Recertification Status Update

Our Recertification into the Medicaid Provider Program

- The California Department of Public Health and Department of Health Care Services recertified Laguna Honda Hospital in the Medicaid Provider Program.
- More than 95% of residents are supported by Medicaid.
- This recertification was the direct result of our team proving, in multiple rigorous surveys, that we meet the highest standards for resident care and safety, fire life safety and operations.

Application for Medicare Recertification

- Based on CMS advice, LHH submitted a *change of information* application for Medicare recertification on August 23.
- CMS further advised a different application be submitted and LHH is currently preparing to submit the new application.
- We are in a position to submit an application because of our work and dedication, and commitment to continuous improvement.
- **As of now, we are subject to a full survey by CMS, which could happen at any time, and without notice.**
- Our goal is to demonstrate to CMS that we meet the highest standards of resident care and safety, fire life safety and operations.

Action Plan Update

- The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) 90-Day Monitoring Survey #3 took place in June.
- In July, we submitted our proposed Action Plan in response to the June survey, as well as other non-monitoring-survey findings, to CMS.
- The proposed Action Plan includes approximately 300 milestones for Monitoring Survey #3 and 150 milestones for non-monitoring-survey findings.
- We have submitted 257 milestones for Monitoring Survey #3 and 109 milestones for non-monitoring-survey findings.





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
