SF ACC placed 134 animals in foster homes during this quarter

Fostered: 97 cats, 11 dogs, 26 others (13 rabbits, 13 guinea pigs). Many of these fostered animals went on to be adopted from us, while many other animals were transferred to our adoption partners

ACOs responded to 2,745 emergency calls for service this quarter
SF ACC received 4 calls regarding sightings of outdoor cats this quarter
14 Cats were transported to the Community Cats Program
(NOTE: Members of the public are instructed to bring feral cats directly to SPCA for their Community Cats program. SF ACC only tracks animals which are impounded at SF ACC and then transported to Community Cats.)
