## DPA Received 35 new cases in the past weeks

- 21% The officer behaved or spoke inappropriately.
- 15% The officer displayed threatening, intimidating, or harassing behavior.
- 12% The officer failed to take required action.
- 6% The officer detained a person without reasonable suspicion.
- 6% The officer prepared an incomplete or inaccurate incident report.

Call for service involved assault, behavioral health crisis, burglary, robbery, and domestic violence.
