This letter is in response to your request to decorate approximately 100 SFMTA-maintained signal cabinets in the City of San Francisco with painted murals. Prior to submitting a proposal for the San Francisco Arts Commission to review and approve, you must first obtain a letter from the appropriate city agency for permission to paint the cabinets, which in this case is the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA). I am writing to confirm that SFMTA is in support of our 100 cabinets being painted (per the list of 100 locations listed on the next 3 pages), and do not foresee any major issues with the painting of our cabinets. Therefore, your Arts Commission review can begin. However, final approval and authorization to proceed with painting our cabinets will be contingent upon working with SFMTA on an agreement/permit that SFMTA and Building 180 must sign. A sample agreement was previously sent to you for review. Because it will take time to obtain the SFMTA permit and for Arts Commission approval, we are providing this letter so that both approval processes can start and proceed concurrently.

It should be noted that some cabinets in the Tenderloin proposed for new murals were wrapped with a vinyl art wrap back in 2017. However, those old wraps are mostly damaged now due to age. Therefore, your new project may install new art on any previously wrapped cabinets that are listed below.

Utility cabinets look similar. Therefore, you took photos showing the cabinets you intended to paint. I have attached your photos to show the SFMTA cabinets that are proposed for painting.

I look forward to working with you on the SFMTA permit. Previous art installations on our cabinets have helped to beautify neighborhoods and make San Francisco a wonderful place to live.
