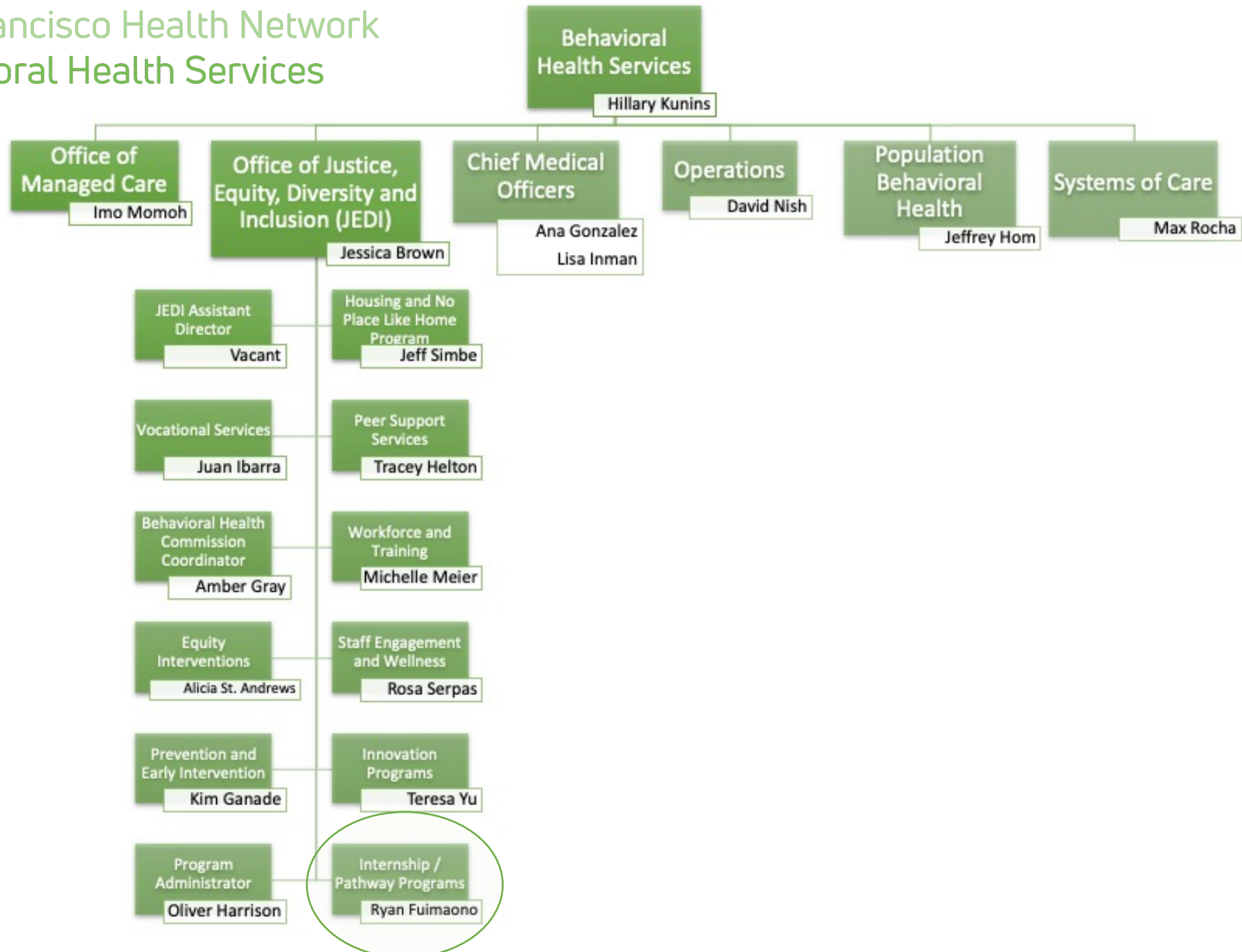

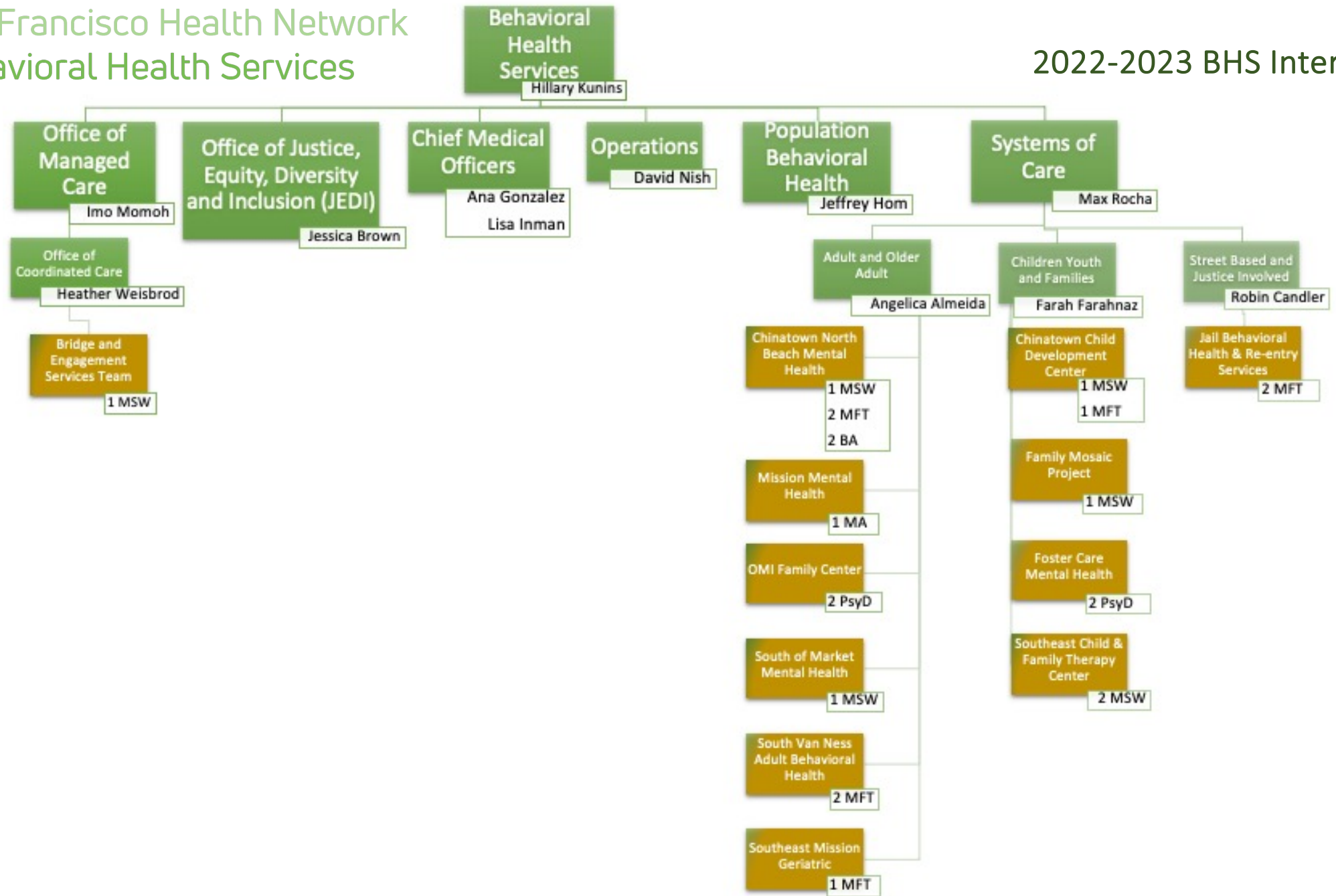

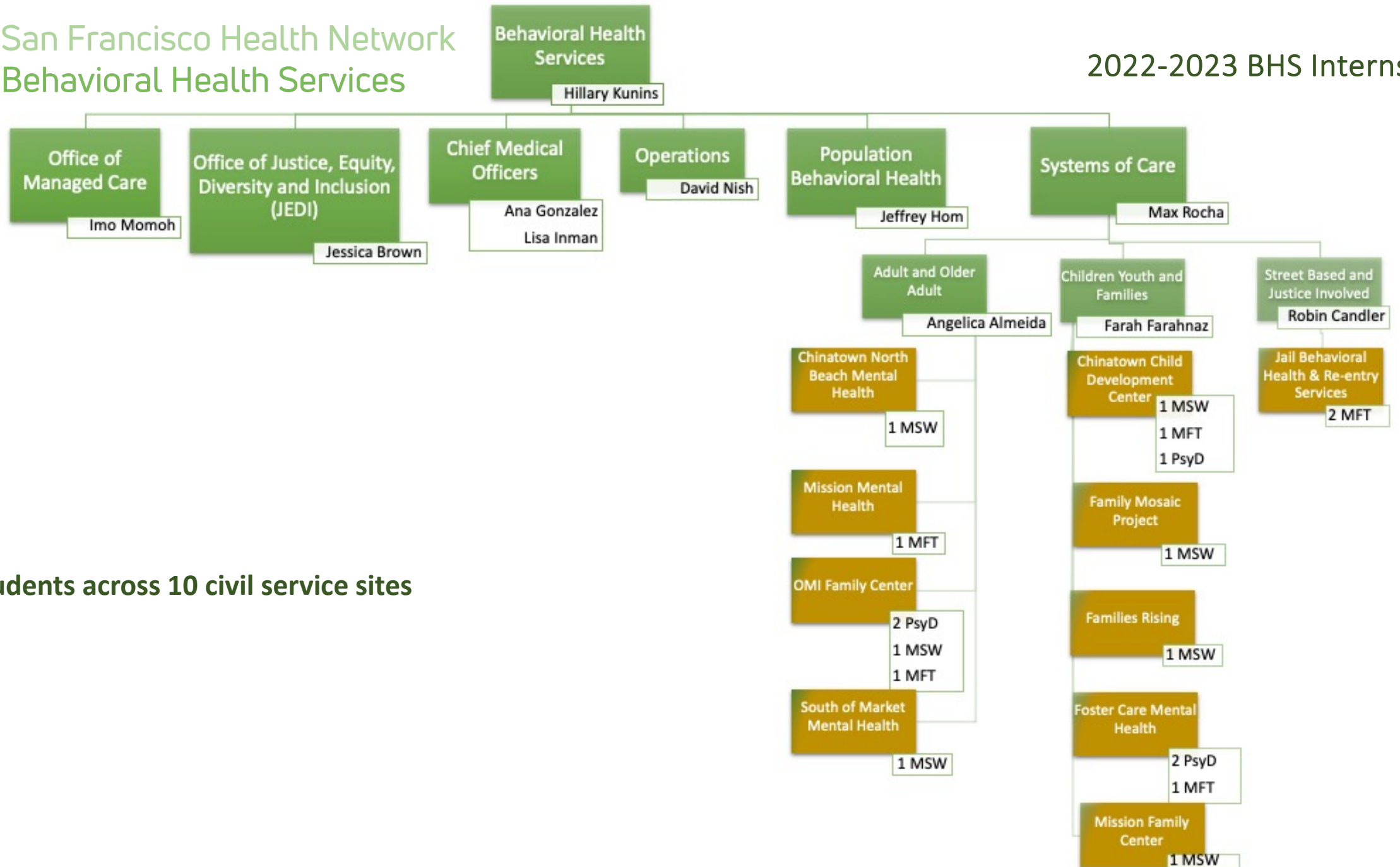

Multicultural Student Stipend Program

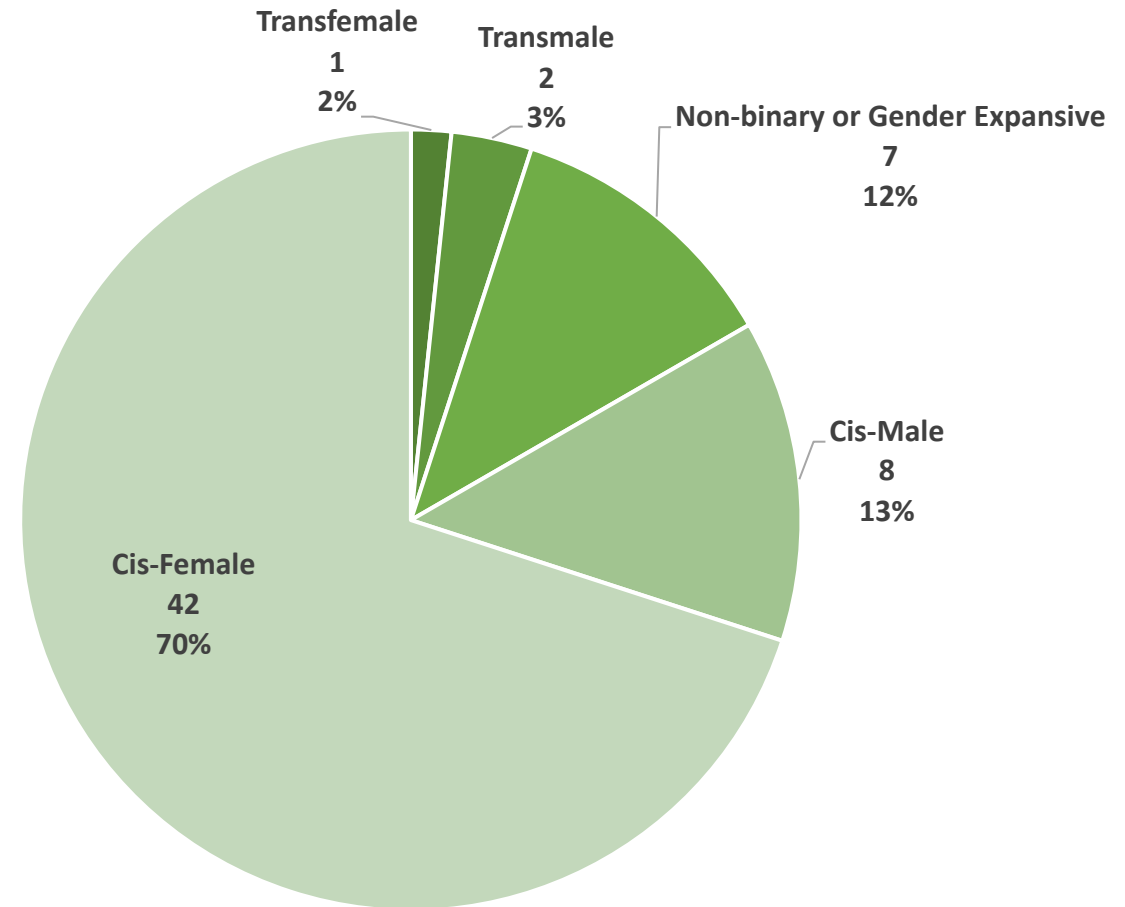
- Established in 1988

- In FY22/23 we added an additional \$150K to the existing \$70K budget
- Stipends ranging from \$1K to \$5K were awarded to 60 students placed across BHS (inclusive of CBOs and partner agencies)

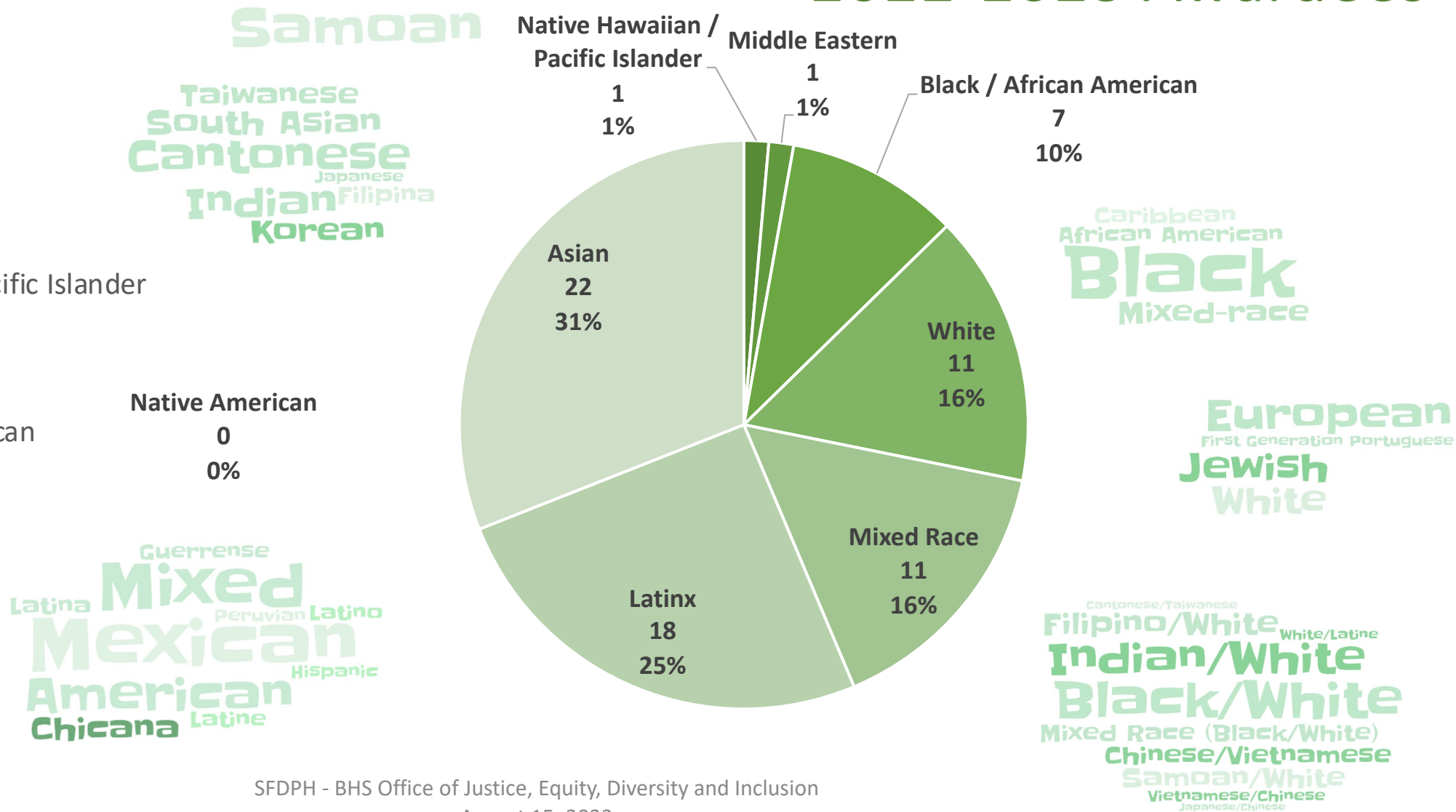

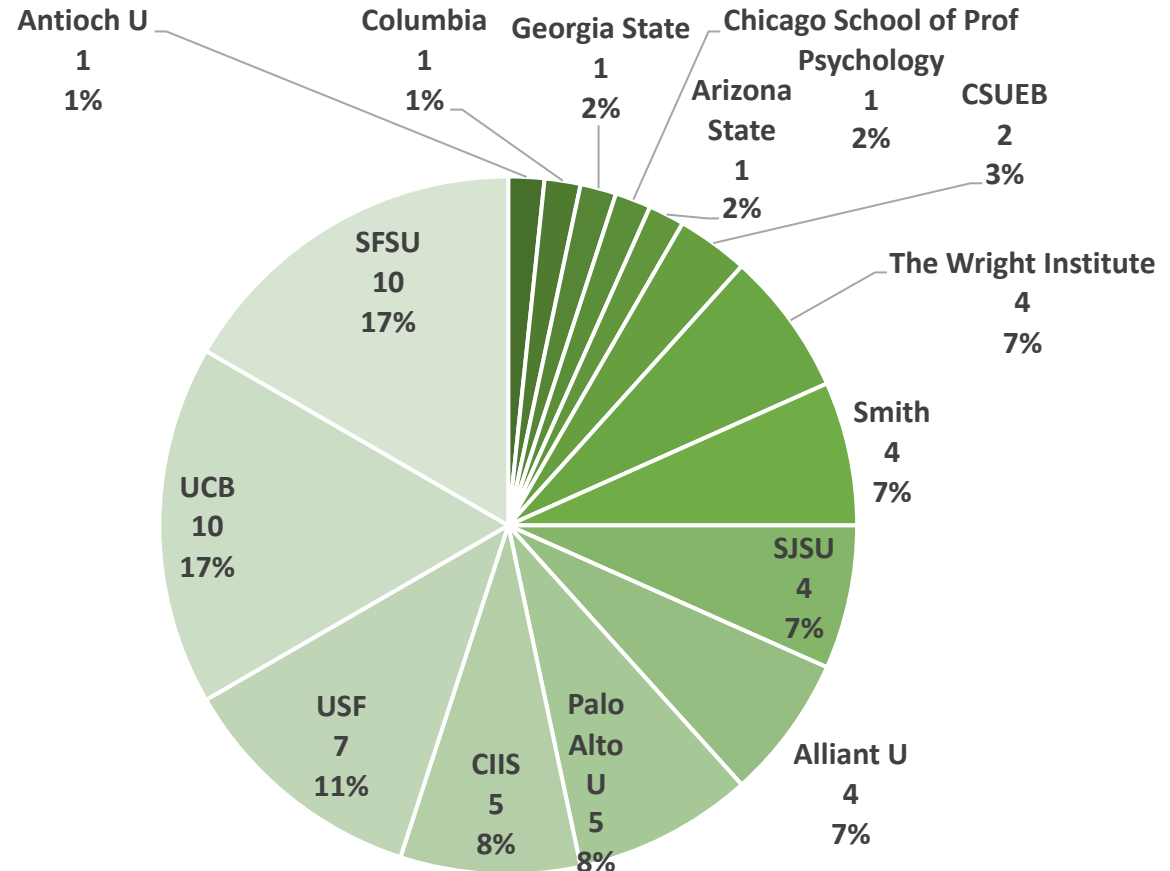

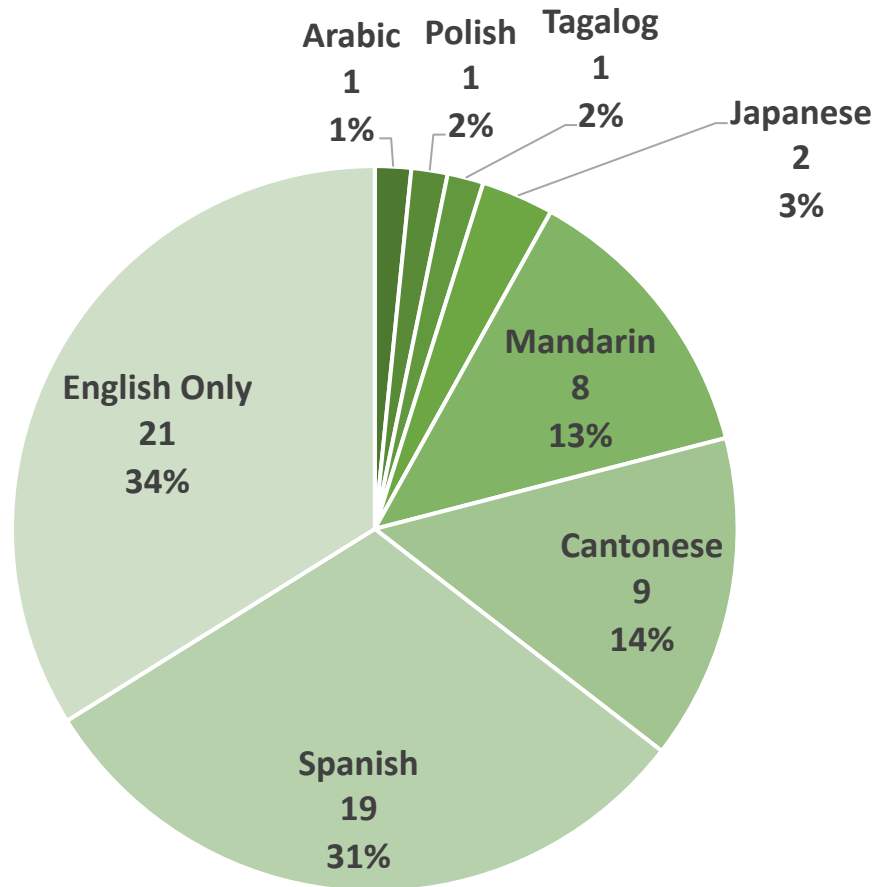
