B - Southern	2	-	Officers failed to investigate a report of a stolen van. Officers failed to notify a security guard of their operation, placing the guard in danger.
C- Bayview	1	1	The complaint witnessed a person in distress and called 911 for help. The officers' response was poor and delayed.
D - Mission	2	3	The officer conducted a traffic stop on the complainant. During the stop, the officer made inappropriate comments and acted aggressively toward the complainant. The officer also failed to call a supervisor to the scene. Officers detained a person for a mental health hold without cause and used unnecessary force, causing injury.
