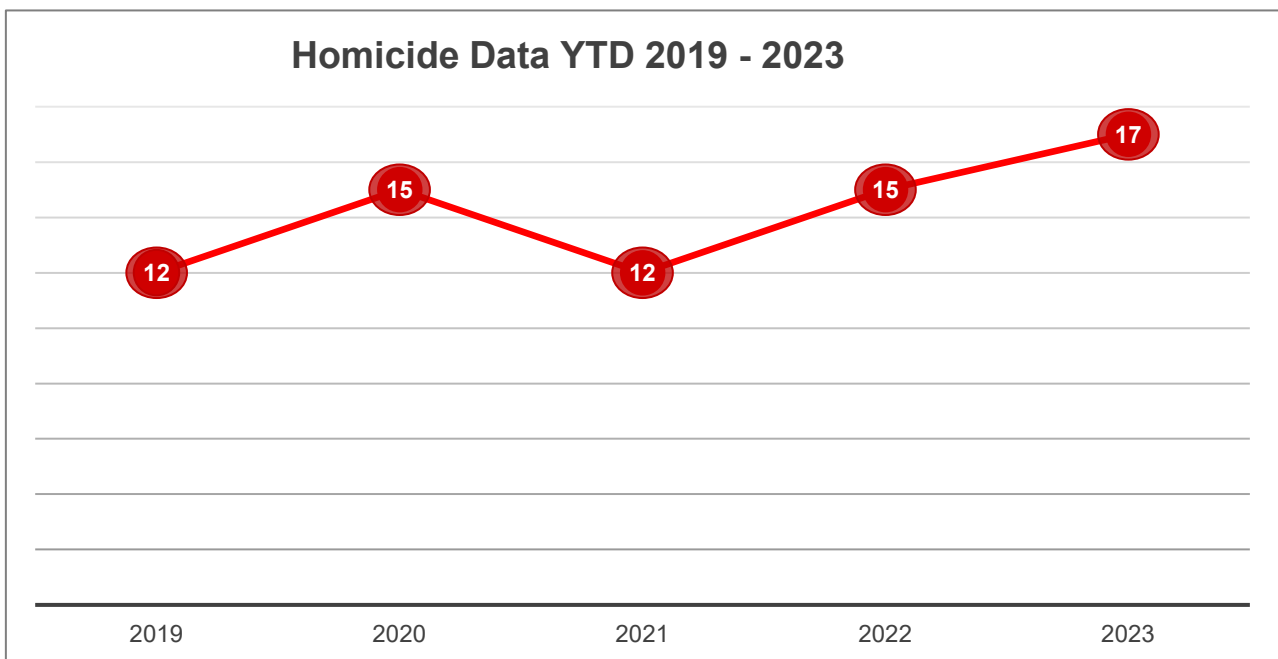
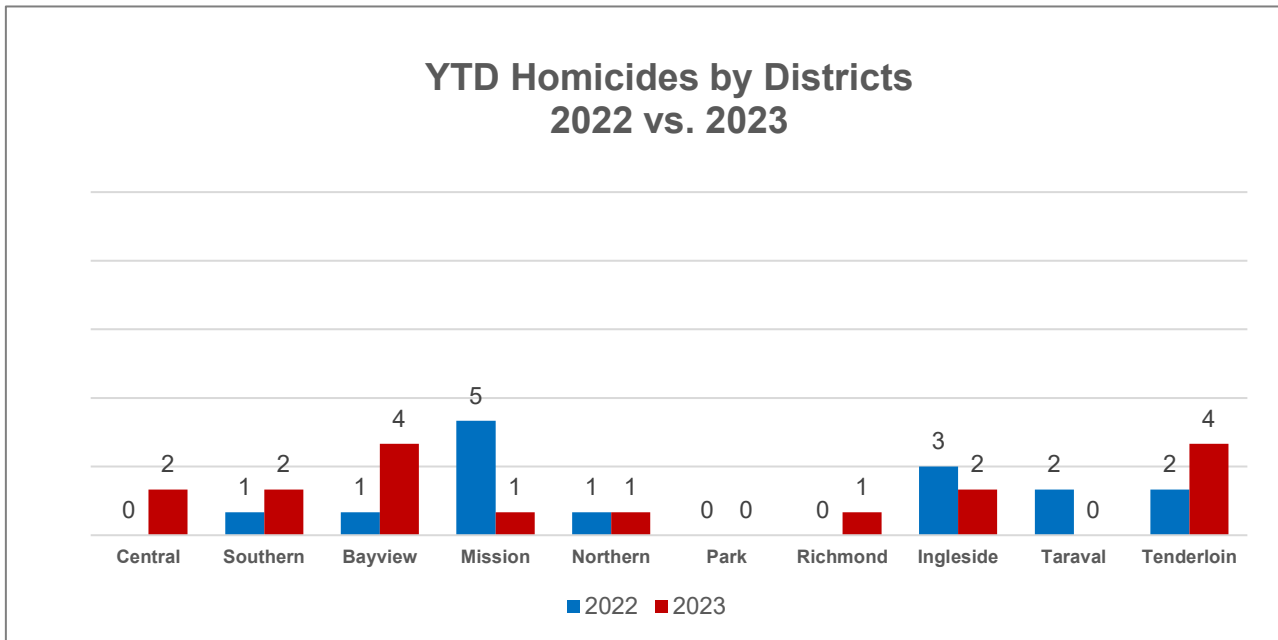
Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
