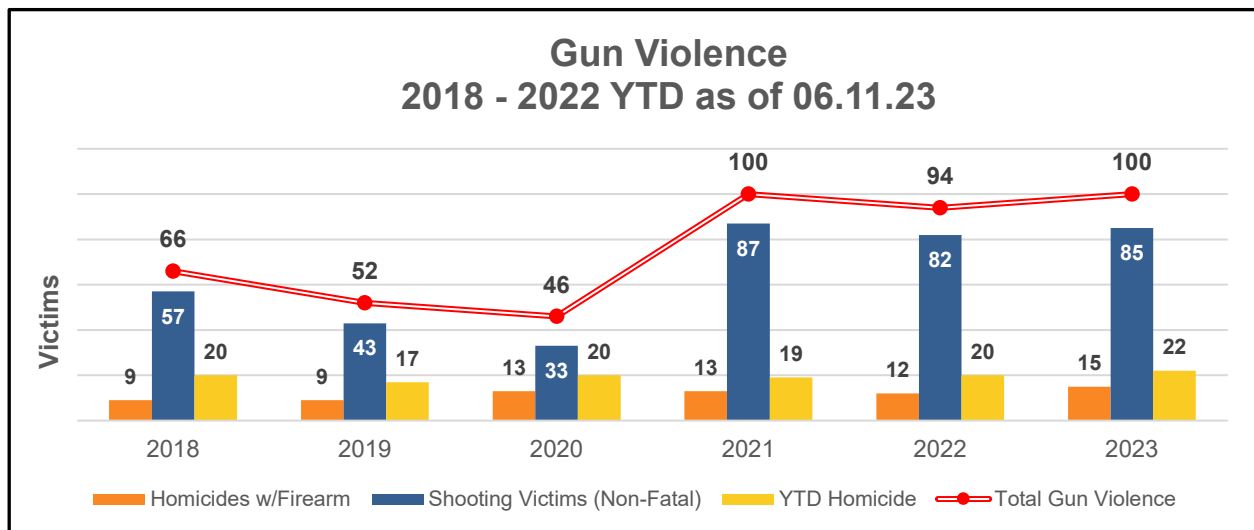

GUN VIOLENCE – UP 5% compared to 2022

- **There were 3 shooting incidents causing injuries to 13 victims this week.**
 - For the year, there are a total of 82 incidents resulting in 100 victims
- **There was 1 homicide incident for the week ending 06.11.23**
 - Please note: There was one homicide outside the reporting period on 06.13.23 - stat to be included in next week's data
 - There are 22 homicides YTD with 15 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 91%**



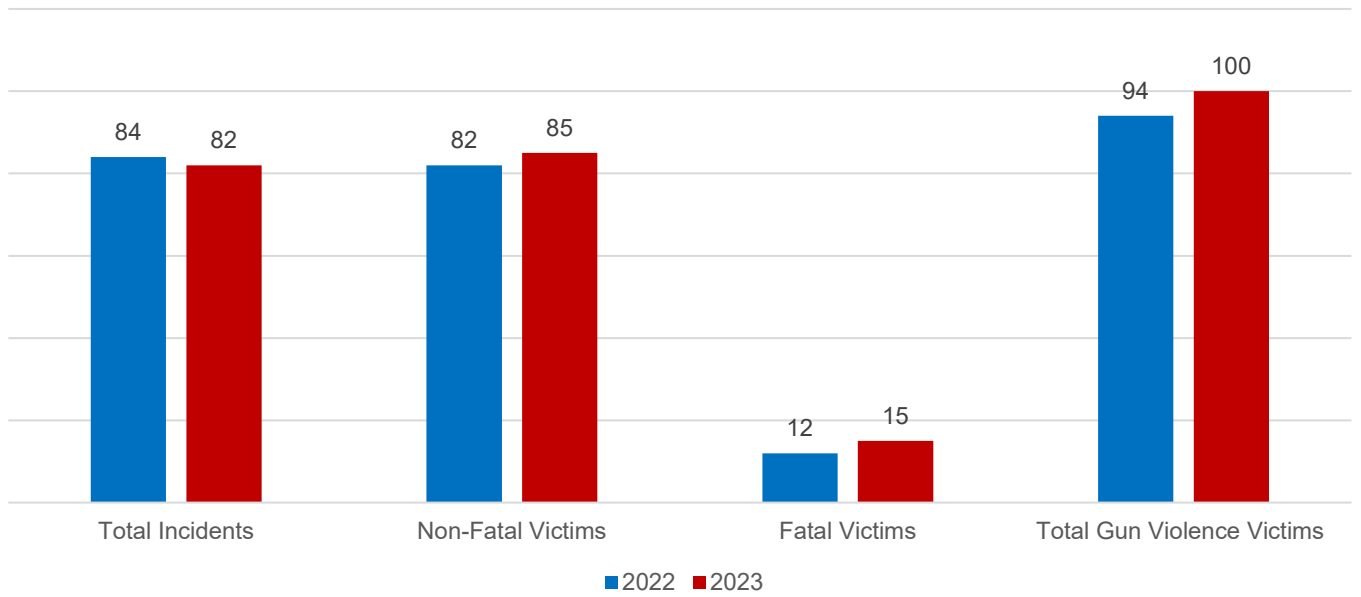

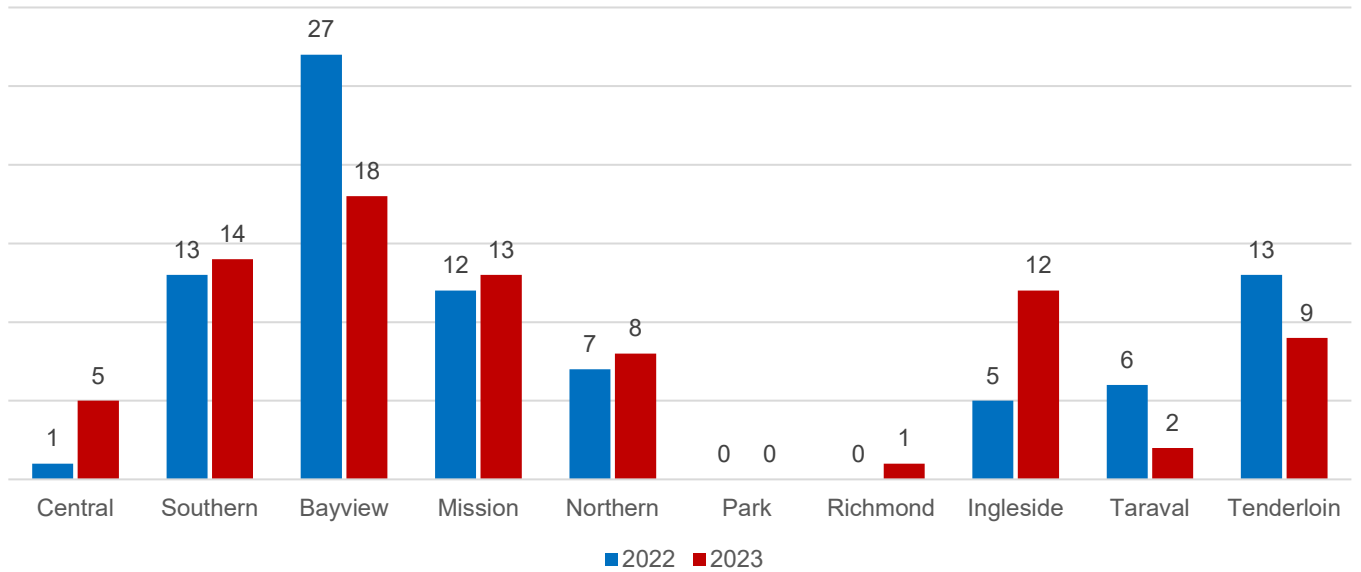

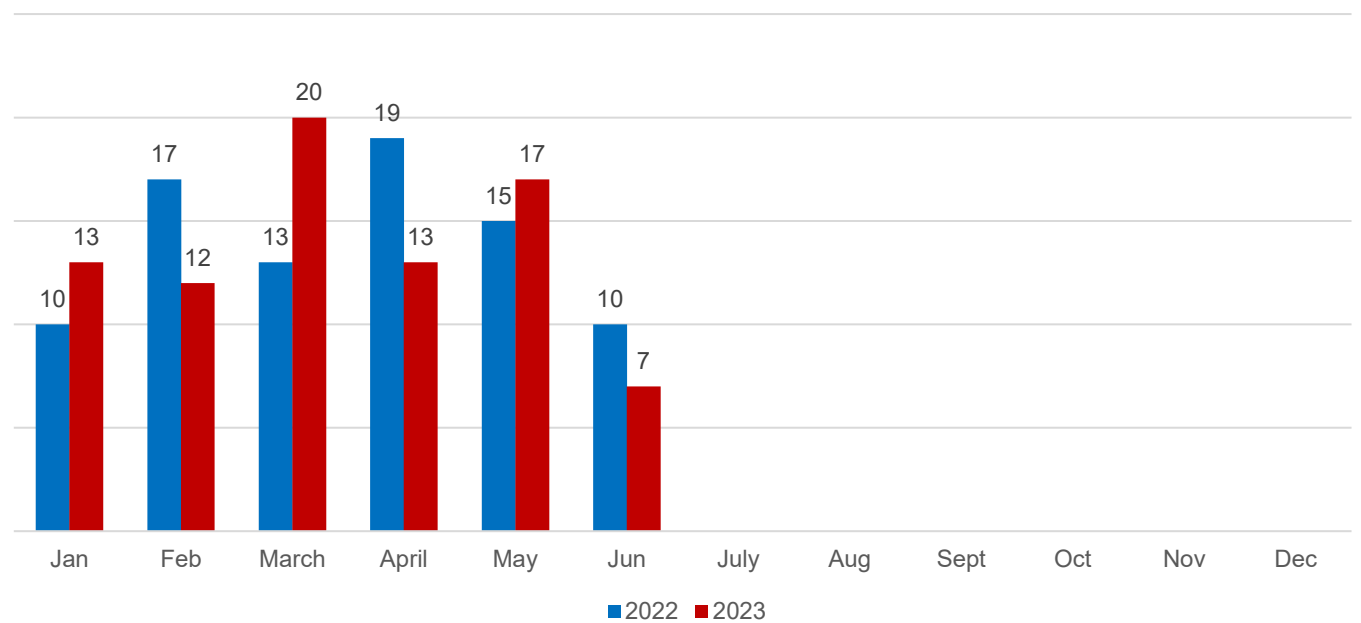
Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2022 vs. 2023



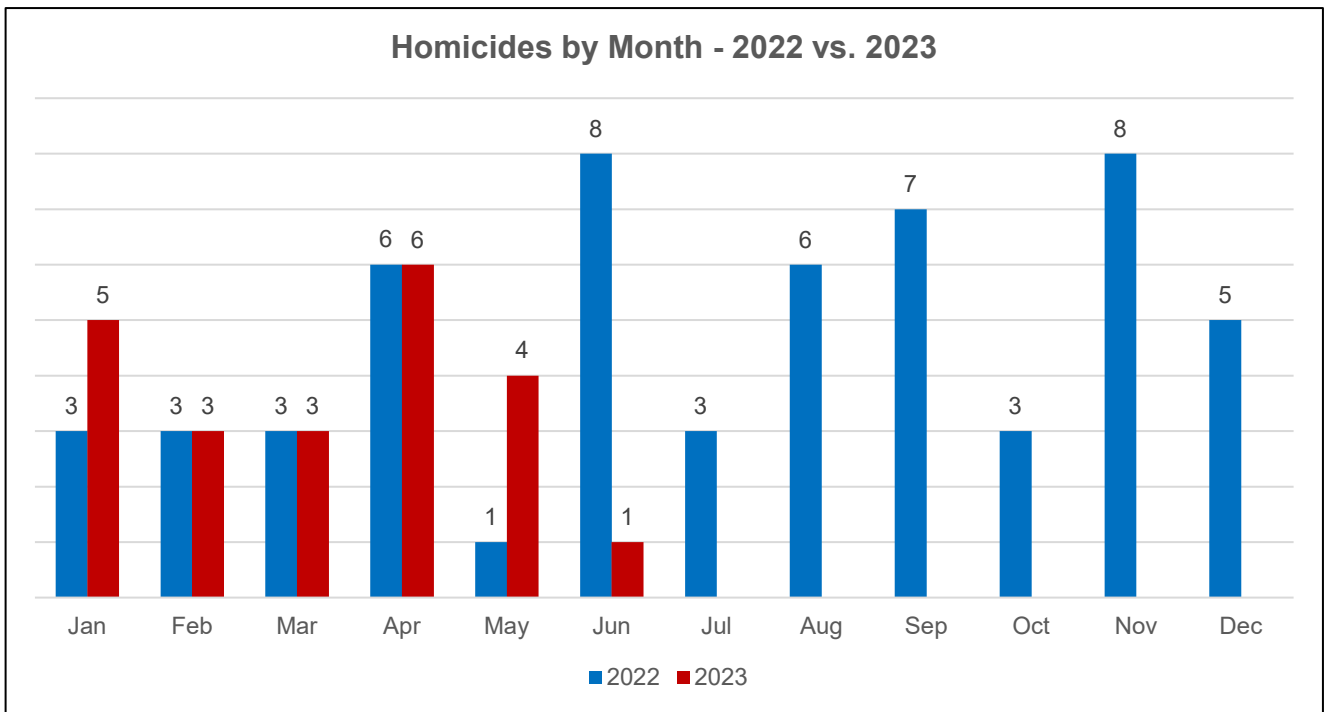
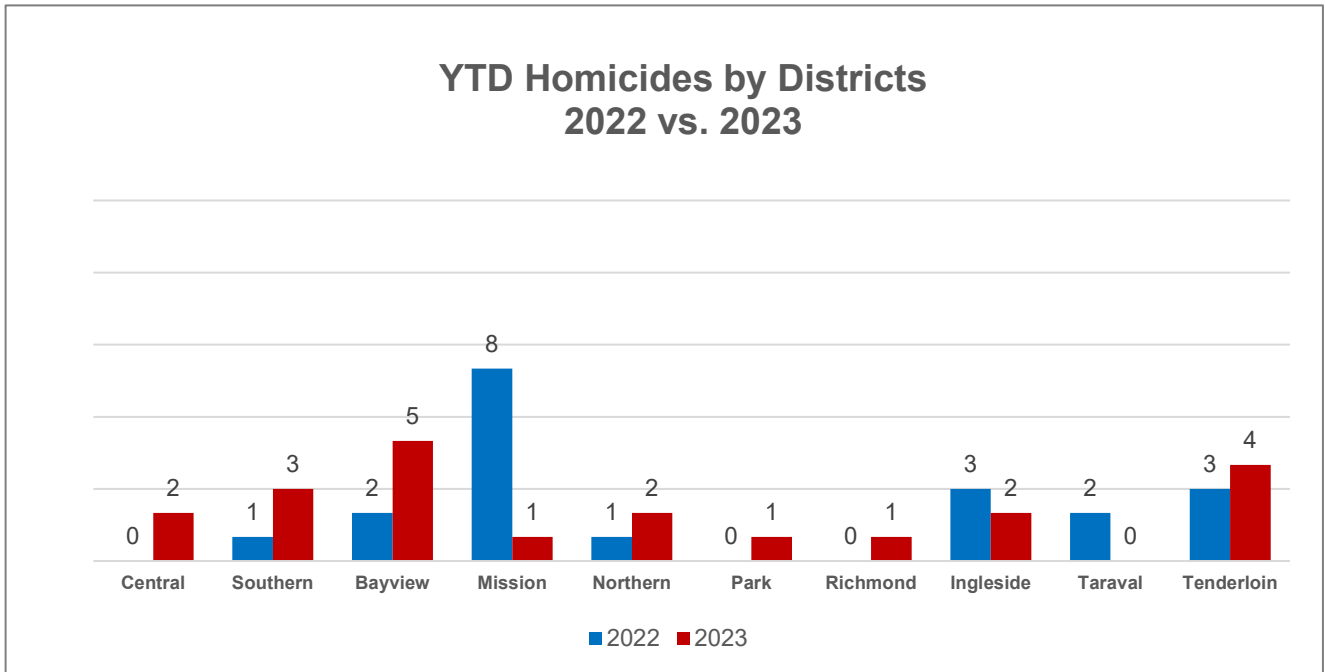
Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
