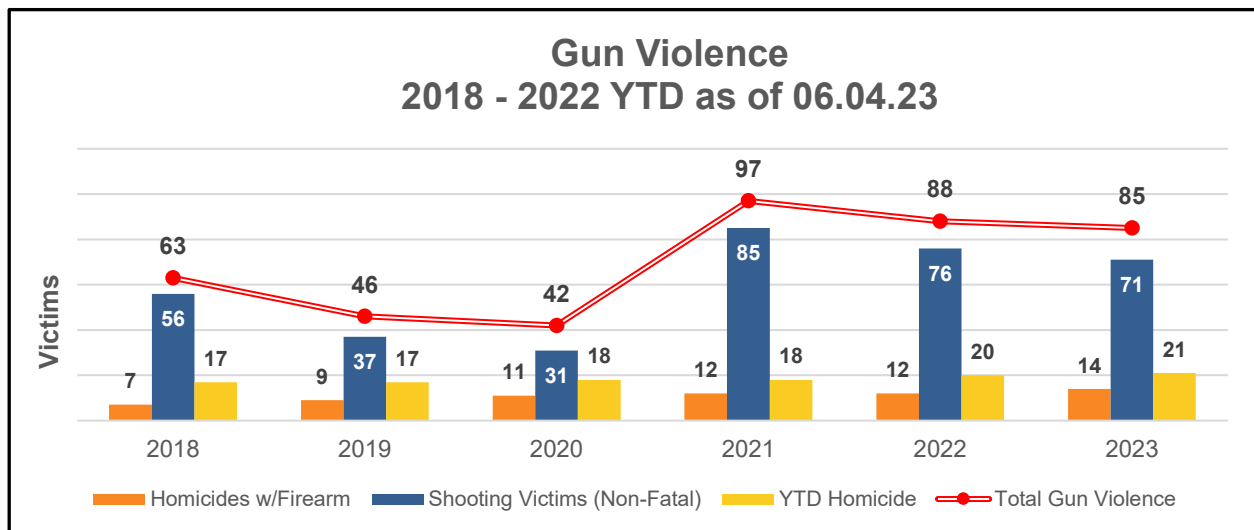

**GUN VIOLENCE – Down 3% compared to 2022**

- **There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims this week.**
  - For the year, there are a total of 77 incidents resulting in 85 victims
- **There were no homicide incidents for the week ending 06.04.23**
  - Please note: There was one homicide outside the reporting period on 06.05.23 - stat to be included in next week's data
  - There are 21 homicides YTD with 14 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - **Overall Clearance Rate: 95%**

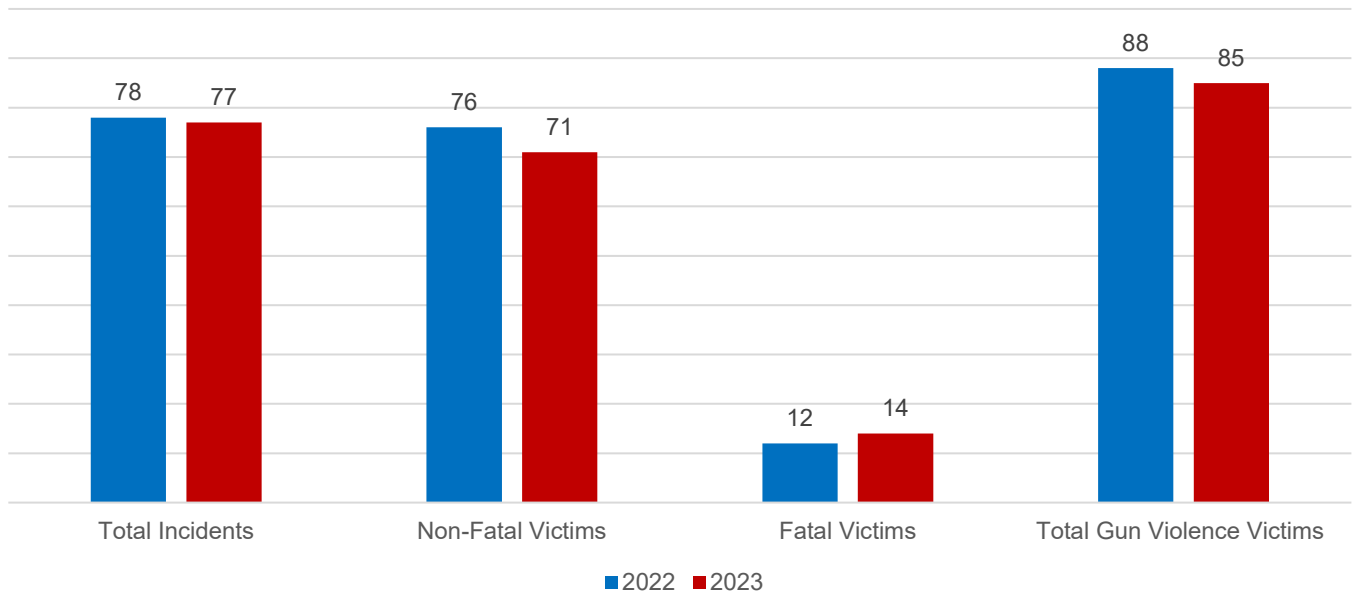

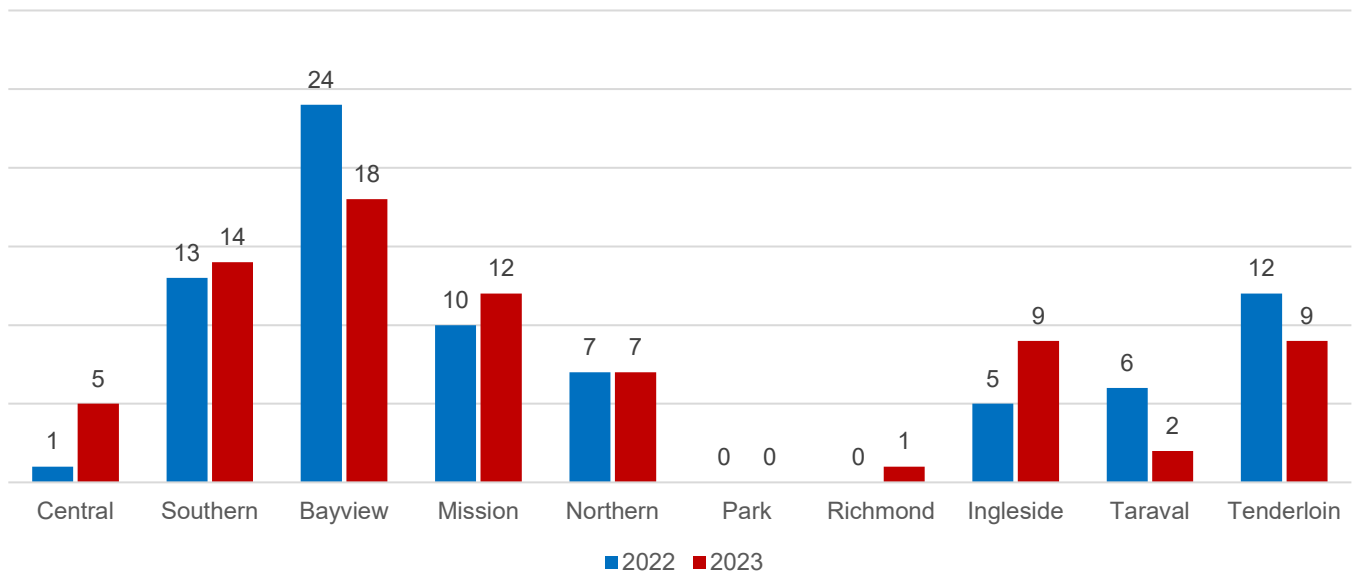

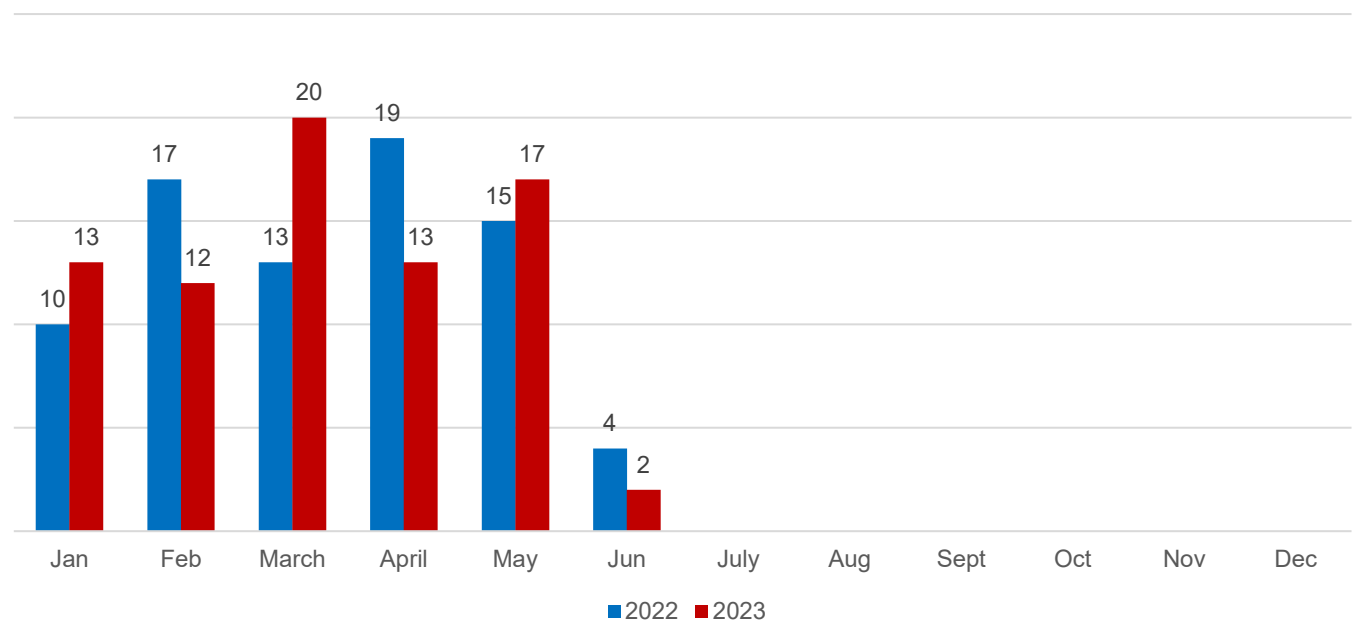
### Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2022 vs. 2023



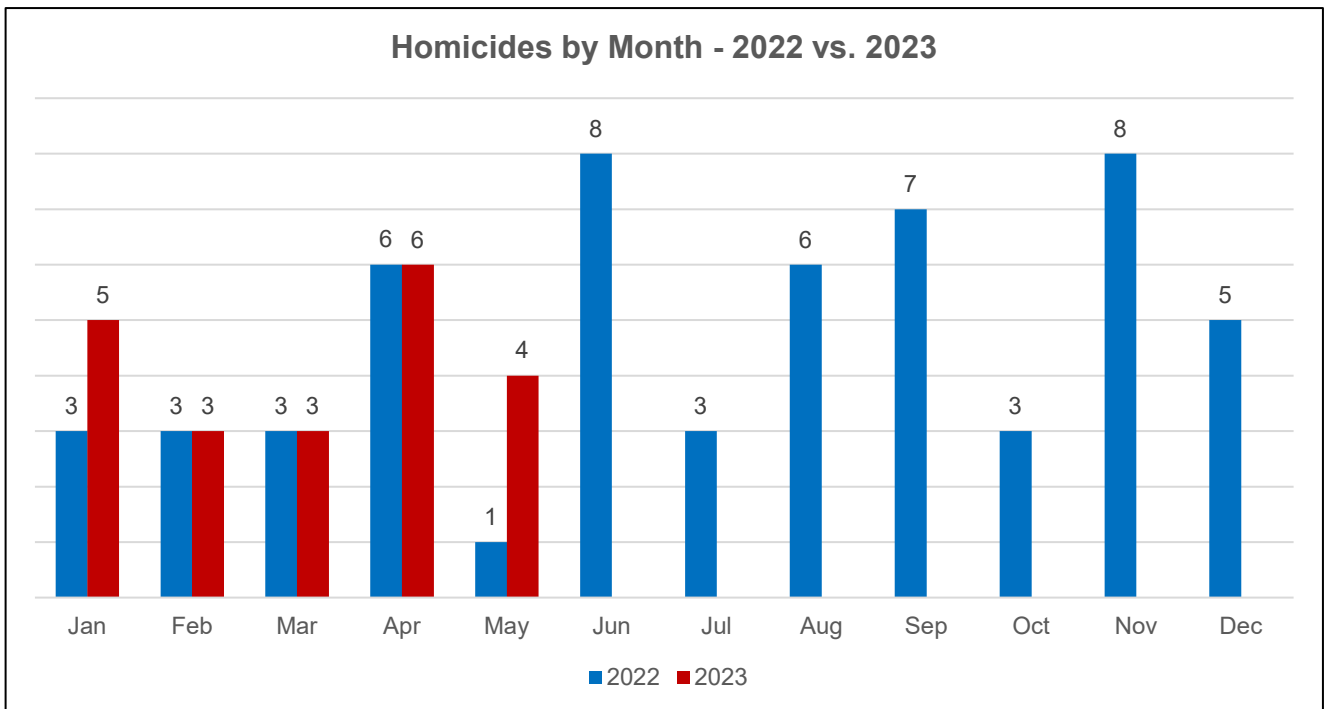
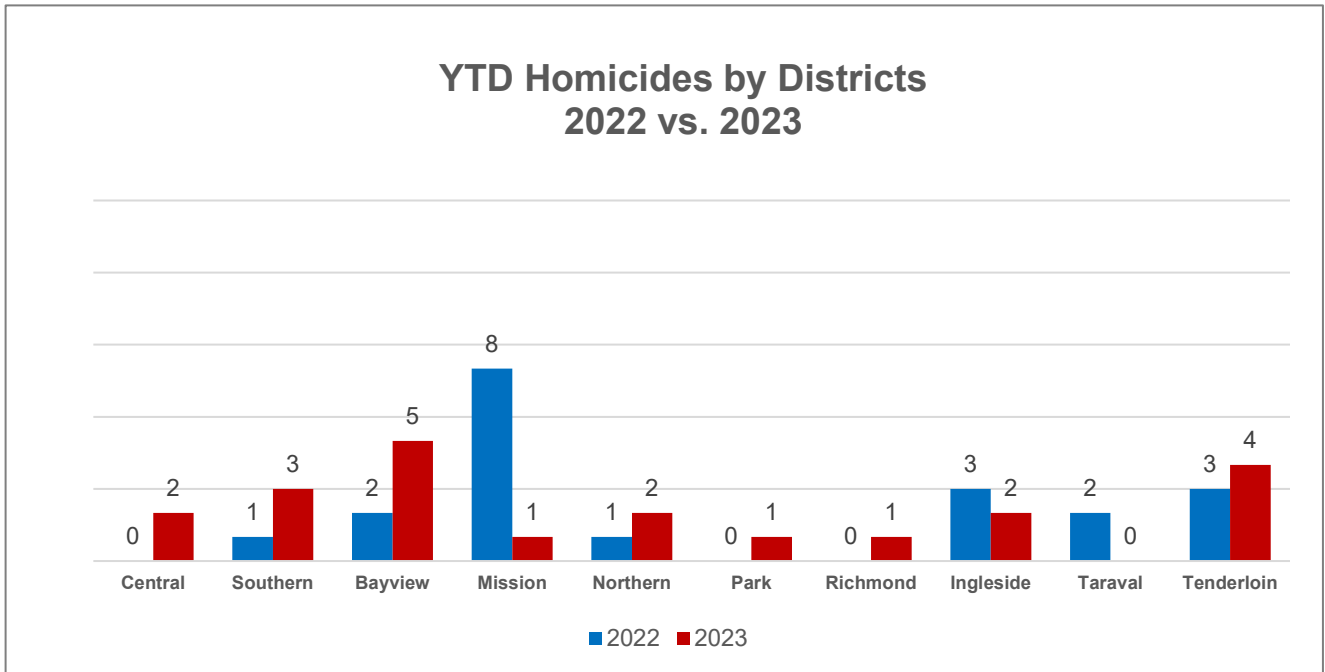
### Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023
