

#### **GUN VIOLENCE – UP 11% compared to 2022**


- There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 victims this week.

  - There are 28 homicides YTD with 19 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 85%





