

RIPA Board 2023 Annual Report Summary


The California Racial and Identity Profiling Advisory Board released its sixth annual RIPA Board Report. The Report contains an analysis of the millions of police and pedestrian stops conducted in 2021 under the Racial and Identity Profiling Act ("RIPA") of 2015 by 58 law enforcement agencies, including the 23 largest agencies, in California.









Quarterly Activity & Data Report (QADR) Q1 2023





- The Q1 2023 Quarterly Activity & Data Report (QADR) considers data from January 1st, 2023, thru March 31st, 2023.

- The QADR uses stop data provided to the State as one of the inputs to the report.





